Player Centered Development

What is our Rugby program's definition of success?

We will have promoted mini (kindergarten) to high school rugby as a sign of program success, introducing ages 3 – 18 yr. old boys and girls to a controlled and safe environment and experience. We will have encouraged the players to acquire

beginner to advanced rugby skills and abilities to compete and advance within the sport while having fun. We will have strengthened the club by recruiting from mini's to high schoolers, parent social members, participating, parents, and become a self-funding organization (sponsorships, memberships, fundraisers, program fees).

Team Goals & Objectives

What are our club's goals, objectives, and expectations of our Rugby program? This year? Next five years?

Our goal for year one is to provide ages 3 – 13 yr. old Youth Rugby. Over the next five years, grow the team to include K-12 rugby. Long-term, be acknowledged as a well-organized and prominent local rugby organization.

Organizational Growth

What efforts are we planning to increase our organization's participant base? e.g., Player, coach, referee, administrator, other “[Friends of Rugby](#).”

To increase our Club Base, we plan to recruit mini-age parents and siblings, neighborhood kids, elementary schools, recreation programs, other rugby clubs, former players, and ex-player parents. We plan to begin the season with a [Try-it before you Buy-it program](#) to introduce new and old players. We will recruit parents and former players interested in coaching or refereeing. We will sponsor their certification achievements.
