

REGISTRATION INFORMATION and FORM

Registrations will be most helpful if submitted by August 21. We will continue to accept registrations up to August 31.

Accommodations will be in on-site “houses” with 4-5 bedrooms, a kitchen, living room and 2 shared baths. Bedrooms have 2 twin beds and room for 2 smaller children on floor mats or in a portable bed which a family could bring.

Accessibility is available, so please let us know your needs.

Meals will be simple and will be provided for all participants from Friday evening through Sunday brunch. There are refrigerators in the houses for personal dietary needs.

- o Friday evening: Traditional soup, bread, salad and dessert.
- o Saturday: Breakfast - boiled eggs, fruit, yogurt, cereal, breads. Lunch - taco bar, w/ice cream social. Dinner - veggie/beef lasagna, salad, bread, dessert.
- o Sunday: Brunch - scrambled eggs, cereal, yogurt, bagels, cream cheese, fruit. Coffee, tea available with all meals. Vegan, gluten & dietary concerns honored.

Costs: All costs are Pay as Led. Please do not let finances be a barrier to participation. Please donate as able and led beyond the listed costs to enable all to attend.

The costs that Regional needs to cover will be:

- o \$50 Registration per adult (none for children 18 and under) to cover food, materials, program costs ,etc.
- o \$100/night per one bedroom. Attendees desiring privacy can request a bedroom that is not shared. However please share, when possible, to allow more people to attend! If you would like to share, please designate the person and divide the cost as you like. The planning committee cannot guarantee to find roommates for you, but, if asked, we will do our best to connect people requesting a roommate. The field station provides blankets and a pillow for each bed. If not renting linens, participants need to bring a sleeping bag or sheets, towels, wash cloths for their own use. OR, add a \$10 one-time charge if you would like the site to provide sheets and towels (same \$10 fee for one or two nights).
