

There are numerous passages in the Bible that command and model for us, prayer. This is one of the reasons why prayer is one of our core values. Prayer is the spiritual discipline by which we communicate with the one true God. It is through prayer that we do battle with anxiety as Paul tells us in Philippians "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made know to God." We are told to "…pray without ceasing" in 1 Thessalonians and Ephesians. Prayer is an important part of confession and repentance. And it is through prayer and God's word (Bible) that we are able to discern what God's will is. As a church that desires to do God's will, we must not only prioritize the Word, we must also prioritize prayer.

This is something that God has been impressing on my over the last couple of years. So in 2025 this is how we are going to prioritize praying together as a church:

#1 Continue to have a portion of our worship service dedicated to prayer. And including the Prayer Gram in the Sermon Notes.

#2 Starting January 12th we will have Praise & Prayer @ 5-6pm on Sundays. During this time we will sing a couple of songs and then spend the majority of time in prayer. There will be a prayer guide each week, with prayer prompts. This event will eventually transition into Home Groups where we will have a Home group every day of the week, praying for our church, among other things. People will sign-up for Host and to join one of the groups. If you would like to Host a group (13 week commitment) be looking for information, coming in February. The idea is joining in unity to pray together with our brothers and sisters in Christ and to bathe our church in prayer. Asking God to lead, bless and build His church.

#3 Re-Launching our prayer team! This year we are going to assemble and train people to serve on our prayer team. This team is going to be responsible for praying for events, praying regularly for our church privately, praying for and following up with the church wide prayer list, gathering together to pray...etc. Basically this team is going to help keep our church praying through example and encouragement.

Every great movement of God started with prayer! I believe that God wants to do a great movement here at Castlewood, for His Glory and to make great His Name! I hope you will join me (Pastor John) in prayer this year. Both privately and corporately as a church together. Will you commit to praying that God would reclaim His glory here in this community that surrounds our church. Will you commit to praying how He wants you to participate and engage with His will for Castlewood and for yourself. I am excited to see how the Lord will answer our prayers this year and hope that you too are looking with joyful anticipation for the ways that God is going to move in 2025.



CORE VALUE: DISCIPLESHIP

Discipleship is another one of our Core Values. Why? Simply because it is the mission our savior gave to us and the means by which His people are to grow in their sanctification and produce more worship on this earth. I once read a quote attributed to John Piper which said "Missions exists because worship does not." What he means is that as long as there are people not worshipping Jesus then there is a need for missions.

Missions and Evangelism are parts of discipleship. Look at the verses below, Jesus commands His people to "Make disciples of all nations". How do we accomplish this task of disciple-making? Going (Missions and Evangelism), Baptizing, and Teaching (Discipleship). Disciple-making involves all three.

Earlier in this publication I talked about the Missions Offering. This is one step towards moving us to be a church that is "Going" to the nations, taking with us the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Once someone has declared their loyal to the King of Kings through the transforming and life giving work of the Holy Spirit in their life they declare publicly through believer's baptism that they have devoted their life to following Christ. And at Castlewood at this time we connect them with someone to carryout the last step of making a disciple, "teaching" them how to obey Christ.

Over the last month, as of the writing of this article, God has been leading and providing clarity on what discipleship is supposed to look like at Castlewood. One of the objectives is helping people to realize what Robby Gallaty so simply stated in his book *Replicate* "Jesus didn't just save us from sin; He saved us for something." If Jesus only saved us from our sins then there would be no reason for us to remain here on earth. However, Jesus does save us for something. I believe in part that something is Making Disciples who Make Disciples.

So what does this look like in 2025 at Castlewood Baptist Church. The short answer is I am still working that out with the Lord. But one thing I do know is that we are going to be more intentional about moving people along from one stage to the next. One goal I have for 2025 is that at least 50% of our members will be ready to take a new believer through our Discipleship pathway. Leading those new believers to becoming disciplers themselves.

Regardless of the details that will be forth coming, I hope that you realize that your salvation was not a finish line, but rather the starting line. That Jesus has indeed saved you for something, and my hope is that you will discover that something this year!

So in 2025 I will begin approaching and training people to do the work of ministry and using their spiritual gifts for the building up of the body of Christ (the church).

I would encourage you to begin thinking about the various talents that the Lord has given to you, and the different spiritual gifts He has equipped you with (don't worry if you can't think of them I will help you).

Doing the work of ministry is not an optional thing when it comes to being a part of the the body of Christ/a Christian. Just like discipleship and disciple-making is not optional. My (pastor John) role is to equip you to do that work.

Discipleship and this will go hand in hand because part of being equipped to do the work of ministry is by living an obedient life that is producing the fruit of the Spirit. We have many opportunities and needs to serve at Castlewood. For example you can serve:

- Children's Ministry
- Youth Ministry
- Stewardship Team
- Personnel Team
- Welcome Ministry
- Prayer Ministry
- Grief Share Ministry
- Food Truck Ministry

Those are just a few options and there are more. My goal is to help you find how God has created and gifted you to serve and to equip you to do just that in 2025.
