\$24 – All Open Ring classes (Double Judged)

\$35/day or \$60/Weekend – Stall fee

\$20 – Any horse on grounds without a stall

\$9 – Shavings per bag (2 bags per stall required by Wills Park Equestrian Center)

\$10/day – Office fee per horse/rider combination

\$10/day – EMT/Security fee

\$25 – Non-preregistered fee – save \$25 per horse/rider combination by pre-registering! (Waived for first time showing RHSC)

\$10 – Non-member fee per horse/rider combination

\$35 – Returned check fee (plus bank charges)

\$10.00 – Check completion fee

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: 6:30 a.m. to 7:45 / 8:00 to 4:30 / 4:45 till the end of show on show day

5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Friday before the show.

All exhibitors must check in at the show office and leave a signed, open check (or pay show bill in advance) even if pre-registered.

PREREGISTRATION CLOSES on Wednesday at 6 PM prior to the show. No exceptions.

OPEN RING RULES:

- Open Halter is open to English or Western but must be shown in a halter.
- In-Hand Trail is open to all horses and any disciplines.
- Intro to Ranch Horse W/J (class 57) riders may not cross-enter any other ranch horse classes except Halter.
- Intro to Trail (class 65) riders may not cross-enter any other trail classes except In-Hand Trail.
