- ➤ Pre-event Foundation (1 Cor 11.2-16)
  - Concept #1: Honor vs. Dishonor (11.2-6)
  - Concept #2: Glory of God vs. Glory of Man (11.7-9, 11-15)
  - Concept #3: Heavenly angelic hosts vs. Satanic angelic hosts (11.10)
  - Centerpiece: Honoring God, glorying God, declaring God all about God
  - Common Thread for the next paragraph

- ➢ Problems ( 1 Cor 11.17-22)
  - Summary: Not a good thing but a bad thing (11.17)
  - Self (11.18-22)
    - Selfish divisions (11.17-18)
    - Selfish leaders (11.19)
    - Selfish actions (11.20-22)
    - Selfless results (11.19)—despise = scorn

- > Personal (1 Cor 11.27-34)
  - "Unworthy manner" (v 27)
    - Distinction: This is different from our worthiness as undone sinners; in Christ, we are able to approach God (Hb 4.14-16)
    - Difference: Behavior in similarity to the self-focus of the Corinthians is to treat the Lord's sacrifice in an irreverent & careless manner
    - Discussion: Are we, am I guilty of careless or negligence or irreverence of the Lord's supper

- ➤ Personal (1 Cor 11.27-34)
  - Worthwhile introspection
    - Proper evaluation: This leads to a self-judgment that we respond to (v 31)
    - Proper results: This removes oneself from the chastening of the Lord and removal of the type of judgment that the world would receive, i.e. severe (vv 31-32)
    - Program note: This judgment is of physical chastening, not loss of salvation

- > Personal (1 Cor 11.27-34)
  - Worth Manner at the "Love Feast" (vv 33-34)
    - Idea: "The Love Feast Meal" was combined with the "Lord's Supper"
    - Waiting on one another: An act of selflessness (v 33) vs.
      "each one taking his own supper ahead of others" (v 21)
    - One's appetites: Satisfy those hunger pangs at home (v. 34)

- > Principles
  - NOTE: No frank protocols explained in the NT; must rely on principles and derived practices from such principles
  - ■P#1: We are to remember the Lord Jesus (Body & blood)
    - □ Focus will be on the person and work of Christ
    - Worship will inevitably erupt to God concerning his Son
  - P#2: Personal and corporate self-evaluation is a necessity prior to partaking—avoiding chastening of the Lord

- > Principles
  - P2#: Personal and corporate self-evaluation (cont'd)
    - Self can easily consume glory away from the Lord
    - Guarding against such covert self is a must
    - On occasion, self examination may be prolonged for the purpose of cultivating & verifying genuineness of heart

- > Principles
  - P2#: Practical Implications (cont'd)
    - Musical accompaniment and spiritual songs are not eliminated; but we remove central musical leadership and accompaniment to preserve attention to Christ
    - Missing: Physical leader so as to not rob attention from Christ
    - Meal: Love feast has been converted to a time of only remembrance and appetites are dealt with at home

- > Principles
  - P#3: Other doctrines of God
    - Doctrines of Christ: Headship of the church local/universal, divinely authorized expressed though gender roles & head covering (1 Cor 11.2-16, 14.34-35,1 Tim 2.12); no "chairman"
    - Doctrine of the Holy Spirit:
      - ✓ Who leads the body in correct direction (Acts 13.2)
      - ✓ Unto Christ (Jn 15.26)
      - ✓ In unity (Eph 4.3): Thus, cohesive and harmonious in our thoughts to God

- > Principles
  - P#3: Other doctrines of God (cont'd)
    - Doctrine of the New Creation:
      - ✓Priests who are tasked to offer up spiritual sacrifices to God (1 Pt 2.5)
      - ✓ Gifting(s): Expression of such will be through the gifting God has given—some serving gift/some speaking gift (1 Pt 4.10)

- > Principles
  - P#3: Other doctrines of God (cont'd)
    - Doctrine of God: Peace/order (1 Cor 14.26-33, 40)
      - ✓ No precise order in the NT, but order is important (33, 40)
      - ✓ Saints prepared: "You come together, each has a psalm ...teaching...tongue...revelation...interpretation" (26a)
      - ✓ Saints built up: As above, in remembering Him (26b)
      - ✓ Saints use gifts: E.g., Tongue speakers/interpreters/ prophets, etc. are exercising their gifts (27-29a)

- > Principles
  - P#3: Other doctrines of God (cont'd)
    - □ Doctrine of God: Order (1 Cor 14.26-33,40), cont'd
      - ✓ Other Saints: Listening and evaluating (29b)
      - ✓ Spontaneous Saints prepared: One may have a thought through the Spirit and is given opportunity to share as the first speaker becomes silent—(30b-31a)
      - ✓ Saints Edified: in remembering Him (26b, 31b)

- > Principles
  - P#3: Other doctrines of God (cont'd)
    - □ Doctrine of God: Order (1 Cor 14.26-33, 40), cont'd
      - ✓ Saints are orderly: E.g., Limits with tongue gifts with the stipulation of interpreters (27-28)
      - ✓ Saints express themselves one by one—i.e. gifts not out of control, but under control—Implying maximum body benefit (31)
      - ✓ In short: Gifts are not meant for show

- **>**Summary
  - The purpose: Remembrance & its resultant worship is to glorify God
  - The primary thing: Christ in his person and work
  - The procedure: Healthy personal & corporate self-examination
  - The process: We evaluate whether the things we do will maximally bring attention to Christ or rob attention from Christ
  - The proclamation: It is of Christ and His doctrines which are simultaneously displayed
  - The point: Worship in spirit and truth (Jn 4.21-24)
