



## POPPY CONTEST (Theme - “Rosie” inspired and/or Juniors)

Categories are:

Theme Arrangement, Poppy Corsage and Poppy Hat (Scarf).

Details on the contest are shown below. Create unusual ways to spotlight the poppy. The poppy, its story and how the money is used are great Public Relations opportunities. Sharing the stories of how poppy funds are spent helps build our image in the community and can also promote membership.

### RULES FOR POPPY JUDGING AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY

Categories: Theme Arrangement  
Poppy Corsage  
Poppy Hat (or scarf)

- Rules:
1. Poppies to be used MUST be the standard four (4) petal Poppies made with red crepe paper with stems of green paper and centers of black and green.
  2. A Unit may enter only their 1<sup>st</sup> place winner in arrangements, corsages and/or hats (scarves) at the District level.
  3. The American Flag may be used in an arrangement, but it MUST be the highest point of the arrangement and the Flag.
  5. Artificial greenery and Baby’s breath may be used in an arrangement, corsage and/or hat (scarf), but NO OTHER flowers may be used.
  6. “Rosie” inspired and/or Juniors may be incorporated in every category.
  7. Nothing disrespectful will be allowed. All arrangements, corsages and/or hats (scarves) must be in good taste.
  8. Arrangements may be made to be placed on a table or to hang on the wall.
  9. Each Unit or District can award prizes at their own discretion, but only the First (1<sup>st</sup>) place winners from each District in each category should be taken to the Department Convention in June to be judged at the Department level.
  10. At the Department level, in each category, First (1<sup>st</sup>) will be awarded a special prize, Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) and Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) places will receive a certificate.
