



It is with great sadness for me to announce the death of Sandra Ozolins, my beloved wife and best friend. She will be very much missed by myself, her family, all of her friends and the many people who knew her.

Sandra was one of the most compassionate people I have ever known. Always helping others, even when too unwell to leave her bed; networking and connecting by telephone.

For a number of years she voluntarily ran a vegan famine relief charity and through her fundraising raised hundreds of thousands of pounds for projects that she helped to develop and finance with sister charities (sustainable projects such as vegetable gardens, water wells, tree planting etc).

Many thousands of lives were improved or saved by her efforts.

An enthusiastic artist and a keen poet. In recent years a dedicated member of Dinefwr Poets.

Sandra suffered from severe ME (Myalgic Encephalomyelitis) for twenty years and the associated chemical sensitivity for the last ten as well.

The official cause of death on her death certificate is ME. Hopefully Sandra's death maybe the catalyst for the NHS in Wales to take ME seriously and put the measures in place to make provision for others with the same or similar conditions (a chemical, scent free safe room in all hospitals for example). Sandra told me that she hoped that would be the case when she knew that she was dying, she was so brave.

Sandra loved living in Wales and was an almost fluent Welsh speaker. She loved the land; countryside and natural environment and the people as well.

Sandra passed away peacefully at home on September 14th at 2.00am, I was with her throughout. Brightest of Blessings to you Sandra. You will always be in my heart.

LLANDEILO YOUTH CLUB INITIATIVE

A few recent incidents of minor vandalism in Llandeilo started a debate on Facebook about what could be done to deal with the problem of bored and frustrated youngsters. "Sports activities are limited and for those not into exercise COVID 19 has made life even more challenging, leading many to get carried away," said one of the founders of Youth Club 4 Llandeilo.

This newly formed initiative is run by a group of concerned individuals who decided to reach out to these kids and give them a space of their own to hang out in, do what they want and feel safe.

"Contrary to some statements made Youth Clubs can run during the pandemic under Section 14 A, subject to special regulations," says Christoph Fischer, co-founder and Llandeilo town councillor. "The problem of bored and frustrated kids is here now and cannot wait until the end of the pandemic."

The group has found a few possible locations for the youth club but is talking to all available venues in town and will chose the most suitable together with the children.

"We have taken guidance from Llandovery Youth Club, and DR.M'z in Carmarthen, who both have been extremely helpful," says Fischer. "We're now looking for financial support, responsible volunteers, furniture and any other items that can be used in the club, such as games, computers, art materials etc."



CALON CYMRU NETWORK CALLS FOR PLANNING POLICIES TO PERMIT RURAL REPOPULATION

Response to Carmarthenshire Local Development Plan consultation urges easier permission for food production ventures requiring more people to live and work in the countryside

The planning framework should have a more proactive role in fostering ecologically sound agriculture and horticulture, to improve resilience in unstable, difficult times, argues Calon Cymru Network, responding to Carmarthenshire County Council's consultation on the 2018-2033 Local Development Plan (LDP).

Calon Cymru warns that "There is a probability that shocks to social, economic and environmental systems will be severe and unexpected. Carmarthenshire, and Wales, will require a higher level of self-sufficiency in basic foodstuffs, and those foods will need to come from the currently under-used countryside.

"It follows that the outputs of Welsh farming need to change significantly, towards a more balanced agricultural system. This requires a significant increase in production of both horticultural crops and arable growing for human consumption.

"Considering fruit and vegetables, just 0.08% of Wales' farmland grows horticultural crops and production is only 3% of the population's requirement for five portions a day."

More horticulture calls for additional people living in the countryside, because fruit and vegetable production requires a larger labour force than the beef and sheep farming which dominates over much of Wales.

But Calon Cymru notes that current planning policy is a deterrent to starting and developing new businesses in the countryside.

The Sustainability Assessment accompanying the LDP recognizes that "Carmarthenshire is currently exceeding sustainability levels with regards to food and drink, energy, capital investment (transport/ buildings) and consumables". Calon Cymru Network is working to help reverse this trend by participating in efforts to move Wales towards a sustainable future.



Thanks to the X-Forces start up loan, and advice from Business Wales, All Carved Up which is based in Llandovery and owned by David Hay, has started producing bespoke log cabins and sheds. They take on all aspects of work; from tree felling to tree houses.

David started chainsaw carving 10 years ago as a hobby and to supplement his forestry work income. But he always had a dream to build log cabins, and earlier this year he decided to go for it.

Unfortunately, COVID 19 stuck which at first was a worry, but fortunately orders started to come in, especially after the public saw the standard of his work

David has built up his workshop over the years, and this is where he spends hours of his day carving and making outdoor furniture. He now has quite a production line, where lorries drop off logs to be milled. He has also built his own kiln for drying-out timber and takes orders for sawn timber, for dimensions that cannot be sourced at vards.

David sells his waste as firewood and has taken on tree work and mobile saw milling.

The job he does is very manual, and he finds it rewarding and consistently offers value for money with his products, by not scrimping on materials and building solid structures to client's bespoke requests, whatever they may be.

A typical shed construction is made from 2 inches thick t&g, in between 4x4 posts and are extremely strong. His cabins are machined from 6x4 timber that interlock. They can also have both insulated roof and flooring and the windows can be double glazed. These can be fitted out however the customer desires.



Shock, horror, blind panic, aaaaaarrrrrgggghhhhhhhhh, what can I dooooooooooo? Disaster.





- Proudest achievements? Outside of family I'd



CREATE A SPECIAL **SPRING** HAVEN FOR **POLLINATORS**

10 plants to start growing this autumn

Want to grow plants that are perfect for pollinators?

Based on their cutting-edge research, scientists at the National Botanic Garden of Wales have revealed a hit-list of recommendations for some of the best spring garden plants, to plant this autumn.

The Botanic Garden's PhD researcher, Abigail Lowe says: "As pollinating insects emerge on warm days in late winter and early spring, they seek their first meals of the season.

"After hibernating over winter, bumblebee queens need to find nest sites to form new colonies - a very energydemanding task.

"Most hoverflies and solitary bees overwinter as larvae, beginning their adulthood 'on the wing' during spring. And while honeybees stay active during warm days throughout winter, they need to replenish their stores in spring to sustain their developing brood."

To give these pollinators a head-start, grow flowers in your garden that provide a bounty of sugary nectar and protein-rich pollen. Here are some of the top pollinator plants for spring-time gardens, based on the Botanic Garden's Saving Pollinators research, led by Dr Natasha de Vere. All can be planted in autumn and early winter.

Abigail added: "Importantly, these plants need to be insecticide-free - our Saving Pollinators Assurance Scheme will help you. Opt for single-flowered blooms which allow easy access for pollinators."

This is your guide for turning your backyard into a pollinator haven next spring:



Wallflowers (Erysimum)

Wallflowers, such as Erysimum 'Bowles's Mauve', have an amazingly long flowering season that spans the colder months. A wide array of pollinating insects will forage on them, including solitary bees.

Hellebores (Helleborus)

Among the first flowers to appear early in the year, hellebores are a welcome sight for pollinators. Pools of nectar are held within nectaries at the base of the flowers and the flowers' stamens offer an abundance of pollen.

Comfrey (Symphytum)

Comfrey is in the borage family – a real all-rounder for pollinators. Short- and long-tongued bumblebees, as well as honeybees and hoverflies will visit the tubular flowers of this plant. Propagate now from seed or from root cuttings, or buy as dormant potted plants. Choose a site where the plant can be kept in-check, as it can be invasive.





Grape hyacinth (Muscari)

These spring-flowering bulbs are a favourite for honeybees and are perfect for a pollinator-friendly pot. When sourcing bulbs, buy organic to ensure they are free from pesticide residues and safe for pollinators.

Anemone

A perfect choice for dappled shade or a pot. The cupshaped flowers are enjoyed by honeybees, bumblebees and hoverflies. Choose from the white-flowered native Anemone nemorosa, Anemone blanda in shades of blue, white or pink and Anemone × lipsiensis in pale yellow.

Crocus

Colourful swathes of crocuses in spring are a welcome sight. In particular, the purple varieties such as Crocus tommasinianus are often sought out by bees and hoverflies searching for food after winter. Plant in a sunny, well-drained spot to get the best results.

Snowdrops (Galanthus)

Snowdrops are one of the first signs that winter is ending, with blooms seen as early as January. They provide a vital nectar and pollen source for emerging pollinators such as honeybees and queen bumblebees. Bulbs should be planted in the ground immediately to prevent drying out and will establish easily. Ensure that you add some drainage in the form of grit to the planting areas to stop the bulbs from rotting.



Apples, cherries and plums (Malus and Prunus)

Most varieties of apple, plum and cherry need crosspollination to produce fruit. Luckily, the spring blossom of these trees is loved by a range of pollinators including honeybees and solitary bees. The wide open flowers are also accessible to hoverflies which, unlike bees, lack a long proboscis. Plant container-grown plants now, and bear root plants once dormant, and the leaves have dropped.

Willows (Salix spp.)

The catkins produced by willows are packed full of pollen and nectar. Cuttings or rods root easily and can be bought online in winter. If you have a small garden, try coppicing, where a proportion of stems are removed each year but be sure to leave some old enough to flower. There are also low-growing alpine species, such as the native dwarf willow (Salix herbacea).

Lungwort (*Pulmonaria*)

The early flowers of Pulmonaria provide nectar and pollen to bees when little else is available. The colourful, tubular flowers are enjoyed by many species but it is particularly favoured by the hairy-footed flower bee, Anthophora plumipes. Good for dappled or full shade, these plants will naturally spread providing a lovely addition to a border.

- The National Botanic Garden of Wales recently launched its Saving Pollinators Assurance Scheme which guarantees that eligible plants are loved by bees and other pollinating insects, don't contain synthetic insecticides and are grown in peat-free compost.
- It is the first pollinator plant logo scheme in the UK to be backed by DNA-barcoding science and is currently being rolled out to growers and nurseries. It aims to prevent pollinator decline and benefits other wildlife such as hedgehogs, sparrows and frogs


