**Roadside Spray Program** – Contact work and spot spraying completed. PW's has been billed in the amount of \$13,108.22 for application and chemical. Jerry Ellis, Wilbur Ellis; toured roads with Todd to assess the most problematic roads. A plan is being put together for a fall application.

**State Parks** –Kochia work performed at Sacajawea, test plots on tree-of-heaven

**BPA** – We have received payment in the amount of \$11,442.31. Craig Fackrell, BPA liaison is transferring to Spokane. Craig informs us he will continue to manage our contract from Spokane.

**WSDA White Bryony Grant** – Continuation from spraying performed in 2018 at Big Flat Habitat managed by USACOE), excavation of tubers

**BCWB**- Marcus and Wes spent a day on the Yakima Delta with BCWB and WDFW staff assisting with flowering rush control

#### FCWB –

Staff surveyed the Smith Canyon area and found large infestations of Scotch thistle and yellow starthistle. Todd has contacted landowners in the area to discuss the problem. Todd will propose a plan to landowners to begin noxious weed work. We hope the work will be ongoing. We are getting ready for the Benton Franklin Fair and Rodeo. Luis is working on adding fresh content to our video. We will showcase activities and field work.
