NEW BUSINESS

WSDA – Contract for the Tree of Heaven project has been received. Work will begin this fall. The contract runs through December 31, 2021. The project is funded for \$5000.00.

FC Roadside – Public Works has been sent a list of "Owner Will Maintain "areas that are not following through with their agreements. Pwk's will follow up with a letter to the individuals with a reminder of what is expected of landowners who opt out of the roadside spray program. Todd has been in conversation with John White, Road Supervisor, Connell and Craig Erdman, County Engineer. It has been decided that a fall application on specified roads will be made to use up remaining chemical. We have also been informed that there will be a push to increase the roadside spray budget.

FC Information Services – We have received payment in the amount of \$273.56 for spraying the Kahlotus cell tower.
