- Mon 7/1- Pray for God to prepare the hearts of the community to respond and to commit our church's VBS into God's hands. "Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and He will establish your plans." Proverbs 16:3
- Tues 7/2 Ask God to prepare workers for each area and that He will fill any open positions with the people He has called. He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." Luke 10:2
- Wed 7/3- Pray that all needs for supplies, equipment, and food be met and that He would protect all the children and workers during VBS. "Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture." Psalm 37:3
- Thurs 7/4- Pray for our VBS Directors, Ginger Holden & Donna Adams, and those involved in the preparation and planning process. Pray for those who are sharing at the city park tonight. "For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding." Colossians 1:9
- Fri 7/5- Pray that kids and workers will seek Jesus with all their hearts before, during and after VBS. "You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart." Jeremiah 29:13
- Sat 7/6 -Ask God to help everyone involved in VBS to do everything with love. "Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong. Do everything in love." 1 Corinthians 16:13-14
- Sun 7/7 Pray for those working in VBS to be steadfast and excel in the Lord's work. Help them to know their labor is not in vain. "Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. - Mon 7/8- Ask God to help the kids learn how God is a friend who's real. "We believe, and we know you are the Holy One of God." John 6:69
- **Tues 7/9--** Ask God to help the children remember God is a friend who loves. "Just as I have loved you, you should love each other." John 13:34
- Wed 7/10-Ask God to help the children learn God is a friend we can trust. "I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart." John 14:27
- Thurs 7/11- Ask for hearts to be open tonight as the students hear the salvation message. They will learn that God is a friend forever. "I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live, even after dying." John 11:25
- Fri 7/12- Thank God for all the new friendships made this week. Help our children to know and remember that God is surprising. "Let your good deeds shine...so that everyone will praise your Heavenly Father."

- Sat 7/13- Praise God for His word! Pray the children would remember the Bible truths learned this week at VBS. "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path." Psalm 119:105
- Sun 7/14-Ask God to continue to develop the knowledge He has given us through his goodness. Ask that God will give them the courage to follow His plan for their lives. "His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and goodness." 2 Peter 1:3
- Mon 7/15 Ask God to bless the follow-up efforts to contact every participant and invite them to join other church activities. Pray for those making follow-up visits to clearly share the gospel. "If I proclaim the Message, it's not to get something out of it for myself. I'm compelled to do it, and doomed if I don't!" I Corinthians 9:16
