



## Steps to Enroll and Attend School

Classes at SBLDA are broken down into two modules to assist you in achieving your goals to enter the industry as a professional driver. Module One will prepare you to obtain your Commercial Learners Permit (CLP) and provide you with Entry Level Driver Training Theory. Module two will provide you with the knowledge and hand on skills to safely operate a commercial motor vehicle. You must complete ALL Module One requirements to be assigned to the second module.

### Module One:

1. Attend Class Orientation.
2. Obtain a DOT Physical.
3. Secure Funding.
4. Complete a School Application and Student Contract.
5. Successfully complete **Objective A** - LMS Online Training.
6. Once you complete Objective A, you will need to take the General Knowledge, Combination Vehicles, Air Brake and Tanker written tests at the DMV to obtain a Class "A" Commercial Learners Permit with a Tanker Endorsement (N) and obtain a 10-year certified driving record from the DMV.
7. Successfully complete **Objective B** - Entry Level Driver Training (ELDT) 35 Classroom Modules online.
8. Take a USDOT pre-employment drug test.
9. The school must receive verified negative test results.

**\*Note:** You must communicate with our office in person for all the steps above.

### Module Two:

After all the requirements of module one are completed, you will be assigned a date to attend physical class. Your first part of week one will be in the classroom. The remainder of class time will be spent mostly operating vehicles on the range and road. The physical class operates Monday through Friday 8am to 5pm.
