



COVID-19 Guidelines

Playing Golf at DAGC

DAGC You MUST book your tee time before arriving at DAGC.
You CANNOT play/attend unless you have booked!

Tee times can be made 6 days in advance by booking online directly @ masterscoreboard.co.uk, or you can visit the Club website. To gain access to the 'members only' side of website (www.dagc.org.uk), you must be a member and have registered. To register (if you haven't done so already), press the link 'Register' and a pin number will be emailed to you within a few days.

Maximum 9 holes bookable per day per player – ALL holes will be played 'outside the wire' only (playing order will be: 12 – 18, followed by holes 1 & 2, leaving the course via the fence-line of the Driving Range).

Under new Government rules released on 28 May, the following groupings are permitted:

- Up to 4 golfers from four separate households may now play together in one single group, **provided strict 'social distancing' of 2m is adhered to at all times.**

Driving Range Use:

- **Open (not bookable).** Max 2 persons at any one time. Please ensure your golf practice balls are clearly marked. **DO NOT** hit balls if person(s) in range, **golfers/dog walkers will be walking along the fence-line to exit course.**

Before your round

- Please arrive no more than 15 mins before your tee time. Wash hands.
- All players must have their own equipment, no sharing of equipment is permitted.
- Players must only go to the 12th hole (starting hole) when those playing in the group ahead have cleared. Please keep to 'booked' tee times (10 min intervals).

On the course

- Players must always keep 2m apart at all times, including teeing areas & greens.
- Stray balls must not be touched.
- If you lose your ball, please take initial look and if not found drop another ball down. Please try to keep play moving if the course is busy!
- **Flagsticks must not be touched/removed.**
- No rakes in bunkers, please use your feet or club to best smooth areas in bunkers. New Local rule – Preferred lies allowed in bunkers until further notice.

After the round

- Players must not shake hands at the end of the round.
- Golfers must leave the course immediately after their round. When finishing on 2nd hole, please walk back via the fenceline of the Driving Range, ensuring 'Social Distancing' of 2m is maintained at all times. Wash hands before leaving GC.
