Buses are the primary mode of transportation for Belizeans and routes run on regular schedules throughout the country. Work day routes usually run from 5am to 9pm.

Bus companies offer two types of services: "Regular" and "Express". Regular buses stop for passengers anywhere along the route, while Express (or non-stop) buses only stop at main towns. The final destination of each bus is displayed in its front window.

Water temperatures fluctuate very little in Belize, ranging from 27-30°C throughout the year. Most divers are perfectly comfortable in a shorty or skinsuit. Visibility is good, fluctuating between 20-30 meters on most sites. Overall, the best time to visit Belize for diving is May, when you'll enjoy excellent diving conditions and low tourist numbers, not to mention that is also whale shark season!
