User Guide

Custom Equestrian Drill Team Scoring System

1 January 2023

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ScoreKeeper EDT was developed to simplify and automate the equestrian drill team competition scoring process. To avoid the time-consuming manual scoring process for judges and organizers, the cloud-based program utilizes tablets and/or laptops for judges to input team scores. The customized program accurately tallies and places teams based on an organization's established scoring rules and guidelines.

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QUICK START

BEFORE THE SHOW



1. **LOGIN** to your ScoreKeeper EDT account.
2. **DOUBLE-CLICK** on and **OPEN** (leave open) Scorekeeper's **CONTROL PANEL**.
3. **CLICK** on the **SHOW INFORMATION** button, follow the link and enter your competition details (show date, names, location and judges). When done, close file.
4. **CLICK** on the **CLASS ENTRIES** button, follow the link and enter your teams in all the classes they have entered per your "Order of Go." When done, close file.
5. **CLICK** on and **OPEN** the "**LIVE**" **CLASSES**, and **PRINT CLASS RESULTS** to see if there are extra blank rows between classes that you would like to "hide" (no need to print blank rows), or "unhide" (hidden rows may be hiding a team name from a previous class lineup). See [Tips & Tricks](#) for Instructions on "hiding" and "unhiding" rows.
6. **START** each of your mobile devices. **OPEN** the judge's scorecard file on each device and check to see that the team names are now listed in the classes per your "Order of Go." Once done, close the scorecard files and shut down/turn off the mobile device(s).
7. **CHARGE** all judge tablets to 100%.

Office Computer(s)

Turn on your computer and connect to the competition venue's Wi-Fi, or setup a "hotspot" on your iPhone, if necessary for Wi-Fi connectivity.

1. **LOGIN** to your ScoreKeeper EDT account.
2. **DOUBLE-CLICK** on and **OPEN** Scorekeeper's **CONTROL PANEL**.

Mobile Judging Devices

Turn on each of your judging devices and connect to the competition venue's Wi-Fi, and/or "hotspot" if one was created for Wi-Fi connectivity.

3. **OPEN** the judge's scorecard file on each device and have it ready for judges to use. **CHARGE** tablets mid-day, if needed. **CLOSE** files and **TURN OFF** devices when scoring is complete.

During the Competition

4. View judges entering their scores, **CLICK** on these **CONTROL PANEL** buttons:
(individual judges) **"LIVE" JUDGE 1, 2, or 3**, or (multi-judge) view **PRINT JUDGES SCORES**.
5. **WATCH FOR TIES** – The office staff will need to watch for ties and break them based on association scoring rules. **CLICK** on the **"LIVE" CLASSES** button, follow the link and monitor the **Show Placings** column for ties. Once a tie is observed, office staff will need to break the tie and enter/type the adjusted placings in the far-right column headed (*Break Ties In This Column*).

Print Judges Scores for Team Coaches

6. **CLICK** the **PRINT JUDGES SCORES** button on the Control Panel to open the report and **CLICK** the print button icon located in the top tool bar. A print dialog screen will open where, if needed, you may change the print settings to your liking (change page breaks, change margins, print without grid lines, etc. When you are ready to proceed, **CLICK** the blue **NEXT** button (top-right corner) to send the report to your printer. *To print individual team scores*, you must first highlight the team's scoring columns, and then click the print icon button. On the print dialog screen, change the **Current Page** setting (at top) to **Selected Cells** and **Page Orientation** to **Portrait**.

7. After all ties are broken and the scoring is complete, print the show placings for your announcer. **CLICK** on the **PRINT SHOW PLACINGS** button and **OPEN** the report. If you have any additional announcements, a space is provided (msg. here) to type your message. When complete, **CLICK** the print button icon located in the top tool bar. A print dialog screen will open where, if needed, you may change the print settings to your liking (change page breaks, change margins, print without grid lines, etc. When you are ready to proceed, **CLICK** the blue **NEXT** button (top-right corner) to send the report to your printer.

Print Competition Reports

8. **SHOW RESULTS** - When all ties are broken and the show scoring is complete, print a complete record of all team scores and show placings. From the Control Panel, **CLICK** the **PRINT CLASS RESULTS**. When the report opens, **CLICK** the print button icon located in the top tool bar. A print dialog screen will open where, if needed, you may change the print settings to your liking (change page breaks, change margins, print without grid lines, etc. When you are ready to proceed, **CLICK** the blue **NEXT** button (top-right corner) to send the report to your printer.

JUDGES SCORES - **CLICK** on the **PRINT JUDGES SCORES** button to **OPEN** the report and **CLICK** on the print button icon located in the top tool bar. A print dialog screen will open where, if needed, you may change the print settings to your liking (change page breaks, change margins, print without grid lines, etc. When you are ready to proceed, **CLICK** the blue **NEXT** button (top-right corner) to send the report to your printer.

Reports from Your Last Competition *(if you haven't printed them yet)*

1. **CLASS RESULTS** - When all ties are broken and the show scoring is complete, print a record of your final show results. From the Control Panel, **CLICK** the **PRINT CLASS RESULTS**. When the report opens, **CLICK** the print button icon located in the top tool bar. A print dialog screen will open where, if needed, you may change the print settings to your liking (change page breaks, change margins, print without grid lines, etc. When you are ready to proceed, **CLICK** the blue **NEXT** button (top-right corner) to send the report to your printer.

JUDGES SCORES - **CLICK** on the **PRINT JUDGES SCORES** button to **OPEN** the report and **CLICK** the print button icon located in the top tool bar. A print dialog screen will open where, if needed, you may change the print settings to your liking (change page breaks, change margins, print without grid lines, etc. When you are ready to proceed, **CLICK** the blue **NEXT** button (top-right corner) to send the report to your printer.

Post Show Maintenance

2. After all association reports have been printed from the previous show, and prior to the next competition, the scores on all judge's scorecards must be cleared off to ready for the next round of scoring. From the Control Panel **CLICK** on "**LIVE**" **Judge 1** and **OPEN** the judge's scorecards. **HIGHLIGHT** and **DELETE** all scores entered for each class (see where to delete scores in the shaded areas in the [Post Show Maintenance](#) section of your User Guide. Double-check to make sure, all scores have been removed. When finished, close the file. Repeat the process for all judge's scorecards.

Live Show Scoring

"LIVE" Judges & Classes

"LIVE" JUDGES 1, 2 & 3 – From the Control Panel, **CLICK** the **"LIVE" JUDGE 1, 2, or 3** button, follow link to monitor the actual judge's scoring as it is entered into the scoring tablet or laptop. There may be a slight delay depending on the facility's Wi-Fi strength. Be on the lookout for any missing scores or unintentional blank cells in a team's scoring column. Bring it to the judge's attention for them to correct prior to printing. Also, there should only be positive number entries in score cells, NO periods, negative numbers, comas, asterisks, or characters of any kind.

Print Judges Scorecards

Judge 1, Judge 2, & Judge 3

PRINT JUDGES SCORECARDS – When judges have completed their class scoring, you can print the scorecards to be given to coaches at the end of your competition. *As a warning...please do not print too soon! Wait and make sure judges are done before you print.* **CLICK** the **PRINT JUDGES SCORES** button, follow the link to open the multi-judge scorecards. Scorecards may be printed to include all teams in a class or for an individual team only.

To print all team scores in a class at once, **CLICK** the print button icon located in the top tool bar. A print dialog screen will open where, if needed, you may change the print settings to your liking (change page breaks, change margins, print without grid lines, etc. When you are ready to proceed, Click the blue **NEXT** button (top-right corner) to send the report to your printer.

To print individual team scores, **first**, **HIGHLIGHT** the team's scoring columns (as shown below). Once the columns are highlighted, proceed to **CLICK** the print button icon located in the top tool bar. When the print dialog screen opens, (at the top) **CHANGE** the **Current sheet** to **Selected cells**, and the **Page orientation** to **Portrait**. Now only the selected cells that you highlighted will print.

When finished, close the file. **OPEN** the next "LIVE" Judge's scorecards and repeat the process for all judge scorecards. *You are now ready to set-up your next competition!*

Tips & Tricks

HIDING REPORT ROWS – Once you have completed the steps in the **PRE-SHOW SETUP** section, you may want to hide the extra rows in **“LIVE” CLASSES** and announcer’s **SHOW PLACINGS**. To do this, on the Control Panel **CLICK** on the **“LIVE” CLASSES** button to open the module, **CLICK** in the row number column (far-left) and **DRAG** downward to highlight the rows you want to hide, **Right-Click** the highlighted rows (example below of highlighted rows 16-27) and **SELECT** the **Hide Rows 16-27** in the drop-down menu. The rows will immediately be hidden and will not print in your reports. Repeat the same steps in **SHOW PLACINGS**.

Now, only the cells you selected will print.
