

The countryside and our gardens are starting to look really colourful and fresh with trees and flowers in bloom, bringing wonderful scents to us all, and birds, bees, butterflies and many insects enjoying this time as well. All is action, movement and dynamism. Many students have been surprised by how much value they find in the sense of practicing together, once again, as part of a group, using technology. Help is given, as needed, to become familiar with Zoom.

Padmasambhava is now taking names for the new Beginners course, starting in September. The Beginners class is suitable for every body, no matter your age or fitness level. This course introduces a progressive series of practices which help release joints and increase flexibility and strength. This foundation course introduces tools which are useful in daily life. Time is spent in each class on breathing practices which reduce stress, improve mood and focus, as well as develop strength in the lungs. Classes finish with a deep relaxation which allows the body and mind to rest on all levels, renewing vitality.

Padmasambhava yoga classes offer so much more than just the physical aspects of yoga. They can help you to



improve your health by introducing you to breathing practises (especially good for people with asthmatic conditions), flexibility of the body and joints, beneficial for anyone with arthritis. Yoga Nidra and meditation, both of which are extremely beneficial to people with high blood pressure, angina and heart problems also help to relieve stress through relaxation. That is not all, for having achieved these improvements help is given on how to maintain this healthy you. Even if it didn't end how you imagined or hoped you took time out to something you chose to do, letting go of the everyday stresses even for just a few minutes can be beneficial to our wellbeing. To give you a bit of creative inspiration you'll always find a simple crafty project in the window that you can snap on your phone to try at home, I'll change it regularly and try and cover as many crafts as we can. I'm mad about free machine embroidery; using small

scraps of fabric to create pictures adding detail with the sewing machine where it becomes your 'pen'. I am self-taught, developing my own style and techniques and I love to pass those on to others; Covid restrictions permitting workshops are being planned along with craft and chat/ knit and natter/ make and moan groups, getting together with other makers is often very inspiring. This is a great way of using up all those small scraps of fabric left over from other makes that you don't know what to do with but can't bear to throw away!

On the 'waste not' principle I have been mindful of our environment when looking at stock; our sewing threads are made from recycle plastic bottles as is our toy stuffing, cushion pads and satin ribbon range. We have pure silk and cotton ribbons and a lovely selection of wooden buttons. All of which we sell by the metre or individually helping to reduce waste and harking back to traditional times! Whilst we cannot eliminate plastic packaging, we recycle what arrives with our deliveries and we only use paper bags. I am proud to support small independent businesses like Bumblebees, we have ranges from all over the world as well as locally sourced; patterns from Merchant & Mills, craft papers from Craft Consortium, tweeds from Abraham Moon, British yarn from Eden Cottage and I am delighted to be stocking local wool from the Cambrian Wool Mill.

So next time you're in town call in, say hello and maybe even inspired to try something creative!

P.S I'm sorry I don't do alterations but if there are any talented, confident dress makers who would like to please do get in touch, I'm often asked and it would be lovely to be able to offer this service.

## SUPER-SIZE WIND TURBINE PROPOSALS

A Cornish development company has been very busy during the lockdowns selecting internet data on farmers and landowners in Carmarthenshire and sending out letters with tempting offers to put up wind turbines on their properties. All the landowner has to do is provide a signature. Because of lockdown restrictions, it is unlikely that the developers surveyed the sites before selecting the locations for their mail-shots. Whereas most people are wary of receiving unsolicited offers through the post, that look too good to be true, others can be tempted. Especially if they don't live close to the site or they are unaware or careless of the stress and upset that previous proposals of this kind have caused to communities and residents that do.

It should be remembered that wind turbine developers and power cable owners enjoy generous remunerations, paid out of the public purse, and so it is in their interest to install the largest machine possible and at the furthest distance possible from the towns and cities where the energy is required.

Clean Earth Energy Ltd. has put in pre-planning 'screening opinions' for three very large wind turbines in Towy valley locations. That is, requesting the CCC Planning Department to provide the applicant with details of any areas, typically environmental, that have to be addressed in the full planning applications.



## COUNCILLOR URGES YOUNG PEOPLE AND WOMEN TO GET INVOLVED

Llandeilo town councillor Christoph Fischer calls on people of Llandeilo to consider standing for town council at the next election in May 2022 and to attend council meetings.

"We're currently not at all representative of the people of Llandeilo," Fischer laments, "especially as most of us stood unopposed for office. There were few contested seats in the last decade. It's come so far that people on Facebook do question town councillors' legitimacy because these people don't remember ever voting for us."

At present there are only two councillors under the age of 50 in Llandeilo Town Council and only three women out of 12 (or 15 if you count the officers). In 2017 seven people stood in Towy Ward for the six seats whereas in Castle Ward it was six candidates for six people without an election.

"We're in desperate need for fresh blood and ideas," claims Fischer. "While we have plenty of experience and talent on the council, there is a tendency to stick to the old."

Fischer tabled a motion in December to allow the public access to council zoom meetings and allow them to speak. Despite its simplicity it was – buried in a full review of all 70+ standing orders - referred to a Procedural Committee meeting in January, leading to a total of three extra procedural meetings. In the end this didn't come to full council as motion again until March. A request for a special motion on how to use zoom for council meetings with members of the public attending delayed the process by another month.

"This is frustrating as zoom is simple to use and other councils have managed to handle this quickly due to an openness and their better understanding of the technology available. Welsh Government suspended the requirement to make our meetings public during the pandemic, but we were actually not aware of this at the time and also never lost the option to keep them public if we so chose. The bureaucracy and slow speed I encountered in this show the need for a more balanced council. Particularly in Lock down people would have had the time to tune into our meetings and get an appetite to get involved."

"Key to change is for us to be transparent and accessible," says Fischer. "People don't see us in action and don't hear what councillors stand for. If people don't see how we work, they will not want to go to the ballot box, nor get involved. We could struggle for new councillors when others retire."

Council meetings are now being held again face to face and up to five visitors will be allowed to attend (but not speak at) those meetings.

"This is some progress but nothing compared to our neighbours in Manordeilo & Salem who for some time freely publish a link to their zoom meeting for the public to join and warmly welcome those who do."

Although this year's annual conference of the Physicians of Myddfai Society, which was due to have been held at the end of June, has had to be cancelled because of the Coronavirus pandemic. the society hopes to present the cancelled programme next year.

The Society's secretary, Dr Donald Williams, said this year's cancellation was unavoidable in view of the current situation. "We regret having to disappoint those who had agreed to take part and the people who were looking forward to attend. However, we plan to reschedule the event for next year."

The conference would have concentrated on herbal medicine, from the remedies of early physicians to the work of a modern medical herbalist. A forgotten Welsh herbalist, David Thomas Jones was on the programme, together with a new Physic Garden which has been created in Cowbridge.

One of the highlights of the conference was a talk by artist William Wilkins, the founder chairman of the Welsh Historic Gardens Trust and a descendant of the doctors of Myddfai. It has been involved in the creation of a tablet to commemorate the Physicians of Myddfai in the Myddfai Room at Swansea University's new Department of Pharmacy. It has also been agreed in principle to contribute towards the upkeep of the garden at Myddfai Community Hall.


