BRAMLEY ARE NOT THE ONLY COOKERS....

When you think of cooking apples, if indeed you ever do, what do you think of? Which name springs to mind? I bet it's Bramley – but as the name of this article suggests, there are many other varieties suitable for cooking - I wonder if you can name any? You can probably have a good stab at naming a few eating apples – Granny Smith, Golden Delicious, Cox, Braeburn, Gala, Pink Lady etc etc. Does that mean that there are lots of types of eating apples but only one used for cooking?

If you're still reading, you won't be surprised to learn the answer is a resounding no! There are many varieties of cooking apples, every bit as good as, or even superior to, Bramley, depending on whether you want to make a pie, a crumble, apple sauce, have a baked apple, make apple jam or one of the myriad other delicious recipes which feature apples. They have different levels of sweetness, acidity and ability to hold their shape when cooked. At the National Trust's Dinefwr Heritage orchard, there are at least 21 varieties of apples suitable for cooking, most of which are also tasty to eat and /

or press for delicious juice, and 6 of which are Welsh varieties. We don't have a Bramley.....

If you want to know your Catsheads from your Lord Derby, or your Gelli Aur from your Pig yr Wydd, a quick visit to the orchard should help you out. The Dinefwr Orchardeers are helping the National Trust to manage this 8 year old orchard of over 60 older apple and pear varieties and are closely monitoring the harvest of each tree. After weighing, some of the apples are available to take away, for a donation, from near the orchard entrance, so please don't be tempted to scrump in the orchard! We even weigh most fallers and utilise them for juice or cider!

For more information, or if you want to come along

to help us, please get in contact with the Dinefwr Orchardeers. We can advise on all things apple, and to some extent, pear. Well, maybe not all things, but

we'll have a go, and probably know someone who can answer the really difficult questions! If you fancy planting your own trees, we can advise you on that as well, and by visiting the orchard, you can see a wide variety of young trees so you know what you'll be getting.

In the meantime, why not have a go at the following recipe – it works really well with Brith Mawr. You could probably use Bramley as well, if you must!

Chicken and Apple Cheese bake Serves 4.

12 oz cooked chicken, diced

5 apples - Brith Mawr

4 oz butter

1/2 pt white sauce

4 oz grated Cheddar cheese

4 tablespoons toasted white breadcrumbs

Salt and black pepper

Set oven to 400 degF / 200 degC / Gas Mark 6. Butter a shallow ovenproof dish. Peel, core and slice 4 of the apples and fry them gently in the butter. Arrange the chicken pieces in the bottom of the dish and put the apple slices on top. Make 1/2 pt of white sauce. Mix 3 oz of the cheese into the white sauce and pour over the apples. Season. Mix the breadcrumbs with the remaining 1 oz of cheese and sprinkle over the sauce. Cut the remaining apple into rings (cored but unpeeled), toss in the leftover apple butter and arrange neatly on top of the dish. Bake for 20 to 30 minutes until crisp and golden.



CONNIE THE LOCKDOWN FOAL

We received a call from a concerned walker in March about a distressed and neglected foal, we knew despite the lockdown we had to respond urgently. What greeted us was a scene we will never forget, there was a tiny foal all alone and hungry, still trying to feed from her thin dead mother. Back safely at Lluest, we checked her over properly with the vet, gave her milk feed and named her Connie. She was fed every two hours around the clock and very quickly built up trust. We are so pleased that after all the expert care she has received, Connie is almost ready to go to a Guardian home.



MORE LOCKDOWN FOALS- ZEUS AND APOLLO (RENAMED BILBO)

Bilbo and Zeus were part of a multi-organisation rescue in the middle of lock down in May. Only two weeks old, both were born on wild moors. Zeus's mother rejected him soon after he was born. They both needed around the clock care and feeding, with Bilbo needing a transfusion and Zeus needing antibiotics for pneumonia. They are now growing healthily, are happy and thriving. Bilbo is in a foster home with Lluest rescue mare Ariel as his nanny, he has now been gelded. Zeus has recovered from his pneumonia and has recently been castrated, he is full of energy and has to be the cheekiest foal we've ever had.



All children in primary school will be offered the vaccine by the school nursing service.

Patients aged between 50 and 64 years are likely to be offered flu vaccine under the NHS flu vaccination programme following the prioritisation of other eligible groups and subject to vaccine supply – probably during November and December 2020.





ChallengeAid

fit for a purpose

Although Covid-19 has brought many challenges around the world, it may also, ironically, have been the springboard for a major development in education in the developing world. Due to lockdown both here in the UK and in Kenya, ChallengeAid is now providing online lessons in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Maths to young A-level students who live in two of Africa's most appalling informal slum settlements, Mathare and Kibera in Nairobi.

ChallengeAid, first established in 2005, creates Schools of Hope (SoH) in Kenya and Tanzania. These schools provide desks, chairs, lighting and up-to-date Kenyan syllabus textbooks, revision lessons after school, at weekends and in holiday time in a safe environment, conducive to learning. It is a simple but unique initiative which allows aspirational young people the opportunity to escape from a lifetime of poverty through education. ChallengeAid also provides extra-curricular activities such as life skills, sports, music, drama and chess. Because schools are currently closed we have also been able to conduct online lessons daily for an hour at a time in late morning during the week. When Kenyan schools restart these revisions lessons for Forms 3 and 4 pupils (Yr.12 & 13) will move to Sunday afternoons.

We are currently using the Billian and St Jerome SoH in Kibera and Mathare which have more reliable electric power sources and wi-fi connectivity to deliver these lessons through a number of hugely experienced A-level teachers here in Wales and around the UK. These teaching volunteers have been able to provide the best of British education into the very heart of some of Africa's worst environments, out of which there is often little hope of escape.

"Between the four of us we have over 140 years of teaching experience. The opportunity of teaching these people has been humbling and most rewarding to see



their dedicated focus, thirst for knowledge and joy of learning. It is so refreshing and motivating to be part of this unique initiative."

Iestyn Thomas, the founder of ChallengeAid said "This is a game changing development which will take the learning to a different level and hopefully enable and empower young people to achieve even better results. Currently approximately 1/3 of our form 4 leavers are going onto University, which in itself is a huge achievement, especially considering the environment in which these young people live, but we now believe that these lessons will lead to even better results and higher achievement in the future. Children can now see that there is a realistic way to escape from the poverty into which they have been born."

Sophia Kamweru, who runs ChallengeAid Africa in Nairobi added "Most of the students who attend Schools of Hope are enrolled in non-formal schools that are owned and managed by Women Groups, Churches and Communities. These schools are not able to hire trained teachers and rely on youths who themselves are just school dropouts. These students performances, especially in Maths and Sciences, has over the years been dismal. There is great excitement among the students to, for the first time sit before trained and experienced teachers to learn. Our students are glad that the Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education Examination has been postponed to 2021, as they will be better prepared and will do well!"

SOME MESSAGES FROM THE **STUDENTS**

"I am a Form 4 student from Kitonguni Secondary School which is in the Eastern part of Kenya. I enjoy the online sessions; the teachers are friendly and we all can interact with them freely. I attend Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry and Biology sessions. I have learnt and understood topics that I previously had no understanding of. I appreciate the opportunity to continue learning when schools are closed due to COVID-19. I thank the tutors for volunteering to teach us, the Billian Centre for supporting us and ChallengeAid for facilitating the program. I promise to work hard and shine academically!"

We had not even covered the 1st term's work, but I can comfortably say that I am now ready to do the main examination as our online teachers have prepared us well enough. We have an easy interaction with them. The tutors are patient with us and go to great length to ensure that we understand the lessons, We are so thankful for the online lessons."

ChallengeAid's founding principles are to never create a culture of dependency, to strive for self-sustaining SoH, and to provide the very best value for money; the current cost for a student in a SoH is approximately 2p per day.

We currently have 45 SoH with 3000 students and pupils most of whom are living in informal "slum" settlements.

OTHER PROGRAMMES

ChallengeAid has also been running a sanitary pad programme for the last 10 years, providing complimentary sanitary pads for any girl who regularly attends a SoH which has enabled many more girls to remain in education.

We are currently working on upgrading the latrines to ensure that every SoH has access to a male and female toilet. In the informal slum settlements where we operate only 17% of people had access to toilets in their own homes & only 29% of others live within 30m of a public latrine. This is especially problematic for children, girls & women forced to travel long distances under poor lighting to use an insecure toilet which probably wouldn't even function properly. Unsanitary, insecure and poorly lit toilets contribute to rape & sexual violence which consequently fuels early pregnancies & the spread of infectious diseases including HIV. These upgraded toilets in the SoH's are now connected to the sewers and have

taps which are connected to a water supply for hand washing!

Many celebrities support ChallengeAid, especially rugby stars. One of our SoH in Mathare, Nairobi, is the George North SoH, created by money raised at just one of our many dinners, golf days, challenges and events.

"We look forward to welcoming those involved in the spectacular sport, with action played out on forest tracks revered in the world of rallying."

The announcement comes following the news that the 2020 Wales Rally GB, due to run in the autumn, would be cancelled in light of the Coronavirus pandemic and the restrictions in place designed to protect public safety.

And with support growing for a green recovery from COVID-19, the new agreement will have environmental considerations at its heart with NRW and Motorsport UK committing to working together on the ambition to drive towards a lower carbon, greener and more sustainable approach to hosting the events in the future.

"This ambition will remain at the heart of our discussions as we work with the rally event organisers on the programme of events for 2021 and beyond".

Motorsport UK CEO, Hugh Chambers, said: "We are delighted to announce a new agreement with Natural Resources Wales which will allow rallying to take place in the Welsh forests for at least the next three years. 


