**YEAR END AWARDS:**

The following are the qualifications needed to qualify for End Of Year Awards for Exceptional Riders:

- 1) Be a current member in good standing.
- 2) Participate at 4 show dates during the current year.

**FEE SCHEDULE:**

**\$ 6.00** - Exhibition warm-up classes(Exhibition Running).  
**\$12.00** - Exhibition warm-up classes(Hunter).  
**\$20.00** - Jackpot classes.  
**\$12.00** - All other classes.  
**\$35.00/day or \$60/weekend** - Stall fee  
**\$20.00/day** - Any horse on grounds without a stall.  
**\$ 9.00** - Shavings per bag (2 bags per stall required by Wills Park Equestrian Center).  
**\$10.00/day** - Office fee per horse/rider combination.  
**\$10.00/day** - EMT / Security fee  
**\$25.00** - Non preregistered fee – *save \$25.00 per horse/rider combination by preregistering! (Waived for first time showing RHSC)*  
**\$10.00** - Non member fee per horse/rider combination.  
**\$35.00** - Returned check fee (plus bank charges). **\$10.00** - Check Completion Fee.
