The Kentucky General Assembly has invested \$3 million in creation of We Lead CS - a statewide, virtual career academy to expand students' access to computer science education and bolster Kentucky's competitiveness in the tech economy. We Lead CS believes Kentucky's Chambers of Commerce will be essential partners in our work, and we're offering \$100,000 in micro grants in 2025 for Chambers willing to take the lead in developing Kentucky's tech talent pipleine.



Who's eligible to apply?

Applications must be submitted by a Chamber of Commerce but can include multiple partner organizations in your community.

How much money may we request?

Chambers may request grants up to \$20,000. We Lead CS will award \$100,000 in micro grants for 2025.
