### Kimberlee Singler extradited from UK, now in custody in 4<sup>th</sup> Judicial District

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo. – Kimberlee Singler, a Colorado Springs woman sought on allegations of first-degree murder and attempted first-degree murder before fleeing to the United Kingdom, has been returned to the United States on December 23, 2025, and is currently being held in custody in the 4<sup>th</sup> Judicial District.

An arrest warrant was issued on behalf of the State of Colorado for Ms. Singler, following the December 19, 2023, murders of two of her three children and the significant injury inflicted on the third. She was taken into custody by authorities in the United Kingdom on December 30, 2023.

Extradition from the United Kingdom is controlled by a treaty between the United States and the United Kingdom that was signed in 2003. Neither the United States nor the 4<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office has influence over the pace of the extradition proceedings.

The 4<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office has filed the following charges against Ms. Singler:

**Murder in the First Degree (after deliberation and with intent), CRS 18-3-102(1)(a), a Class One Felony (two counts)**

**Murder in the First Degree (child victim under 12 yoa), CRS 18-3-102(1)(f), a Class One Felony (two counts)**

**Criminal Attempt to Commit Murder in the First Degree, CRS 18-3-102(1)(f); 18-2-101, a Class Two Felony**

**Assault in the First Degree, CRS 18-3-202(1)(a), a Class Three Felony**

Criminal charges are merely allegations and Kimberlee Singler, like all persons accused of a crime, is considered innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
