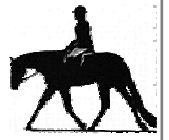

**YEAR END AWARDS:**

The following are the qualifications needed to qualify for End Of Year Awards for Exceptional Riders:

- 1) Be a current member in good standing.
- 2) Participate at 4 show dates during the current year.

**FEE SCHEDULE:**

- \$5.00** - Exhibition warm-up classes.
- \$9.00** - All other classes.
- \$25.00**- Stall fee
- \$20.00**- Any horse on grounds without a stall.
- \$8.00** - Shavings per bag (2 bags per stall required by Wills Park Equestrian Center).
- \$10.00**- Office fee per horse/rider combination.
- \$5.00** - EMT fee
- \$10.00**- Non preregistered fee – *save \$10.00 per horse/rider combination by preregistering!*
- \$5.00** - Non member fee per horse/rider combination.
- \$35.00**- Returned check fee (plus bank charges).
- \$5.00** - Check Completion Fee.

**SHOW OFFICE HOURS:** 6:30 a.m. to 7:45 / 8:00 to 5:30 / 5:45 till the end of show on show day / 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Friday before the show.

\*All exhibitors must check in at the show office and leave a signed, open check (or pay show bill in advance) even if preregistered.\*
