Suggestions include teeth floating, vaccinations, and gelding. A fee would be collected on top of any services rendered by the vet which would go into the club bank account. 
Feb, Mar – drawn at April meeting. Everyone at this night's meeting received an entry! The more you participate the more chances you have to win.

One of our sources will be our 4H members as they need to work on this for that organization; it will be a great opportunity for us all to learn, for the kids to polish their skills, and most importantly get youth interaction back into the Club. **<u>4H Leadership Monthly and Quarterly Meetings</u> –** Kena brought to the membership that the Pierce County 4H leadership is looking for a place to hold their meetings on a consistent basis. Sharon Taylor moved to offer the club house to the 4H leadership for no charge. It was seconded and discussion proceeded. Kena does not believe they would be willing to pay for the use of the club house but suggests it would provide exposure of MRC to a wider 4H audience.
