MONDAY, JANUARY 3

Read Luke 23 - Innocent Jesus Crucified

- 1. Find three declarations of Jesus' innocence proclaimed by people.
- 2. Jesus absolves the sins of sinners twice on the cross. Describe these absolutions.
- 3. Read v 26-31. How is this an end times prophecy?
- Prayer: Jesus, you were innocent but you took my sins to the cross with you. Praise God.

TUESDAY, JANUARY 4

Read Luke 24 - On the Road with the Risen Christ

- 1. Women are in the forefront of the history of Jesus' death and resurrection. Find three places in Ch 23&24 where they are prominent.
- 2. Cleopas and his son's eyes are finally opened by Jesus to the whole Gospel story. How? Through W_____ and S__
- 3. How does Jesus like his fish cooked? Baked, fried, poached?
- Prayer: Jesus, open our eyes to your righteousness through the preaching and feeding of your church on earth.

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 5

Read John 1 - Behold the Lamb of God

- 1. God gave us the law through Moses. What did he give us through Jesus?
- 2. John the Baptist calls Jesus the Lamb of God. Think of two Old Testament histories that involve a sacrificed lamb.
- 3. How has God revealed to us his true self and nature by sending us his Son, Jesus? Think of love, mercy and grace.
- Prayer: Thanks be to God for revealing Himself in the glory of the incarnation, death and resurrection of his Son.

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THURSDAY, JANUARY 6

Read John 2 - The First Miracle

- 1. Jesus reluctantly manifested his glory in the miracle at Cana. When will his full glory finally be manifested?
- 2. Do we truly know Jesus through His miracles or through his death on the cross?
- 3. Where does God dwell in the Old Testament? Where does God dwell in the New Testament?
- Prayer: Lord Jesus, give me confidence as I seek you in my hour of need. (LSB)

FRIDAY, JANUARY 7

Read John 3 - Nicodemus Finds God

- 1. How can we see the Kingdom of God? How are we born again or born from above?
- 2. Read versus 14-16 together without a break. In what way does God love the world?
- 3. Nicodemus thinks Jesus is a teacher/rabbi sent from God. Who does Jesus tell him He is?
- Prayer: Father, grant that my life may be a testimony to Your sacrificial love. (LSB)

SATURDAY, JANUARY 8

Read John 4—Living Water Flows from Jesus

- How does Jesus' humanity show at the well in Samaria? How does Jesus' divine nature show at the well in Samaria?
- 2. Do you have occasions and the courage like the imperfect Samaritan women to share the Gospel with others?
- 3. What is remarkable about this official's response to Jesus' promise? Did he rush home to find proof?
- Prayer: Jesus, give me and my family unquestioning faith in all Your promises. (LSB)

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
