NEW BUSINESS

CO Road – County Roads sprayed both sides of the county as well as County Public Works yards in Pasco and Connell along with block wall areas Dent, Kohler and Burns Roads. FC Public Works has been billed in the amount of \$176163.14. Rain has been pretty beneficial for incorporating the herbicide on the roadsides! In addition, at the end of the year we will receive rebates for all the herbicide that we purchased from Envu. Should be somewhere over \$15000.00.

2026 Cost Share-We will be paying out 3 cost share applications that have been completed so far. A total of \$7505.17 to be paid out this month.

State Parks – We have started on State Parks working on early Kochia at Sacajawea Park and beginning Trail work as conditions allow. Working on Kochia Pre-post-emergence application. Park Rangers mowed an area off pretty well so that we could see the Kochia seedlings carpeting areas. Additionally, we started on the Columbia Plateau Trail at Ice Harbor past Levey Park.

Bonneville Power Administration- We will be reviewing powerline right of ways to be sprayed this spring.

Weed board – Gearing up for a very weedy year around the county!

Washington Vegetation Management Association- Looking for speakers that can speak on crops issues.

Coordinators conference- Held in Chelan March 11,12,13. Learning more about how weed boards operate.

Farm Fair – We attended the Farm Fair March 26-27. The goal of the Farm Fair is to increase agriculture literacy, knowledge, and awareness among youth. We spoke about how weeds spread and common weeds in our area. Great turn out, 850 students, 40 teachers and 20 booths set up for the kids to visit.
