Padmasambhava Yoga & Meditation Centre

All at the Centre hope you are well and enjoying meeting family and friends, going out and about and having good and happy times.

Padmasambhava hopes we will have good weather with much sunshine and warm days, for this should uplift our spirits and raise our energy. Visiting the seaside, seeing different places, meeting more people helps to widen our horizons and gives us both physical and mental freedom. We can harness and use this energy for all our endeavours and creativity and when we need to slow down, yoga has the tools to bring about balance through awareness, breathing practices, relaxation and meditation.

While Padmasambhava has now closed for the summer break, the Centre is currently preparing the Autumn term timetable. They are now taking names for the new Beginners course, starting in September. The Beginners class is suitable for every body, no matter your age or fitness level. This course introduces a progressive series of practices which help release joints, as well as physical tensions within the body, and increase flexibility and strength. This foundation course introduces tools which are useful in daily life. Time is spent in each class on breathing practices which reduce stress, improve mood and focus, and develops strength in the lungs. Classes finish with a deep relaxation to allow the body and mind to rest on all levels, renewing vitality. Closer to the time the Centre will consider whether this class will be held in person or via Zoom.

For the time being, Padmasambhava continues to teach via Zoom. These classes have been well-received. Help is given, as needed, to become familiar with Zoom. Many students have been surprised by how much value they find in the sense of practicing together, as part of a group, using technology. Padmasambhava offers a mixture of classes online via Zoom – from the Monday morning chair yoga, to a mixed daytime class on Tuesdays and a selection of more experienced evening classes.

Padmasambhava yoga classes offer so much more than just the physical aspects of yoga. They can help you to improve your health by introducing you to breathing



practices (especially good for people with asthmatic conditions), flexibility of the body and joints, beneficial for anyone with arthritis. Yoga Nidra and meditation, both of which are extremely beneficial to people with high blood pressure, angina and heart problems also help to relieve stress through relaxation. That is not all, for having achieved these improvements, help is given on how to maintain this healthy you. Teachers are made aware of any health problems that students may have, instructions for all postures take this into consideration. The number of students in each class is kept to a comfortable number.

Whilst the Centre is closed for the summer, it is still there for students old and new – so please do call Padmasambhava if you would like help or guidance or resources for practice. A few simple practices can provide the tools to enhance our awareness and begin to make a difference to the state of our minds, our health, our energy, as well as relax the body – and taking quieter time helps with developing a sense of well-being. A VISUAL REFLECTION ON THE LAST YEAR

Globally many artists' work has been impacted by the pandemic but for the Carmarthen Artists' Network this has provided inspiration for a new exhibition of works at the Llanwrtyd and District Heritage and Arts Centre entitled 'Strange Times Indeed'.

The CAN was set up in 2011 for arts graduates to provide creative support for contemporary artists living in West Wales and members have spent the past five years working collaboratively with the National Botanic Garden of Wales' Regency landscape restoration project. The group has exhibited regularly since its inception, but are exhibiting at the Heritage Centre for the first time throughout August.

The variety of displays is extensive with artists specialising in different forms and styles, using sculpture, textiles, prints, eyanotypes, collage, painting and ceramics

The importance of gardening during lockdown is echoed in hand-built porcelain pots with patterned sprigging and scraffito, inspired by the Acoma Pueblo of New Mexico, who traditionally use the seed heads for storage, whilst 'Just Keeping in Touch' are tactile, night sky acrylic paintings which will resonate with the experiences of many people who found original ways to deal with the lack of contact with others.

Other inspiration includes the planet earth which has stimulated several art works including an intricate textile design. based on the surface textures and patterning found on the hard surfaces of stones, but worked in soft, sheep's wool and colourful plant form sculptures, produced from lead, iron and steel.

Using a very early form of photography, cyanotypes involve just the sun, oxide infused paper and plants, 'Magic Moments' emerge as delicate botanical images on a deep blue background, offering enchanting glimpses into the structures of plants.

Sculptures entitled 'The Beauties' are an affectionate recreation of the female form, and, to commemorate the anniversary of the death of the boxer, a small bronze of Muhammed Ali and the boy in the Startright Shoes was created, inspired by a photographic tribute on the day he died.

The 'Strange Times Indeed' exhibition is a colourful, lively mixture of art and illustrates that creativity can blossom, thrive and inspire both the artist and viewer and we hope you will be delighted by the range of skills and creativity portrayed in the exhibition.

The Centre is open Thursday to Sunday 10am to 4pm with precautions in place to protect visitors and staff.

FACEMASKS... A DIFFERENT **PERSPECTIVE**

If you see a person not wearing a facemask what do YOU think? Do you assume that they are being disrespectful?

I overheard a local shop keeper call any who does not wear a mask an IDIOT. A delivery man say they should be shot... I could go on...

I am a Nurse and a woman who is not able to wear a mask. I am medically exempt. I carry a card and am happy to show this to anyone who thinks I might be being.. difficult.

I am writing this as a reminder and a request to consider those who are not able to wear masks to think about how you might instantly JUDGE those those who are not.

As a person who does not wear a mask I find it very hard to go out. I am met by shops which state: NO MASK :NO ENTRY. While I have not looked into the legality of this, I do know that being constantly met with doors notices saying I cannot enter, shops which use tannoys to continually urge the wearing of masks is difficult.

Harder, my fellow humans staring, giving me angry looks and suddenly, violently diverting their journey to keep far away from me and name calling. I, like others am not immune to the very real pain this creates on a daily basis in my life.

Of course I understand, people are scared. As a Nurse I know that FEAR will shut down the protection we naturally have against any virus ..it shuts down the immune system. And I understand It is hard to not be fearful at times. I fear going out and getting shouted at and even physically attacked as I know other people who not not wear masks literally have been.

Those of us who do not wear masks are regularly met with blind judgement that is akin to racism, homophobia and anti Semitism.

If you feel fear around those who are unable to wear a mask then I ask you to consider that they might not be: purposely out to get you! And I offer that you acknowledge your fear and calmly keep a distance/ do what makes YOU feel safer, rather than attack /blame and shame someone that you not know.

There are some that do not wear masks and call others Sheep. There are some that wear masks and call others worse names than idiot. Neither side is understanding each



other. Both sides are fearful and acting out of ignorance.

We are living in a time where information from many sides is manipulated and confusing. We don't know who to trust and we feel deeply unsettled.

The majority of us have been negatively affected by this whole situation. We are dealing with illness, extreme fear, grief and more. I do know that when we come together we are stronger and can support each other. We are all made of the same stuff. Blame, isolation, name calling, judgement is fostered by the media. It is an energy that is rooted in fear hatred and separation and importantly makes us sick.

The next time you see a person without a mask, take a moment to wonder why. Notice how you feel. Are you judging them without knowing the FACTS.

More than ever I feel this is a time to come together and understand others, have compassion for others. And this can extend to different opinions too.

How about looking beyond whether someone is wearing a mask. Considering that perhaps they might have Lung cancer, they might have been been violently abused in a way where wearing a mask would trigger a reaction that would be life threatening, they might have severe allergies... etc etc etc. As the Government website states, there are many reasons for not being able to wear a mask.

If you feel extreme fear of catching a virus and this is really impacting you it is very understandable. Help is available. When we learn to respect and feel our fearful feelings we do not have to blame others for them. We can take responsibility and empower ourselves. You can learn how to calm your nervous system and you can seek support. There is no shame in this, we all feel fear.

How about not viewing everyone who is not wearing a mask as a trouble maker, stupid or that they just don't care? How about the possibility that they are just a fellow human being who is trying to do the best they can.

If you own a shop or restaurant etc how about displaying a lawful sign which says medically exempt non masks wearers are welcome?

How about changing your town or establishment from a fear-full place into a place that trusts that people are basically good, a place that respects and does not discriminate against difference?

Wouldn't it be great if we all took sensible precautions and open our minds and hearts to create environment's of respect and safety for each other?




