AMATEUR PACKET UPDATE

One product that came out years ago for digital modes was the AEA PK-232 . This unit hooked up to the serial port of the computer and decoded lots of different modes like RTTY , CW, Packet , ASCII, weather FAX and more. The unit even had a signal identification mode where you could tune in a signal and it would tell you what the format was. Timewave Technology has come out with a new version of this old classic decoder. The new unit has a built in digital signal processor (DSP) along with an isolation transformer for hookup to your computer sound card for digital programs that use that. The DSP allows for better filtering which allows copy in bad band conditions and tighter bandwidth than old analog filtering did. They are also offering the PK-232 with a USB connector to hook to your computer. Newer computers are now coming with USB connections and a lot do not even have an RS-232 serial port on them anymore. AMATEUR HARDWARE UPDATE

I have been finding a lot of old cell phone chargers in the garbage cans lately. I guess with everyone getting new designs and the fact they can be so cheap means they are now throw away items. I wanted a small housing to put a switch in to make a portable morse code key. I stripped out all the circuitry from the housing and I mounted a small pushbutton switch in one end of the charger. Instead of running a wire or cord out the back end I mounted a ¼ inch plug so I could just plug a standard ¼ inch male connector cable in and connect it to my key input. I soldered the wires from the normally open contacts of the switch to back to the ¼ inch jack. Now I can just plug a cable when needed and hook to my radio key input. This can easily be carried in your pocket or in an emergency radio parts kit to be used when needed. If your primary key ever gets lost or broken this one would come in handy.


