NEW BUSINESS

CO Road – We received payment from Public Works for roadside spraying \$171605.31. \$34090.65 for application charge and \$137514.66 for herbicide. Also, there was an additional check in the amount of \$3430.35 for additional herbicide. From here we will need to watch for Kochia. We still have about \$5000 available from Public Works.

Jerry Ellis – We did some test plots with a product called Altify for Jerry Ellis at Envu. Both test plots that we did were located along the rail road right of way adjacent to SR-395. One at Sagemoor Road the other at Russel Road.

Not Cost share- We have billed Richard Lathim \$14,326.00 for herbicide and aerial application on his lupine and Yellow Starthistle application. Looks like the application was pretty successful! Richard seemed to be pretty pleased with the results.

State Parks – We have finished State Parks applications. State Parks calendar year ends June 30. Second year of the biennium starts July 1, 2026. We will be billing out State parks shortly.

Bonneville Power Administration- We have finished surveying several line right of ways. And have billed Bonneville Power for survey and spraying on the Benton-Scootney line \$2,634.53 on the rebuild of that line. Unfortunately, we did not max out the available funds on that contract. Our annual survey and spray contract were also billed in the amount of \$13,100.00.

Annual Report- 2025 Annual Report has been completed.

Weed board – Gathering our records and time doing applications in order to bill State Parks. We have made a return to the Scotch thistle around Moon Road area to clean up as much as possible on the returning Scotch thistle. It looks a whole lot cleaner so far as what we have looked over so far. There is some additional area left to survey and spray but very much improved since a couple of years ago. We will be doing some surveying and spraying around Connell in the next week or 2 to clean up Scotch Thistle and Kochia.
