

### SAUDI ARABIA OFFICIALLY JOINS BRICS BLOC-STATETV

Saudi Arabia officially joined the BRICS bloc, as announced on state TV, following the foreign minister's statement in August about studying the details before the proposed joining date of January 1. Prince Faisal bin Farhan emphasized the economic cooperation benefits of joining



BRICS. This move comes amid tensions between the U.S. and China, with Saudi Arabia seeking to assert its independence amid concerns about U.S. commitment to Gulf security. China, Saudi Arabia's largest oil customer, has pushed for BRICS expansion to counter Western influence, aligning with Saudi Arabia's interests.

# COUNTRIES ARE CLAMORING TO JOIN BRICS GROUP, SOUTH AFRICA SAYS, AS RUSSIA TAKES UP LEADERSHIP

Following the recent expansion of the BRICS economic group to include Iran, Saudi Arabia, UAE, Ethiopia, and Egypt, South Africa's Foreign Minister announced that thirty-four additional countries have expressed interest in joining the

bloc. Russia, currently holding the rotating chairmanship, is overseeing the applications, signaling a growing global interest in aligning with the China and Russia-backed initiative. The expansion of BRICS, originally comprising Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa, is seen as a strategic move by China and Russia to counter the dominance of the United States in the international system. With the addition of major oil-producing Gulf economies and closer ties with Iran, BRICS aims to strengthen diplomatic and financial coordination, potentially challenging the existing global trade framework dominated by the US dollar.

### CHINA BACKS, BUT NO CONSENSUS ON ADMITTING PAKISTAN INTO BRICS

Pakistan's bid to join the China-backed Brics group, comprising Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa, faces hurdles as existing members are not in consensus. Russia, the current Brics President, appears hesitant about Pakistan's inclusion, citing the need for consensus among members and Pakistan's economic status.



Meanwhile, Pakistan may enter the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) with China's support, but criteria differ between the two groups. Brics recently expanded to include UAE, Saudi Arabia, Egypt, Iran, Ethiopia, and Argentina, but Argentina later withdrew, leaving the total membership at 10

### BRICS UNIVERSE EXHIBITION IS HELD IN RUSSIA

An exhibition of the "BRICS Universe" project opened in St. Petersburg, featuring images of UNESCO's creative cities from the BRICS countries, taken both on Earth and from the ISS. A total of

41 foreign and 48 Russian photographers from BRICS countries were involved in the project. 40 images were selected for the exhibitions. The exhibition "BRICS Universe" has already been shown in Moscow, in the Museum of Cosmonautics. Then the exhibition will continue its journey to eight UNESCO cities, including Kargopol, Nizhny Novgorod, Ulyanovsk, Kazan, Rio de Janeiro (Brazil), Beijing (China), Mumbai (India), Durban (South Africa). The "BRICS Universe" project is implemented under the auspices of the Russian Commission for UNESCO and is part of the plan of events of the Russian Federation's BRICS Chairmanship in 2024, operated by the Roscongress Foundation.

### RUSSIA SAYS RISING ECONOMIC BLOC BRICS SURPASSES G7 IN PURCHASING POWER PARITY

Russian presidential aide for foreign affairs Yury Ushakov said on Tuesday that the BRICS countries do not compete with the West but have already outdone the G7 in terms of purchasing power parity.



Ushakov said in an interview with Russian state news agency TASS that cooperation with the BRICS economic bloc is "one of the main vectors" of Russia's long-term foreign policy, which aligns with the country's core interests and commitment to shaping "a fair multipolar world." Over 250 events are scheduled in more than 10 Russian cities during Russia's BRICS chairmanship. The main event will be the BRICS leaders' summit, which will take place in Kazan from Oct. 22 to 24.

### RUSSIA TO HOLD BRICS SUMMIT IN KAZAN THIS YEAR IN OCTOBER 22-24

Russia will hold the BRICS Summit in Kazan from October 22 to 24, 2024, Kremlin aide Yuri Ushakov told Russian News Agency TASS on Tuesday.

During its BRICS presidency this year, Russia will focus on "promoting the entire range of partnership and cooperation within the framework of the association on three key tracks – politics and security, the economy and finance, and cultural and humanitarian ties," Russian Presidential Aide Yury Ushakov was — quoted as saying by TASS. Russia holds the BRICS rotating presidency this year for the first summit since the expansion of BRICS.

### Ruby Sinha President BRICS CCI WE

### In your opinion, how critical is the need for women's empowerment across BRICS nations?
