CMG wants to find out more about their current status, the habitats where glow worms still live and whether a reintroduction project is feasible. Glow worms glow in June and July – so please look out for them. For a good introduction to glow worms, read the "about glow worms" section on this website: www. glowworms.org.uk.

CMG is working with partners: National Botanic Gardens of Wales; Initiative for Nature Conservation Cymru; and West Wales Biodiversity Information Centre to pull in technical knowledge and ensure long term records are retained. Further information will be posted on the group's website:

Schools of Hope

Since lockdown, here in Llandovery we have been hoping and praying that the Schools of Hope, staff and pupils, are staying safe and managing to continue with their studies. Enthusiasm for learning is stronger than ever even though messages received over the past few weeks show that life has become even tougher for those living in the slums of Kenya. Loss of employment (without any compensation), food shortages, the impossibilities of remaining at home in already cramped conditions and the indignity of having to pay for using toilets which have to be shared with several other households have compounded the situation. Updates and videos providing a rare insight into everyday life in the slums of Kenya can be found on ChallengeAid's Facebook, Twitter and Instagram accounts.

Residents have been receiving some help during the coronavirus outbreak; supervisors and committee members have been delivering food aid to families in the slums, including SoH pupils. Most of the food aid has been donated by the Visa Oshwal Community of Nairobi, a Jain community committed to the principle of SEVA (helping the needy) during this difficult time.

Meanwhile back in the UK, fund raising efforts continue in spite of the lockdown. In particular, we encourage as many as possible to cheer on Phil Walker who is doing 150 burpees every day in support of charities including ChallengeAid. His target is £26,000 and donations can be made going to uk.virginmoneygiving.com/PhilWalker17. You can also check out his progress on the ChallengeAid Facebook page.





SOCIALLY DISTANT BUT ALWAYS ON DUTY - USING TECHNOLOGY TO CATCH WASTE CRIMINALS



Natural Resources Wales (NRW) is using high-tech surveillance techniques to tackle unscrupulous waste operators seeking to take advantage of the Coronavirus crisis

Government guidelines on social distancing mean NRW officers are unable to use their usual investigation methods. As such, they have turned to sophisticated drone technology and satellite cameras to help in the tracking of waste criminals.

The new approach includes:

Using drone footage to investigate illegal waste disposal. Participating and benefiting from research and tools created in partnership with the Scottish Environment Protection Agency through the Life SMART Waste Project.

Trialling the use of satellite imagery obtained from the European Space Agency, as well as high resolution commercial satellite data.

Adrian Evans, head of NRW's Tackling Waste Crime initiative, explained:

"Social distancing is impacting on how companies supplying goods and services operate and waste criminals are taking advantage of this.

"We have had to modify our ways of working by developing technological solutions to support our work and ensure that waste operators comply with environmental regulations.

"This technology will ensure the environment of Wales is protected for the people who live here and for legitimate waste operators who abide by the rules and work in a responsible manner.

"Those hoping to exploit the lockdown restrictions to commit waste crime should think again. We have the capability and technology to continue to identify and pursue those that flout the law."

This type of surveillance is already underway in south east Wales, where NRW and Gwent Police are using drones to investigate illegal activity.

PC Matt Andrews, who, as part of Gwent Police's Rural Crime team, is the embedded officer with NRW and assists the South East Wales Operations team in tackling all types off illegal activity, said:

"During lockdown our waste team continues to have close communications with permitted waste sites, but we've also strived to find alternative ways to having boots on the ground.

"Drone work has helped us investigate illegal activity in remote locations while adhering to the social distancing guidelines.

"For example, the imagery can be used to identify the extent of illegal tipping on land which would normally take two NRW waste officers to physically investigate."




