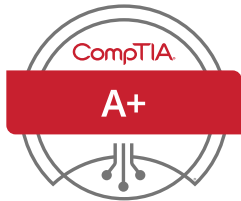

Volunteer Opportunities for Tech Professionals

◆ Virtual Career Connections (Fall – 1 hour)

Share your story in a 15-minute presentation about your role, career path, and a “day in the life.” Present to three groups of students in a single hour.

◆ Virtual Job Shadowing (Spring – 1 hour)

Host a 45-minute “virtual field trip” of your workplace (if appropriate). Show your team in action, projects you’re proud of, and your work culture.

◆ Project Mentoring (Fall/Spring, 20–30 minutes, 2x per semester)

Meet with a small group to review their tech projects, offer advice, and share professional tips.

◆ Mock Interviews (Spring – 1 hour)

Conduct short practice interviews to help students strengthen communication and interview skills.

◆ Guest Trainer (Fall and/or Spring)

Lead a hands-on workshop on a tech topic like GitHub, Agile, cybersecurity, cloud tools, or project management.

◆ Topic Spotlight Speaker (Fall and/or Spring – 20–30 minutes)

Give a focused, engaging talk on a tool, method, or concept you use—like DevOps, GitHub, Agile, or PM.
