<p>Creativity/Originality (35%)</p>	<p>Original moves, “island” and “surf culture” names of moves, the moves align with the vibes of the song, and each of the 3 original moves are demonstrated for 30 seconds each</p>	<p>Students show that they are competent and understand the dances, moves, and vibes of the song, but have varied lengths of how long they demonstrate each move (not 30 seconds per move)</p>	<p>Students understanding of putting together moves that match vibes are satisfactory at best</p>	<p>Fails to create new moves and is not original in carrying out the dance</p>
<p>Style/Enthusiasm (15%)</p>	<p>Dress (costumes), rhythm, enthusiasm, and confidence is displayed during the performance</p>	<p>Meets three out of four of the criteria</p>	<p>Meets two out of the four criteria</p>	<p>Does not meet criteria, no enthusiasm at all</p>

<p>Introduction, (10%)</p>	<p>Brief history of how you came about learning and naming the moves, and personal explanations of the basics of skanking</p>	<p>States history of the dance, how it came about, and shares how one came to name it, but is lacking in detail</p>	<p>Meets one out of two of the criteria</p>	<p>Does not meet criteria</p>
<p>Explanation, and Details of the Original Moves (30%)</p>	<p>Clear explanation of the moves ensure the reader's ability to perform them, details of moves include other variations of this move (i.e. spinning around, locomotor, or non-locomotor)</p>	<p>Explanation is written in a way, which readers can follow, and the moves include locomotor or non-locomotor movements</p>	<p>Explanation and details are written in a vague tone</p>	<p>Explanation of details and original moves are not present</p>
<p>Performance Cues (10%)</p>	<p>The cues align with the moves, and the short phrases or words describe intended movements</p>	<p>Cues are in alignment with movements and description present</p>	<p>Cues are not always aligned with movements or description</p>	<p>Cues aren't present on paper and not aligned with dance</p>
