MONDAY, NOVEMBER 1

Read Mark 15 - The Death of Jesus

- 1. How was Jesus' arrest and crucifixion the best of times and the worst of times?
- 2. In the end even the Roman centurion confesses the dead Jesus was the Son of God. Why is this important?
- 3. Why did Jesus not just step down right off the cross when the chief priests and scribes mocked him and prove that he was the Christ? Do we see and then believe?
- Prayer Focus: Pray for your immediate family, father, mother, brothers, sisters, children, grandchildren, nieces, nephews.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2

Read Mark 16—The Resurrection of Jesus

- Before Jesus's trial, he tells the disciples he will see them in Galilee after he is raised up. The young man in the tomb tells the women the same thing. Has Jesus kept his promises?
- 2. What are the three core beliefs of our Christian religion? Hint, all of them are concentrated in the writings of Mark 15/16.
- 3. Has the great commission to proclaim the Gospel everywhere been accomplished? Why has Jesus not come to us in person again as promised?
- Prayer Focus: Pray for your extended family, aunts, uncles, cousins, close friends.

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 3

Read Luke 1 - Certainty of Things Taught

- 1. No one really knows who Theophilus was. In your imagination, who do you think he might have been and why did Luke write for him?
- 2. Almost all of Luke's infancy narrative is unique. Where do you think he got the well-researched information about Jesus' youth?
- *3.* How are both God and his people shown to be faithful in the birth narrative?
- Prayer Focus: Pray for your next-door neighbor, your neighbor across the street, your back yard neighbor.

Read Luke 2 - Go Tell It on The Mountain

- 1. What does Jesus' humble birth say to us about the Gospel given to us in grace?
- 2. Simeon raises the baby Jesus in his arms and foretells the salvation of all people. Who should we look to for our salvation?
- 3. Jesus learns and grows in strength as a twelve-year-old man in the temple. What is he preparing for (ex. ch4)?
- Prayer Focus: Pray for your local public schools, students, teachers, administrators, school boards.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 5

Read Luke 3 - Jesus Baptized

- 1. Why did John the Baptist tell the decedents of Abraham that eternal salvation was not assured for them?
- 2. What did John's baptism of his followers accomplish? Was it complete?
- 3. Matthew shows Jesus is descended from the Judean Abraham. Why might Luke have showed Jesus is descended all the way back from Adam?
- Prayer Focus: Pray for your local town, city and county and the government leaders and workers.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 6

Read Luke 4 - Jesus Ministry Begins

- 1. Jesus relied on the Word of God to resist the devil's temptation, not some super power. What does this teach us about dealing with our temptations?
- 2. Does the Nazarian mob eventually succeed in killing Jesus, or not?
- 3. Jesus' authority accuses, silences and casts out evil. What does his authority also say about the assurances he gives in his promises?
- Prayer Focus: Pray for your state of Georgia, for the leaders of our state and its workers.
