

WATER FRONT and Miscellaneous Rules

- We are not responsible for injuries from using the waterfront activities. Use at your own risk. Drugs and alcohol use is prohibited while using.
- Children under 18 must have adult signature on this waiver saying that there is health insurance coverage to obtain medical treatment if needed.
- Adults need to provide supervision of children on the waterfront at all times.
- Anyone using the waterfront activities must have a wristband obtained from the office at check in.
- Tubes and rafts are recommended to be used on the waterslide. The slide is faster and more comfortable with use of tubes, rafts and boards without fins. **DON'T WALK UP THE SLIDE**

WATERCRAFT

- Designate a driver for boats and pontoons. Drugs/alcohol use prohibited for drivers.
- Fishing requires license and ID.
- All watercraft require life jacket use. Those are available on the beach rack where the watercraft are stored or in the office. Wristbands are required to use the SUP boards, kayaks, canoes, and waterslide. Paddles are located near or on the rack or ask at the office. Put things back after finished.
- Park and drive boats away from the swimming areas and slide path.
- Row boats are free for guests staying on site but require lifejackets on the boat for each person. Make sure there is a plug in place and an anchor on board. Do not leave your trash on the watercraft or boats when finished and secure to a dock or anchor on shore when finished. Report any damages to the office.
- We reserve the right to charge for damages caused by your negligent behavior.
- Wave runners and jet skis can be used here safely but must follow the boater safety rules. We do not supply these but welcome you to bring or rent them to enjoy.
- Be reminded that for the motor vehicles **NO WAKE IS FROM 7:30PM UNTIL 11:00AM.**
- If renting a pontoon return keys to the office when finished and if gas is needed please see Charlie for purchase. We are not responsible for your items left on boats if damaged or lost.

- Please enjoy your games or those provided here for you but use basic safety and caution. There are several swing set play areas for children to use. It is possible to get injured doing anything. We offer volley ball, horse shoes, tether ball and basketball hoop, grills, firepits, boat launch and pavilion along with the waterfront activities.
- Respect others. Quiet time is 11pm and after. No smoking of marijuana in public areas. Confine that to your own space. Rowdiness is not tolerated from people or pets. If complaints are made you will be warned and then asked to leave if it continues.
- Pets remain in the designated areas only.
- Visitors must sign in at the office if using the waterfront activities or bringing pets.
- The pavilion is to be used freely by all who stay and visit here unless it has been reserved and rented for a specific period of time and posted as such. Take your own garbage to the dumpster and clean off your tables. We accept returnables and can burn the cardboard.
- The fish cleaning shed is provided with water and light over the table and is located in the corner of the circle drive parking areas. There is a garbage can there for fish entrails. We bury those so never put them in the dumpster.
- Firepits and grills are cleaned out by us once per week usually Fridays. If you need to dump cold ashes and coals those can be collected and put in the dumpster. Never dump the hot coals anywhere.
- **Waterfront hours of operation are from 9am to 9pm for waterslide and kayaks, canoes, row boats, paddle boat and SUP boards that are provided by us for your use.**

We are of the opinion that woods, water and sunshine are good for anyone and that risk of catching a virus in this environment outside is minimal. However, you are responsible for social distancing and/or wearing a mask if wanted. We do not require this nor will we be able to monitor your safety. If there are complaints they will be addressed as they happen on a case by case situation.
