Tucson Preparatory School is scheduled to reopen 8/17/2020. Students will be given access to an array of learning tools that will allow them to succeed during this time of COVID-19. Teachers have spent substantial time and effort in developing learning plans that will give all students the same educational opportunities that they would receive during traditional in-person classes.

Social Emotional Support will be offered to all students in need. This includes providing developmentally appropriate strategies for understanding and regulating emotions and practicing self-care, guiding families on how to create supportive home environments, and fostering an overarching commitment to creating connectedness across physical distance.
