Wildlife Trusts in Wales launch a youth climate change project, **Stand for Nature Wales**

For the next three years, Wildlife Trusts in Wales will work to empower and inspire young people to take action for nature and wildlife in their local area in a bid to tackle climate change. From urban Cardiff to rural Montgomeryshire, young people are standing for nature and their futures.

There has never been a more important time to take action for nature. We are currently facing a climate and nature emergency, with 17% of species in Wales at risk of extinction. But we can change this. By putting nature into recovery, we can tackle climate change. Thriving habitats can safely lock up vast amounts of carbon, while providing other vital benefits that help us adapt, such as flood prevention, clean water and improved health and wellbeing.



LIT FEST FOUNDER RECEIVES COMMUNITY RECOGNITION



CAVS branded Llandeilo resident Christoph Fischer "a selfless, charitable, humanitarian with a heart of gold."

Further, their recognition award says: "Christoph has been pivotal during the pandemic in supporting the local community and people in need while continuing to be a proactive member of Llandeilo Town Council and Chair of a very successful Festival of Senses."

Christoph moved to Llandeilo with his Welsh husband 6 years ago and within a year had set up a popular local Literature Festival in town.He joined the town council, helped revive the Llandeilo Chamber of Trade, brought Town WiFi to town and reluctantly stepped in to save a leaderless Festival of Senses. During the pandemic he set up a volunteer network for the Covid Support Group and co-founded a few new initiatives, such as litter picking group Taclo, Ffrindiau Parc Penlan Park Friends, Llandeilo Children and Youth Society (Youth Club Initiative), Fair Trade Llandeilo and the LLandeilo Community Action Hub.

While the Covid group and the Lit Fest received several awards for their work as a group, this is the first time someone has officially recognised Christoph as an individual for his energy and multiple achievements.

Meanwhile Christoph himself sought community recognition awards for other Llandeilo Covid Volunteers, with support from Llandeilo Mayor Owen James and private sponsors.

The Action Hub committee responded to the award with this official statement: "..we're glad to call you one of our own."

The Action Hub is currently looking to collate information on all local groups and activities to connect them with new members and volunteers and the Lit Fest will be happening online this weekend.



CREATING CONNECTIONS IN LLANDEILO



The Llandeilo Community Action Hub is a new and exciting project which has been up and running since the 1st March 2021. It's aim is to compile lists of all the clubs, groups and organisations which help and support the local community of Llandeilo and the surrounding area. It will establish a directory that will show how to access these groups, how to join and also how to volunteer.

There is so much going on in the town including sports clubs, support groups, social groups, food producing associations, art groups and creative projects. People will be able to clearly see what's going on in Llandeilo and decide if they want to join in or volunteer their time and services.

From the beginning of The Covid19 Pandemic there have been many local people wanting to help out in whatever way they could. Over 150 people signed up to volunteer for The Covid19 Support Group and it has been an extraordinary collective of local people showing what a strong sense of community our town of Llandeilo has. The Action Hub aims to build on this to create a central point of contact, through Facebook, leafleting and other platforms, with information available to all.

There is already a long list of local groups being compiled including TACLO – a group who keep the town clean and tidy with litter picking events, Tregib Sports facilities, fitness groups, mental health services, dementia support, food networks, town festival committees – the



list is growing daily! If you are a club or group who would like be included, or a volunteer who wants to be active in the community or an organisation looking for volunteers – please get in touch. All are welcome.

Volunteer forms are being published in May where you can put down your details and what you are interested in volunteering for. You will then be kept in touch with relevant organisations and events where your help would be needed.

Information and volunteer forms will also be available at the Llandeilo library. Later in the year look out for information on the new Llandeilo noticeboard which will be incorporated into the community mosaic mural currently being created in the walkway between the main carpark and Rhosmaen Street.



Now that the pandemic restrictions are being eased, the Ramblers group for this area, Dinefwr Ramblers, will again be providing led walks which will offer both variety and good company with a friendly group for enjoyable outdoor exercise over the coming months. MS AWARENESS WEEK 2021



As Multiple Sclerosis (MS) Awareness week approached, 19th - 25th April, I reflected on what it's meant for myself, a person living with MS and many others facing the pandemic with a chronic illness. It's fair to say the last 12 months have been particularly worrying, challenging and difficult for everyone as we lived through a global pandemic. Its aftermath which has yet to end, has been far reaching and widespread, taking a toll on mental health as people struggle with the devastating loss of lives, the impact of lockdown, loneliness, financial difficulties and the inevitable recession that we are entering. MS can lead to mental health problems and the risk of suicide for people with MS is significantly higher. MS is a condition where the



immune system mistakenly attacks the brain and nerves, causing a broad range of symptoms, including problems with vision, movement, sensation, balance, memory and just about any neurological function can potentially be affected. It's a lifelong condition that can sometimes cause serious disability. There currently is no cure. The NHS, a service we are fortunate to have, has been placed under enormous strain as it's battled against the virus and with most of its resources tied up in this, appointments have had to be cancelled, treatments delayed, people left in limbo waiting for answers, medical consultations conducted over the phone. This has added to the feelings of uncertainty, anxiety and fear. The MS Trust, a charity who supports people with MS and those around them, reported it had received record numbers of calls to its free helpline from worried people. The Trust provided clear up to date information on their website and Facebook page about COVID and MS which I found helpful in understanding the risks for me. Lockdown saw many fundraising events cancelled thus cutting off a vital source of income for charities, such as the MS Trust, yet somehow they had to find ways to keep going especially when people were in need of support more than ever.

I fell into the group of people clinically extremely vulnerable to serious illness if they caught the virus and received a letter to shield, basically to stay home having minimal contact with anyone, even those I live with. I attend hospital monthly for an infusion of a disease modifying drug to manage highly active MS that works by altering how the immune system operates. It was decided the risks of stopping treatment or increasing the time between infusions outweighed the risks posed from the coronavirus so I could continue as usual which was lucky (or unlucky depending how you look at it). When it came to leaving home for the first time after a month of shielding to attend hospital I was apprehensive and felt like a survivor in a disaster movie heading out into the unkown. I don't know what I thought I'd see but there were no apocalyptic scenes awaiting me, in fact the world looked pretty much the same, only eerily quiet with most places shut and a distinct lack of people. Those who were out were queuing 6ft apart, mindful of social distances, awaiting entry into the supermarket or chemist. There were no horrific scenes at the hospital either, just a sense of strangeness with all the black & yellow tape up, areas closed off, no people in the corridors except for hospital staff wearing masks & gloves, a virtually empty car park and entrance doors locked. Admittance was permitted after completion of a general health check that included having your temperature taken and using antibacterial spray on your hands. The outpatient waiting area in front of the coffee shop (which was open for takeaway drinks only) was full of NHS staff taking a well earned break. I felt I didn't belong amongst these ordinary everyday heroes, a cloak of invisibility would've been useful as I tried to creep past to get a coffee. There was no idle chit-chat. The atmosphere was sombre. Once I was admitted to the MS ward, all the staff were wearing gloves, masks, aprons and everything was sprayed with antibacterial spray.

Things I use to manage pain, fatigue and general wellbeing became hard to access in lockdown causing a flare up of symptoms. I usually attend a yoga class and regular acupuncture but these were cancelled. I was able to join an online yoga class in the end but missed months of acupuncture which set me back. If you have one autoimmune condition, there is an increased risk of having another and I have Coeliac disease, a condition where your immune system attacks your own tissues when you eat gluten. Panic buying made it hard to get hold of Gluten Free foods resulting in some creative cooking! The lack of paracetamol disrupted pain management routines. I stopped watching and listening to the news because the reports were stressinducing and stress can be a trigger point for people with chronic illnesses, actually stress doesn't help anyone. I felt reassured after I had my vaccination and less worried every time I had to leave the safety of home. Not everything about lockdown was bad, it provided a chance to pause and slow down, spending more time enjoying the outdoors.

For anyone feeling worried about life with MS, you don't have to suffer in silence. The MS Trust provide a free enquiry line 0800 0323839 and information you can trust, or talk to your Doctor/MS Nurse. The MS Trust have a useful A-Z section on every MS subject you can imagine, on their website www.mstrust.org.uk. Their Facebook group https://www.facebook.com/groups/multiplesclerosistrust/ is another way to access support and to reach out to the wider MS community.

Brigid Loizou, founder and curator of the award winning 'Art at the Hall' in Llangathen, launches a brand new permanent contemporary art space in Ffairfach, Llandeilo, with its debut exhibition **'Let the Darkness In'.** The much anticipated opening of Studio Cennen, at a site steeped in history and with its roots firmly in the community, will showcase a select ten artists and makers. Their work will be displayed with Brigid's unique talent for curating – a talent which has already engendered success in studiocennen.com online.

The building is a turn-of-the-century industrial boiler house for what was once the Llandeilo Creamery. A large chimney stems over its foundations and marks your way to Llandeilo. Situated by the flowing River Cennen, Brigid and her husband, architect Tony Loizou, were drawn to the locality's elements of industry, remains of soot and coal mark the chimney, juxtaposed by trees and water. The site has recently undergone a renovation with Brigid's flavour - fashionable, welcoming and bold. Brigid had a highly successful thirty-year career in fashion before her more recent venture as curator on her return to Wales. She has travelled throughout Wales - prepandemic and virtually - to select the top artists for your interests and tastes to show at the premier exhibition. The affordable range, dynamic displays and friendly atmosphere makes for an opening exhibition not to miss.

'Let the Darkness In' is an embrace of change through darkness; it is only through dark colours, physically, that we see light. The artists selected all have an interest in the properties of this quality; whether enabling them to focus on form, Adam Taylor, painter, it's many textures and depths, Paul James ceramicist, its mystical possession, Beth Marsden, painter or "Folklore stories and my own imaginings", Sculptor Sharon Griffin.

What could be more emblematic of beginnings, than a painter's black piece of charcoal – where form begins and unravels ideas onto the page? Adam Taylor has taken this a step further – his studio is an old coal shed, where this fine raw material was once stored and indicative of Welsh heritage. Adam now conjures bodies of paintings which explore his coastal, rugged landscapes in Pembrokeshire. When seeing his work for the first time in person, Brigid was immediately drawn to the dramatic, thickly applied black painting of a harbour with an orange buoy. "I also

love the square shape of his canvas. Neither portrait nor landscape."

In contrast, Beth Marsden, in her light-filled studio in North Gower, interweaves black (with beams of light) for its associations of dreams and its dual evocation of destruction and renewal in human and geological cycles. Brigid was introduced to Beth's work by Gill Clement, the Mumbles based jeweller. Brigid was struck by the resonances of Beth's subject matter and Studio Cennen's site, the bare trees, silhouettes, shadows and reflections.

Brigid set up an introduction meeting for Adam Taylor and Beth Marsden to discuss the idea of a joint show. Previously unknown to each other, Adam and Beth were immediately enamoured with the others work and were excited to collaborate for this first exhibition. When thinking of the space as a whole, Brigid had envisaged the 3D aspect to work along side the paintings, "I approached Sculptor Sharon Griffin with a DM, I had been following Sharon on Instagram for quite some time, with my fingers and toes crossed I was excited to receive a promising reply and delighted when Sharon agreed to join us for the show.

To evoke the feeling of a domestic setting Brigid has always incorporated furniture in her exhibitions. Tim Bowen Antiques joined Brigid at the Midsummer In Cahoots at the Hall in June 2019 to much acclaim, Tim will be returning for this premier exhibition. No show would be complete without the amazing plant displays of Jess Jones of Little barn Nursery. Jess, sister to Brigid, has always put the finishing touches to each of the nine Art at the Hall shows with her fine art of planting. Little Barn Nursery will also be occupying the outdoor space and garden area at Studio Cennen Ffairfach, creating a stunning backdrop for sculptures and outdoor ceramics.

Six ceramicists will also be joining the line up, Kim Colebrook, Rhiannon Gwyn, Mick Morgan and Paul Taylor all currently show their work with the online gallery, and local potter Nick Membery. London based ceramicist Paul James will be showing in Wales for the first time. As the sculptor Louise Nevelson once said black "encompasses all colours... I don't know a lesser word". Come "Let the Darkness In' – whether your interest is in antique Welsh furniture, a painting, sculpture or a pot – there will be something for everyone.


