THE INVISIBLE HOUSING CRISIS

Look into the windows of rural estate agents today and you may notice a high proportion of properties have "Sold" splashed across them. No sooner a property is placed on the market these days than the agent is inundated with buyers. It is a seller's market and prices are booming. Demand is outstripping supply and even those with plenty of capital cannot find what they want. In the meantime rental properties are being snapped up at inflated rates by people who have sold and cannot find anywhere suitable to buy. The situation has rapidly intensified due to the pandemic and more people working from home.

With broadband, it is now possible to work virtually anywhere but there is a down-side for some people. If it is provided by wireless, also used by all mobile technologies, it seriously affects those who have become sensitised to man-made electromagnetic radiation. The electro-hypersensitives (EHS) have become an invisible underclass and their plight is being ignored or dismissed by doctors, the media, national and local governments, the public, commerce and industry.

Ordinary people of all ages and from all walks of life are being quietly subjected to unbearable suffering, hardship and social exclusion. The disabling effects of wireless over-exposure are often attributed to other causes and glossed over. It is routinely claimed that no evidence of harm exists, despite thousands of credible scientific studies and countless victim testimonies to the contrary. Women appear more affected than men but the prospects and life opportunities all people with EHS could reasonably have looked forward to in the past are now being rapidly erased. Even as pandemic restrictions are loosened, those for whom wireless is poisonous are unable to safely travel, attend places of learning or worship, socialise, work or enjoy their own homes.

Welsh Government policy to facilitate 4G service over 97% of the country via the joint Shared Rural Network (SRN) and the Emergency Services Network (ESN) is expected to result in an additional 234,000 homes which up to now have been located in 'not-spots' being continuously irradiated with pulsed digital microwave

radiation, like everywhere else. 'EMF Refugees' in Britain will literally soon have nowhere safe left to go. Though still outside most people's comprehension or awareness, this invisible trend has now reached epidemic proportions.

Wireless / microwave radiation is a toxic man-made pollutant and may ultimately prove to be poison to every living thing including livestock and wildlife. It is classified by the World Health Organisation's International Agency for Research on Cancer as a Class 2B Possible Carcinogen. Cancer is however not the only way wireless radiation impacts life. It particularly affects brain function causing early onset symptoms such as loss of concentration, loss of memory, sleep deprivation, headaches and dizziness and mood changes. Imagine if up to a third of the people you interact with are routinely struggling to remember or think straight ...

As wireless proliferation continues to intensify, inevitably more people are likely to realise they too are affected and will have to look for somewhere safer to live, further exacerbating the housing crisis that now exists.

CARMARTHENSHIRE HISTORY LECTURE EIGHTEENTH **CENTURY HYMN** WRITERS OF THE LLANDOVERY AREA



On Saturday 16 October at 2.00 pm there will be a free public lecture in Llandovery entitled "The Seven Mile Circuit: Eighteenth Century Hymn Writers of the Llandovery Area". It will be held at the William Williams Memorial Chapel and will be about the circle of prolific hymn writers centred on Llandovery in the eighteenth century.

CHURCHYARD WILDFLOWER MEADOW EXHIBITION FEATURING THE WORK OF CAROLE SPACKMAN, POTTER & COLIN HORSMAN, PHOTOGRAPHER



Carole & Colin will be showing their pottery and photographs at Llanwrtyd & District Heritage Centre for the month of October. Living in Llanddeusant for forty years, the Churchyard Meadowland has provided Colin & Carole with a wealth of plants and animals to photograph or use as subjects for sculptures and decoration of pottery. Each year a different combination of wild grasses, flowers and fungi appear to fuel their creativity.

Colin's work on show is a set of close detailed photographs taken inside this stone walled wild flower meadow over the four seasons. Photography studies include groups and details of Orange Hawkweed, Dandelion and Bluebell during the Spring, followed by Yellow Vetchling, Purple Knapweed, Yellow Rattle and Pink and White Clover during Summer culminating in the Autumn self-seeding period of the various wild species across whole area of the churchyard before onset of frost and snow of Winter.

The detailed close up photography is supported by broad landscape studies of surrounding fields and mountains as viewed from the churchyard throughout the year, including sweeping views of Black Mountain and closer studies of the fields, hedges, trees and sky of this unique and special landscape set in Western half of the Brecon Beacons National Park.

Colin Horsman qualified in photography and journalism at West Surrey College of Art, then worked as photographer and writer for a number of International and National magazines and publishers including The Countryside Commission, culminating in hard back and

guide book publications. Colin continues to pursue his profession as photographer and writer.

Throughout her 50 years of potting, Carole has made pots for her customers to use and enjoy. She will be showing her Meadow Flowers range together with a new Twilight range that are for use in the kitchen or at the table. She incorporates locally gathered grass and wood ash into her unique glaze recipes, then decorates them with other colours that blend in the high firing process to create an impressionist effect of this wild flower meadowland. Her more subtle stone glaze with added coloured slips echo the locally quarried stone used in surrounding ancient buildings.

Carole will also be exhibiting her frost-proof sculptures suitable for inside or outside. With these sculptures, which feature the local animal and bird life, she aims to capture fleeting moments of characteristic actions of these creatures.

Carole has exhibited in galleries such as the Glynn Vivian, Newport, Monmouth & Brecon museums. Her Welsh crayfish pate jar design has been sold in Selfridges, Fortnum & Mason and other leading London stores.

ROGER PARRY & PARTNERS WARN WELSH FARMERS NOT TO GET CAUGHT OUT WHEN CONSTRUCTING SLURRY OR SILAGE STORES

Roger Parry & Partners are warning Welsh farmers to be aware of Natural Resources Wales' requirement to notify them when constructing or reconstructing a silage or slurry store.

The requirement to notify Natural Resources Wales (NRW) 14 days before construction starts is for any new, substantially improved or reconstructed store used for the storage of silage or slurry. The notification is also a Cross Compliance requirement under Statutory Management Requirement (SMR) 1 – Water Protection.

Gail Jenkins, Consultant with Roger Parry & Partners based in Carmarthenshire, said, "We regularly work with farmers to successfully gain planning permission for new stores for the storage of silage or slurry on the farm. Many farmers are unaware, however, of this requirement to notify NRW 14 days before the construction work starts. Those that don't notify NRW risk prosecution or an unlimited fine."

According to Natural Resources Wales the farmer is responsible for making sure the rules are met. The rules apply to the land owner if they control, manage or look after a farm or an installation on a property, for example as a: farmer or land manager; tenant farmer – unless you can prove someone else, for example the landowner, is jointly or wholly responsible.

There are a lot of rules to take into consideration before construction work starts on a store for silage or slurry. Considerations must be made relating to the location of the store, what exactly is being stored, and whether planning permission is required. There are specific rules you must adhere to for the storage of slurry, particularly for earth-banked stores. NRW state farmers must first find out what permissions they need from which authorities.

If a breach of the regulations is confirmed, action will be taken according to the Natural Resources Wales Enforcement and Prosecution policy and procedures. Possible action depends on the seriousness of the breach and impact on the environment. They include: advice on remedying a minor breach; warning letter noting the breach, which may be taken into account in the event of a future breach; legal notice; formal caution or prosecution. If prosecuted and convicted in either the Magistrates or the Crown Court, you may face an unlimited fine.

LOW-CARBON ALTERNATIVE SOLUTIONS



Ian and Adelle moved from a modern property on the gas grid into an 1820s stone cottage and barn conversion with a multi-fuel Rayburn. Despite easy access to wood fuel on their property, the idea of all the dirt and high maintenance did not appeal to them and they looked for alternative solutions. The system also qualifies for the Renewable Heating Incentive (RHI) payments, allowing them a return on their investment via quarterly payments from the UK government over seven years.

CHARITY ANNOUNCES £500 JOINING BONUS TO ATTRACT STAFF



Elidyr Communities Trust is a Carmarthenshire charity working with young people with disabilities and complex learning needs. This week they have launched a fantastic new scheme offering a £500 joining bonus for support workers who start between now and October 2021.

The charity is near Llandovery, surrounded by countryside and is a safe haven for around 50 young adults, who are being taught how to live and learn more independently. Like many in the care sector recruiting care staff has become a huge challenge.

Dai added: "The perception of care work can be negative and undoubtedly the publicity around the pressure on care staff during the pandemic hasn't helped that. But Elidyr Communities Trust is not like other care settings. We've a huge vibrant campus, with a mixture of modern houses, ancient buildings, gardens, animals, craft workshops, a shop and a gym. Working with our young people is hard work but it's never boring!"

The £500 joining bonus will be a big financial incentive but there are other benefits to working with the charity. Ah well, to those of you who are still reading this you will have noticed the shortage of newsprint for which I apologise.




