### 1:1 Tutoring, Mentoring, Facilitation of Independent Assignment Progress

Description: Some scholars benefit best from a combination of 1:1 and small group, classroom instruction, guidance, & mentorship. Dr. Lowder, as well as select faculty, will offer 1:1 sessions in 30-minute chunks to support individual student. Dr. Lowder and/or faculty will use our professional judgement to determine how to best utilize scheduled 1:1 sessions to support the learner in working towards shared academic, engagement, and growth-oriented goals. Parents may elect to register, upfront, to secure regularly scheduled 1:1 sessions, during the 21-22 academic year registration process. ### Director &/or Faculty Consultations, Meetings, Strategic Sessions, Etc.

Description: All Academy families are provided an initial consultation during the enrollment process. These consultations take place via a virtual meeting, phone call, email, text, &/or a combination of these communication tools.

Student-Parent-Faculty conferences are held once each fall and spring; the fall conference is a student-led meeting.

In addition to these opportunities, parents may request to schedule further consultation, strategizing for support, clarification, etc., with faculty and/or Dr. Lowder, as needed.

It is the goal of the director to schedule such meetings within one week of the request being submitted via email, by parents.
