

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

### BETWEEN

**WIFI FOUNDATION (Women Innovators Foundation Incubation – WIFI NPO) for Women Entrepreneurs**, Pune, Maharashtra, India (hereinafter referred to as “WIFI Foundation”)

**WIFI Foundation NPO for Women Entrepreneurs** envisions a transformative entrepreneurial movement aligned with the national mission of **VISION VIKSIT BHARAT** and the regional aspirations of **VISION VIKSIT Konkan, VISION VIKSIT Vidarbha and VISION VIKSIT Marathwada**. In alignment with **NEP 2020**, which emphasizes innovation, multidisciplinary learning and entrepreneurship, and the **UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**—especially SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 5 (Gender Equality), SDG 8 (Decent Work & Economic Growth), and SDG 9 (Industry, Innovation & Infrastructure), the Foundation is committed to achieve **100% Employability** by nurturing innovation-driven Startups and MSMEs, ensuring meaningful, skill-oriented and future-ready opportunities for all.



Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Technological University was established by the Government of Maharashtra vide Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Technological University Act. No. XXII of 1989 as a Unitary University. Later, the Government of Maharashtra converted this University to the Affiliating Technological University since 2016 vide Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Technological



University Act No. XXIX of 2014 with the jurisdiction of the University as the entire state of Maharashtra. Presently, 272 institutes are affiliated with the University and the total student strength is 1,36,534.


The sprawling 468 acres of the campus of this University provides as a sanctum seat of learning across the state. The University attracts meritorious students from the entire state and molds them into employable engineers and competent technocrats. This University provides well-equipped laboratories with testing and analysis facilities that can be extended for the benefit of the industries. In addition, the University offers facilities like conference hall, auditorium, playground, workshop, and computing facilities. The University has spacious and good hostels with all the basic amenities.

The University is blessed with highly qualified faculty members who are committed to impart the best kind of knowledge through an effective teaching-learning process. The faculty and staff of the University believe that achieving excellence is a challenging task and they continuously strive for it. University also provides a conducive environment and opportunities to the students for research and innovation which leads to creating entrepreneurs. The University is empowered to affiliate Institutions that offer UG, PG, and Ph.D. level programs in the disciplines of Engineering, Pharmacy, Architecture, and Hotel Management & Catering Technology.

The main thrust of the University is to develop and provide state-of-the-art infrastructure and an excellent academic and research environment for its faculty and students. The university has kept pace with the times by introducing the CBCS system, multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary programs – courses. It has an efficient and transparent governance system, support for researchers, clean and green campus, gender-friendly atmosphere, ample opportunity for students to hone their skills in co-curricular activities, technologically equipped classrooms and laboratories, a state-of-the-art library, an incubation center titled, “DBATU Forum of Innovation, Incubation & Enterprise” (Section-8 Company) with support from Maharashtra State Innovation Society, a nodal agency of Govt. of Maharashtra, well equipped health center with practicing medical professionals. The university has already started implementing provisions of the NEP 2020.

## 1. PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed to establish a long-term collaborative partnership between WIFI Foundation and DBATU to jointly create a **statewide, self-sustainable, outcome-oriented entrepreneurial ecosystem**. Both the parties aim to promote innovation, startups, incubation, consultancy, skill development, research commercialization, and global academic collaborations across DBATU and its affiliated institutes.



## 2. DURATION OF THE MoU

- i. This MoU shall be valid for a period of **five (5) years** from the signing date.
- ii. It may be **extended further** by mutual written consent at the end of the term.

## 3. FORMATION OF COMPANIES UNDER THE DBATU-WIFI ECOSYSTEM

WIFI Foundation shall facilitate the creation of **up to 12 companies** across DBATU main campus and all affiliated institutes, as follows:

### 3.1 List of Entities

- a) **DBATU-WIFI FOUNDATION INCUBATION NPO up to INR 232 Cr Revenue Generation**
- b) **Centre of Excellence of Consultancy Pvt. Ltd.** (Domains: IPR / Finance / Educational / Industry Consultancy)
  - 100 IP GRANTED PATENTs Portfolio per Institute with ZERO Fees (**Refer Appendix B**)
  - For Startups/ MSME ZERO Professional Fees for IP Patent TM Design till Grant (**Refer Appendix C**)
  - Finance all kind of Funding/ Subsidies/ Grants/ Loans etc
  - Industrial / Educational Consultancy Services under single umbrella of every Incubation at DBATU University affiliated Campuses
- c) **Ten (10) Startup LLPs / Pvt Ltd Companies** formed by DBATU stakeholders.

## 4. FUNDING STRUCTURE

- a) Total cost for incorporation and making each entity **successful, sustainable and scalable: INR 13,33,333 + GST per company** (**refer APPENDIX A: FUNDING for Women Entrepreneurs**)
- b) Funding contributions:
  - **WIFI Foundation: 75% (Seed Funding)**
  - **DBATU: 25%**
- c) Funding includes:
  - Incorporation
  - Branding, Marketing, Compliance



## 6. REFUND & EQUITY BUYBACK OPTION FOR DBATU

- i. DBATU's 25% contribution = **INR 3,33,333** per startup.
- ii. After **3 years**, DBATU may choose any one of the following options:

### Option A : Continue Stake

DBATU keeps its **20% equity stake** permanently.

### Option B : Exit & Refund

- WIFI Foundation shall **refund INR 3,33,333** to DBATU.
- DBATU will **transfer 100% of its equity (20%)** to WIFI Foundation.

This aligns with the **3-year lifecycle** of incubated startups.


## 7. REPRESENTATION & BRAND USAGE RIGHTS

DBATU authorizes WIFI Foundation to:

- iii. All event expenses will be borne under **DBATU-WIFI Incubation Ecosystem**, not separately by DBATU.
- iv. WIFI Foundation shall execute **branding, promotion and outreach** activities for DBATU at national and international levels.



DBATU will provide **upfront expenses**, while WIFI Foundation ensures **goals, planning and execution**.

## 9. NON-COMPLIANCE CLAUSE — MOUs ONLY VALID WHEN BOTH PARTIES PERFORM

If either party fails to fulfil their assigned responsibilities, this MoU shall be considered **NULL AND VOID** and:

- No party shall be held liable for commitments beyond termination.
- All obligations cease without penalty.

## 10. PROFIT MARGIN CLAUSE FOR CONSULTANCY & STARTUPS

- i. All 12 entities (Consultancy CoE + Startups) shall operate with **10% profit margin only while they remain under the DBATU-WIFI Incubation ecosystem.**
- ii. When they exit incubation and start bearing full expenses themselves (operations, staffing, infra, offices, resources, etc.) **only then the profit margins will be calculated at actual commercial market levels.**

## 11. INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATIONS

WIFI Foundation shall execute multiple **International MoUs** with:

These collaborations will strengthen DBATU's global visibility and student opportunities.




## 16. TERMINATION



Either party may terminate this MoU with **90 days written notice**, subject to the non-compliance clause in Section 9.
