

Accelerated Services GM Quality Load Audit

| | Ensure that VIN in driver's device matches the VIN on the dash or driver's door plate Be sure to perform a quality inspection. Start at the driver's door moving counter clock wise around the |
|----------------------|---|
| | vehicle looking for impact damage. Be sure that all loose shipped items are accounted for |
| 0 | Take extra care when inspecting driver's door, front and rear bumpers, quarter panels and roofs (top 5 damage areas) |
| 0 | Ensure that loading skids are fully extended and decks are bridged before loading so no contact made |
| 0 | Beep the horn before backing vehicle out of bay-don't drive through bays ACCELERATED SERVICES |
| 0 | Do not exceed 5 MPH when loading or unloading GM vehicles. RTERS |
| 0 | Ensure that all windows are rolled up |
| 0 | Be sure to maintain 2" clearance for undercarriages, 3" between bumpers and a minimum of 5" between horizontal panels and decks above (roof, hood and deck lid) |
| 0 | All vehicles must be secured with 4 soft tie straps, 1 over each tire, centered in tread, straight down into decking-NO ANGLES |
| 0 | Are all decks pinned and secured? |
| 0 | Load height must be measured before leaving yard and at the dealer on multiple drop loads to ensure 13'6" |
