Weed Report - John updated pods have been evaluated and appears to have fewer weeds this year. Diquat has been approved. It is half the price of other chemicals and broader spectrum. Diquat is used cautiously when stocking the lake. Blue Lake is stalked with Walleye's even years in the fall, so not a worry this year.

Brad Brown – Shared his phone number and said call anytime – 763-260-0381 he has been installed as a Supervisor of Spencer Brook township. It was approved he can be Blue Lake liaison. Brad is being trained by Loren Daudt for road maintenance. Brad has removed the road restriction signs. Next Township Meeting May 10th. Chris Erickson will present concerns of the North access. Support for the meeting would be appreciated. Brad mentioned May 1st Spencer Brook cleanup day.

Boat monitoring – Jill reported monitors have been hired and ready to start the season. Isanti county request an invoice for the \$7800.00 which appears new this year. Don will provide an invoice if they require for the monitors.

North Landing Concerns – Brad Brown from Spencer Brook township still supports the closing of the North access but fears consequences of closing. He reviewed the history of the acquisition of the landing and reports Bill Fredell's history is accurate of the past history of the acquisition of the access. Concerns were shared about access load issues on the East Access and need for strong supervision of parking by county Sheriff. Don Davies presented the idea of communication to the access users on the board of the landing.

Tiger Street Rain Gardens – Don discussed Sam Hass has maintained the gardens in the past and has agreed to maintain this summer. Sam requested \$100.00. Don motioned to accept the charge. Seconded and approved.
