Renewing *Passport* Visitor Stamps!

All visitors staying in the Placencia area are required to renew their passport stamps every 30 days at the Immigration Department in Big Creek.

RVBelize guests have two options for getting to/from the offices located just across the lagoon. 1. Take the Hokey-Pokey water taxi from M&M service station in the village, then grab a taxi at the port or 2. Drive the scenic Southern Hwy to Independence (one hour each way).
