



Camping Rules and Etiquette

1. The main gate will be open at noon on the Friday before show weekend. Note: arriving before noon will result in waiting in the parking lot.
2. No reserving or blocking of spots. Parking and camping are done on a first come, first served basis.
3. Respect your fellow campers and our neighbors, maintain Quiet Time between 10pm – 6am.
4. Don't alter trees or vegetation. Highlining of horse(s) is ok with use of tree savers. No tying directly to trees.
5. If your horse digs holes, you are required to fill them in prior to leaving.
6. Self-penning must not block an open spot for parking. You will be asked to take down the pen if it is blocking a parking space.
7. No shavings or bedding of any kind.
8. NO fires, wood/or propane firepits. Raised BBQ stove is allowed, unless otherwise posted.
9. All dogs are to be kept on a leash at all times.
10. Roadway must remain clear. No vehicles or trailers blocking or parked in roadway. Garbage – Leave no trace!! What you pack in must be packed out.
11. All vehicles other than trucks and trailers are to be parked in the parking lot next to clubhouse.
12. NO Motorhomes or travel trailers. Motorhomes that pull horse trailer will be permitted.
13. Trailers with awnings - will not be permitted to extend awnings that block another space.
14. MRC has dry camping only. Campers are not to stretch hoses across the road or hook up their personal hoses to the water supply.
15. Clubhouse will be locked on Friday and Saturday night. Porta Potties will be available next to the practice arena.
16. Parents are to ensure that children are not running through other campsites.
17. Once the main arena has been prepped and watered for the next day, it will remain closed for the remainder of the night. The practice arena may be used at any time.
18. Outside of the arena horses are to remain at a walk.
19. Vehicles on the property must be attended. MRC will not be held responsible for any damage to vehicles on the property.
20. Gates are to remain closed at all times during the night.

Camping Procedure

1. Camping is for Members only. If you have not paid your annual membership it can be paid on site or on-line.
2. Upon arrival, campers must check-in with designated grounds volunteers. (They will be wearing an orange vest for the purpose to easily identify who to speak to.)
3. Since spots first come, first serve, you may pick your spot and the grounds volunteer will ensure that camper is only taking up the spot with appropriate size for their truck and trailer.
4. This year we have implemented a camping fee. This fee will go to combat the additional garbage cost and support a local 4H group or WAHSET Team member to come in and help restore the grounds.
