Praying

1. Prayer Walking (weekly)
2. Triple-Five Prayers (praying for 3 people for a minute each 5x a week)
 - Hearts to be soft to the presence and promptings of God
 - For the Holy Spirit to convict them of sin and help them see their need for God's Grace
 - For God's blessings to flow into their lives and for them to recognize His goodness
 - That God would break down and remove obstacles in their lives that keep them from seeing and responding to the Holy Spirit
 - Surrender your life, time, and words to God. Ask Him to use you to reflect His grace, serve faithfully, and share His Good News when the time is right.
3. Prayers for Workers (Harvest is plentiful, the workers are few)
4. Scripture Prayers (Mt 9:35-38, Eph 2:1-10, Phil 1, Col 1, I Jn 5:1-12)
5. Listening Prayers (How would you have me pray, God?)

4. When you are viewing the power and beauty of creation

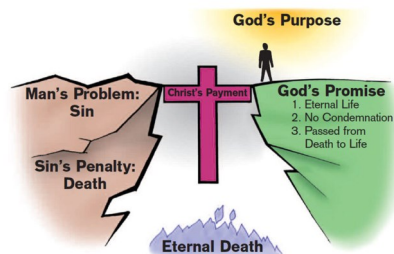
