

Accelerated Services Nissan Quality Load Audit

0	Ensure that the driver is wearing clothing that will not harm Nissan vehicles (safety vest when required).
0	Are rings, watches, belt buckles, cell phones, etc. removed or covered before handling Nissan vehicles?
0	Driver must ensure that VIN on paperwork or in his device matches the VIN on the dash or driver's door.
0	Are gloves and hats removed before entering Nissan vehicles?
0	Be sure to perform a quality inspection. Start at the driver's door moving counter clock wise around the vehicle looking for impact damage. Be sure that all loose shipped items are accounted for.
0	Take extra care when inspecting driver's door, front and rear bumpers, quarter panels and roofs (top 5 damage areas).
0	Beep the horn before backing vehicle out of bay-don't drive through bays.
0	Driver must be sure to follow yard traffic pattern rules and posted speed limit.
0	Ensure that loading skids are fully extended, and decks are bridged before loading so no contact made.
0	Do not exceed 5 MPH when loading or unloading Nissan vehicles.
0	Ensure that all windows are rolled up.
0	Be sure to maintain a minimum 1" clearance between strap and vehicle, 2" clearance for undercarriages, 3" between bumpers and 5" between horizontal panels and decks above (roof, hood and deck lid).
0	Are all vehicles secured with 4 soft tie straps, 1 over each tire, centered in tread, straight down into decking, no contact with vehicle-NO ANGLES.
0	Are all decks pinned and secured?
0	Load height must be measured before leaving yard and at the dealer on multiple drop loads to ensure 13'6".
0	Is the loading area free of debris and oil spills?
