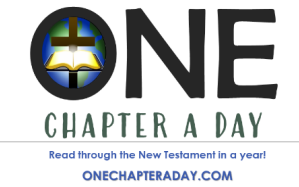


**MEMORY VERSE OF THE WEEK:** Luke 11:28

# MY NOTES

## My Insights / My Questions

**MONDAY, NOVEMBER 15**

**Read Luke 11**

- 1. Jesus asks what father, in response to his son's request "... for an egg, will give him a scorpion?" The egg however, is useless until it is cracked open. How does this action reflect His promise in this week's bible memory verse?
- 2. Jesus gives the people a clear choice about Himself in verse 20. What does it mean to you that "the kingdom of God has come upon you"? How does your choice reflect His promise in this week's bible memory verse?
- 3. What did men of Nineveh do when they heard the preaching of Jonah (v 32)? How did their choice reflect this week's bible memory verse?
- **Prayer:** *Lord, let me always seek to clearly hear your Word through the guidance of your Holy Spirit and to be joyfully obedient to Your will.*

**TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 16**

**Read Luke 12**

- 1. Jesus says to "fear him who ... has authority to cast into hell". He also says "Fear not". How can we control our fears? How do Christians, facing martyrdom, calm their fears? How do they (we?) rejoice in times of trials and tribulations?
- 2. Jesus calls the man who says to his soul, "relax, eat, drink, be merry" a what? What are the man's priorities? What are our priorities when we do not give to God our first fruit offerings? (See Luke 12, 31.)
- 3. Referencing v.31, Jesus tells us that he came to bring, not peace on earth but rather, division. What does He mean? Isn't he called the "Prince of Peace"? What is eschatology?
- **Prayer:** *Lord, let our hopes and dreams always be guided by Your love and Your will in our lives.*

**WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 17**

**Read Luke 13**

- 1. Jesus tells us (v.5) that we have to repent. If not, we will \_\_\_\_\_. How do you share the Gospel with someone who tells you they have nothing to repent?
- 2. To people who say they ate and drank with Jesus, in v.27 (NIV, a bit different from ESV), He says. "I do not know you or where you came from. Away from me, all you evildoers." These are "churchgoers" ("We ate and drank with You"). What is the purpose of excommunication? Is it an act of love, justified righteousness, protection of the faithful, other? (Mathew 18, v.15)?
- 3. Jesus clearly saw his looming death in Jerusalem. What was His lament (v.34)? What is God's will for His disobedient children?
- **Prayer Focus:** *Let us daily repent of our sins and beg your forgiveness.*
