**Antioch Missions Moment**

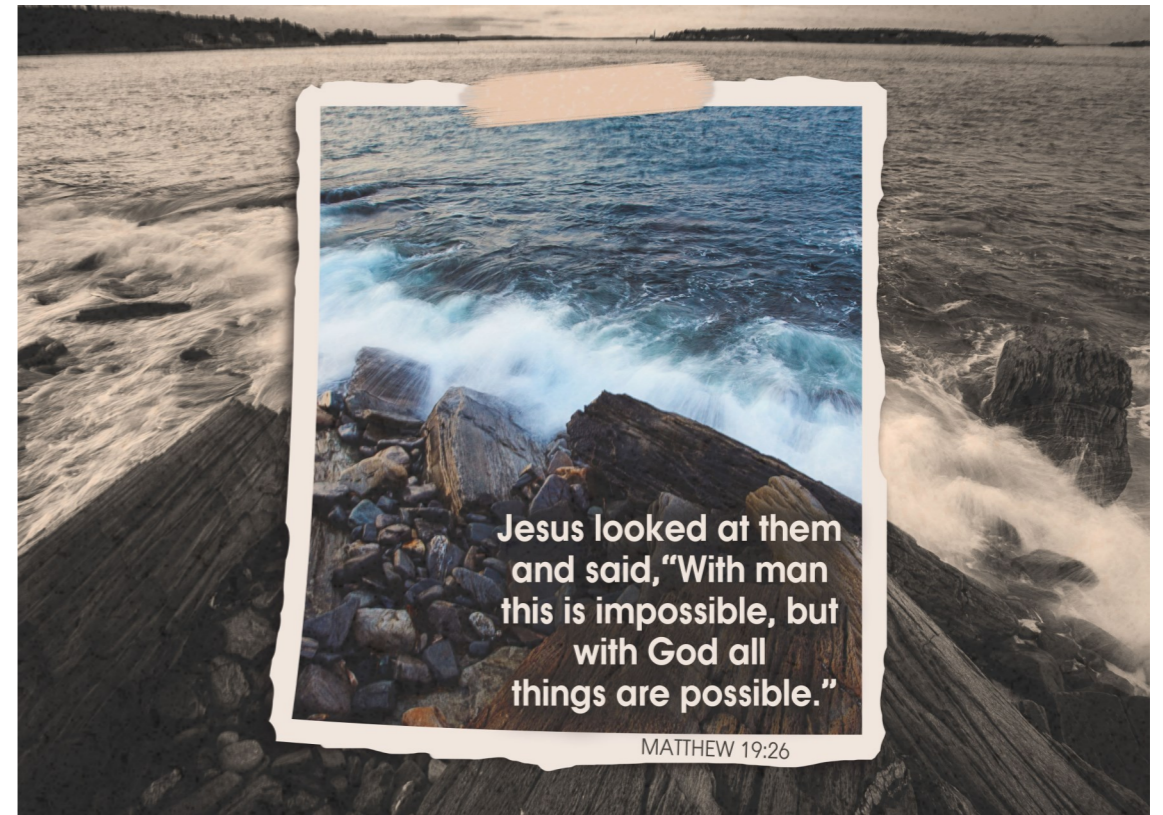

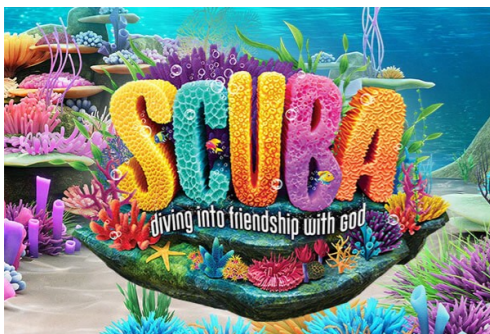
