FREE/NO CHARGE MISSOURI NONDRIVER LICENSE

If you don't have a valid photo ID, the Missouri Secretary of State's office will help you obtain one (1) nondriver license for free. We can help you obtain the documents you need at no cost to you.

To obtain a nondriver license from the Missouri Department of Revenue, you will need to provide the following:

1. Proof of Name, Date of Birth, Place of Birth

U.S. Birth Certificate **OR** U.S. Passport **OR** U.S. Certificate of Citizenship, Naturalization or Birth Abroad **OR** a photocopy of a certified U.S. Birth Certificate accompanied by a U.S. Military Identification Card / U.S. Military Discharge Papers

2. Social Security Number (verbally or by presenting card)

3. Proof of Missouri Residential Address

Utility Bill – Paycheck – Government Check – Mortgage Document – Voter Identification Card – Property Tax Receipt – Housing Rental Contract – Bank Statement – Homeless Shelter Address – Church Address
