THERE'S SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE IN **AUSTIN, MINNESOTA.**

BIRDING: Austin-area birding sites include: Jay C. Hormel Nature Center, Taopi Prairie Interpretive Area, Lake Louise State Park, Shooting Star Prairie SNA and Wild Indigo Prairie SNA.

ARCHERY: Cedar River Archery Club: All are invited to 3D public shoot dates throughout the year.

CANOEING / KAYAKING: Cedar River State Water Trail runs for about 25 miles from the village of Lansing to the Minnesota-Iowa border. Equipment rentals at the Jay C. Hormel Nature Center.

BIKING: Austin City Trails offer 13 miles of hard-surfaced trails that connect you to many locations within the city and to the Shooting Star Trail, an asphalt trail on top of abandoned railway through the communities of Rose Creek, Adams, Taopi, Lake Louise State Park and Leroy for a total of over 40 miles. Equipment rentals at the Rydjour Bike Shop.

HIKING: Jay C. Hormel Nature Center is 529 acres with miles of trails. Lake Louise State Park is 1,168 acres and known for hiking on miles of interpretive trails.

HUNTING: Austin area has 14 Wildlife Management areas, Cedar Valley Conservation Club and 3 Arrows Hunting Preserve.

SNOWMOBILING: Mower County has 200 miles of trails that connect to more than 800 miles of trails in Southern Minnesota.

FISHING: Austin area has Eastside Lake, Wolf Creek within Todd Park, Mill Pond and the Cedar River State Water Trail.

Located just 90 minutes south of Minneapolis-St. Paul.
