We do so look forward to Christmas and all those things regular and traditional - except that last Christmas, NOTHING was regular nor the way we have always done them. Inside and outside our homes, our familiar routines were disrupted - and things have not really settled down yet. At our Church of St Michael, Llanfihangel Rhos y Corn, perched up on top of the edge of the Cambrian Mountains in the Brechfa Forest, services were still cancelled so the celebration of Christmas 2020 inside the building couldn't happen and the doors were locked.

This year things are looking brighter with regular services resuming, and the first part of the Christmas celebration will be revealed at the first Sunday in December at the 2.30pm service with the windows once again beautifully decorated by our "angels", our volunteers, displaying their individual takes on Christmas with imagination and creativity. Menter Dinefwr's new centre, Hengwrt, in Llandeilo will open its doors in time for Christmas following substantial refurbishment.

Hengwrt is a new community centre located on Carmarthen Street, and from 25 November to 24 December the centre will be open to the public to celebrate Christmas with various pop-up shops by local businesses. The centre will also house a new branch of Cyfoes, Menter Dinefwr's shop, selling books and all sorts of Welsh merchandise.

The move marks the end of the first phase of Hengwrt's restoration, which was in poor condition when it was transferred to Menter Dinefwr from Llandeilo Town Council in 2018. Since then, the centre has been completely renovated to make it fit for a wide range of community uses.

Phase 1 has included a complete refurbishment of the building ready for the Christmas opening, and phase 2 will include the development of a heritage and visitor centre, together with room hire and offices, to be developed early in 2022.

Chief Executive Owain Gruffydd said, "We were fortunate that the building work could continue throughout most of the pandemic, and although there were challenges and delays, we are extremely proud of what has been achieved and can't wait to share it with the community. We would also like to thank our contractors TAD Builders, for their cooperation and for getting the project completed ready for the Christmas period."

Non Edwards, Menter Dinefwr's Commercial Services Manager added, "Opening a new branch of Cyfoes in Llandeilo is very exciting, and we're glad to be able to offer smaller businesses a space in the town centre, especially in the run up to Christmas."

Menter Dinefwr, a local community enterprise, secured funding to refurbish the building in 2018, following vast consultation where the need to create a multi-use building including meeting rooms, office space, and a heritage visitor centre was identified. Hengwrt will also house community artwork, town memorabilia, and will be a hub for activities and events, together with being the headquarters for Llandeilo Town Council.

Menter Dinefwr is a community enterprise established in 1999. The organisation works to promote the use of the Welsh language, and to support community and economic development. It has grown substantially over the last 20 years and is looking forward to opening its new flagship project in Llandeilo.

LOW-CARBON SOLUTION IN TALLEY



lan and Adelle moved from a modern property on the gas grid into an 1820s stone cottage and barn conversion with a multi-fuel Rayburn. 

It seems unbelievable that the Powell family of Llanwrda are facing the third anniversary of the disappearance of their much loved (and very distinctive looking) sheep dog Spot. Wednesday December 5th 2018 is a day date forever etched in their minds; the day when they took a call informing them the Spot had disappeared from another farm in Gwyfe SA19, where she was being trained as a sheepdog. Sadly, they are still no further on as to knowing what happened to Spot that day; unfortunately there was a 24 hour delay before the Powells were informed by the trainer. 24 crucial hours. Someone must know something.

It cannot be stated strongly enough that back in 2018 it was inconceivable that Spot would not be found or located. The Powell family have never, ever given up hope of finding Spot. Since that day so much has been undertaken and put in place in a bid to find her. They are extremely grateful for the huge ongoing support and help, that they have received from the local community and, also from further afield from people they have never met. Kindly enquiries from local people about Spot are very much appreciated because it means that people haven't forgotten about her; they have never wavered in their hope that one day she will be back with them, where she rightfully belongs. Spot was more than a working dog, she was part of the family. The more cynical might think that they are hoping for the impossible; however, Missing Dogs Team Wales (a volunteer group who are on Facebook) update followers with news of dogs returned to their owners even after an absence of longer than two years. Celebration of these reunions go viral on social media and this strongly suggests that people should never give up hope. It goes without saying that the Powell family will never give up on Spot.

So what has been done in a bid to find Spot during the past three years?

- · A huge social media campaign spanning Facebook and Twitter; this is on going
- · Messages and sharing of possible dogs similar to Spot



description have been followed up. These have come from all over the UK and Ireland

- An extensive poster campaign in the SA19 locality immediately after she was reported as missing
- A poster campaign in call centres in Merthyr and Cardiff and in the South Wales Valleys
- · Scenting strategies were put in to action immediately, despite the 24 hour lag of the family being informed she was missing by the trainer.
- · Dog tracking
- The following up of potential sightings locally.
- · Food stations and night cameras were set up and checked every single day in all weathers
- Liaison with the Dyfed- Powys police force and the Rural Crime Team
- · Legal advice has been sought
- Custom made banners displayed at key locations
- · Adverts and articles in Countryman's Weekly and Agri Trader

REGGAE SOUNDSYSTEM CULTURE IN CARMARTHENSHIRE

Hand built Reggae Sound Systems originated in Jamaica. They are surprisingly alive and well here in Wales, thanks to a few enthusiasts. Possibly the only one in Carmarthenshire playing roots reggae music is the Real Roots Sound System (see photograph).

Real Roots Sound System was originally from Brixton, London. Brixton was the birth place of Sound Systems in the U.K, when a man called Duke Vin played on his in 1955. Real Roots is waving the flag and promoting this niche culture and the roots reggae music that goes with it.

Hand built wooden speaker boxes and hand built analogue equipment, strictly vinyl (records) gets played, and gives this sound system its unique special sound of its own. Every sound system sounds and looks a little different. Big bass speakers, mid range and high top speakers make up a system for a balanced sound. The music is bass lead throughout sound system culture, but roots reggae music is in a class of it's own. Roots reggae has spiritual, inspirational lyrics often singing about god and the struggles of ghetto life. Roots reggae was born in Jamaica in the 1970s but has grown up here in the U.K.

South Wales has a long history with Jamaica for generations now. Here in Wales it's fantastic that this incredible tradition is kept alive. Look out for any local sound system events near you. (Not to be confused with the illegal rave scene!)

After weeks of rain there is finally a glimmer of sunshine allowing us all to get out and do a good stint in the garden. The last few weeks have been spent bulb planting at Aberglasney and with literally thousands to do there is a good deal of trepidation involved.

Planting bulbs in grass or lawns is an excellent way to increase all year-round interest. In fact, some of the best garden features I have seen have been simply a tree in a lawn with bulbs planted underneath. This may seem basic but a nice tree with good flower and autumn colour underplanted with spring and autumn flowering bulbs can give a huge amount of pleasure for very little cost or effort. There is an added incentive as the grass needs to be cut a little less often, which for some of us, is a real help.

One thing I did not realise was that the Towy valley has some of the best dairy land in the country. What this means is the grass grows seriously quickly for most of the year. With about four acres of amenity and pedestrian mown grass, cutting it takes a huge amount of time. Cut grass is always good to see but can we get a little more interest out of it? Adding bulbs is one way and something we do a lot. It's a great idea, with one down fall, you must wait for the bulbs to die down before you cut the grass. This is a particular problem with Narcissus (daffodil) as they can look messy for a long time after flowering. The trick then is to plant them in long grass areas which are cut less, and the dying stems can be hidden in the grass.

A careful choice of bulbs can get round this problem quite easily. If you grow early spring flowering bulbs like Scilla and Crocus, or autumn flowering Crocus, the grass grows more slowly and they have the added advantage of dying back very quickly after flowering. There is a huge drift of Scilla at Kew gardens which flowers in March-April and the grass can be cut back about week or two after flowering. This means the area never gets overgrown and there is about a three-week splash of colour.

When planting in grass larger quantities of bulbs are usually needed but the same principle applies. Generally naturalistic plantings work best. For instance we have thousands of Crocus planted in the lawn below the Yew tunnel. The idea of planting this number of bulbs is very daunting but there are a few tricks that can make the job a little easier. Both bulbs can be planted about two and a half times their depth which because they are only about a centimetre tall roughly works out to the depth of a thick

piece of turf. By pulling back the strip of turf but not removing it (like a flap) you create a pretty good planting hole into which a small hand full of bulbs can be scattered.

The hard part is keeping the planting natural. There are a couple of tricks we use such as different sized holes with the flaps in different directions and using a normal bulb planter to add in smaller clumps. If the turf is gently pressed back down, then the bulbs should not be damaged. If they have sprouted a little, then they will damage more easily and although not ideal it can be better to lie them on their sides. It's best to do this job when there is plenty of moisture around as it will allow the turf to re-establish more easily. Taking a few photographs of the planting before the holes are filled in can be helpful later in the season especially when it's time to mow. Naturalising bulbs in lawns can really add to spring and autumn interest without causing lawn mowing headaches. The real trick is careful placing and choice of bulbs, for advice on this specialist bulb growers are probably the most helpful.

TIPS FOR THE MONTH

- · Make the most of the dry weather and do any digging
- It's not too late to plant latter flowering bulbs like Tulips
- This is about the last chance to buy and plant wall flowers
- If you have free draining soil onion and garlic sets can be planted
- · Grease band fruit trees
- · It's not too late to plant up winter baskets

Individuals/Groups/organisations will now submit a project proposal form for funding for their cause/ project. (Full criteria are listed below). Please complete the proposal form (see above) and submit it, with your digital teaser, to any of the following places:

Coop, Mary Ellen 139, Post Office or email them to christophffischer@googlemail.com, owenjames@menterbrodinefwr.cymru or message the Llandeilo Community Action Hub on Facebook before 1pm 20/12/2021.

You must also provide a short digital teaser explaining the project. (Support available on request). If accepted, you will be invited to attend the Participatory Budgeting Community Event in February, which will be held at Hengwrt and online. We will share all digital teasers on social media, from January, to promote the ideas put forward.

At the event, the community will be in attendance in person and on-line and they will vote on the projects being presented to them. 1 person, 1 vote. Each participant will be required to give a presentation/pitch to the community. Maximum 5-minute time limit.

Votes are collated, and the winning projects will be announced on the day.

Support is available throughout the process.

Eligibility Criteria

Your proposal must be legitimate, honest, and open

Those bidding can be from a constituted group; meaning that a voluntary group, 3rd Sector, community group, charity, PTAs, sports clubs and any group that will benefit the Llandeilo community can apply.


Although applicants do not have to be from a constituted group there either has to be evidence of an existing bank account or a process to have a constituted group manage the funding on their behalf.


One amazing achievement accomplished by Doug

"Might as well" said Doug. So they carried on. And on. And on. And Well, by the time they stopped walking they had walked the whole of the Wales Coastal Path. Every inch of it. Anglesey (Ynys Môn) included. 874 miles of it. The exact same mileage as it is from John o' Groats to Lands End but without a bit of tarmac in sight. It was a truly incredible achievement by both of them. Especially so as they had to take 2 cars, drive to the walk, park one car, drive on, park the second car, walk back to the first car, pick up the second car, drive back to the first car and then drive home!
