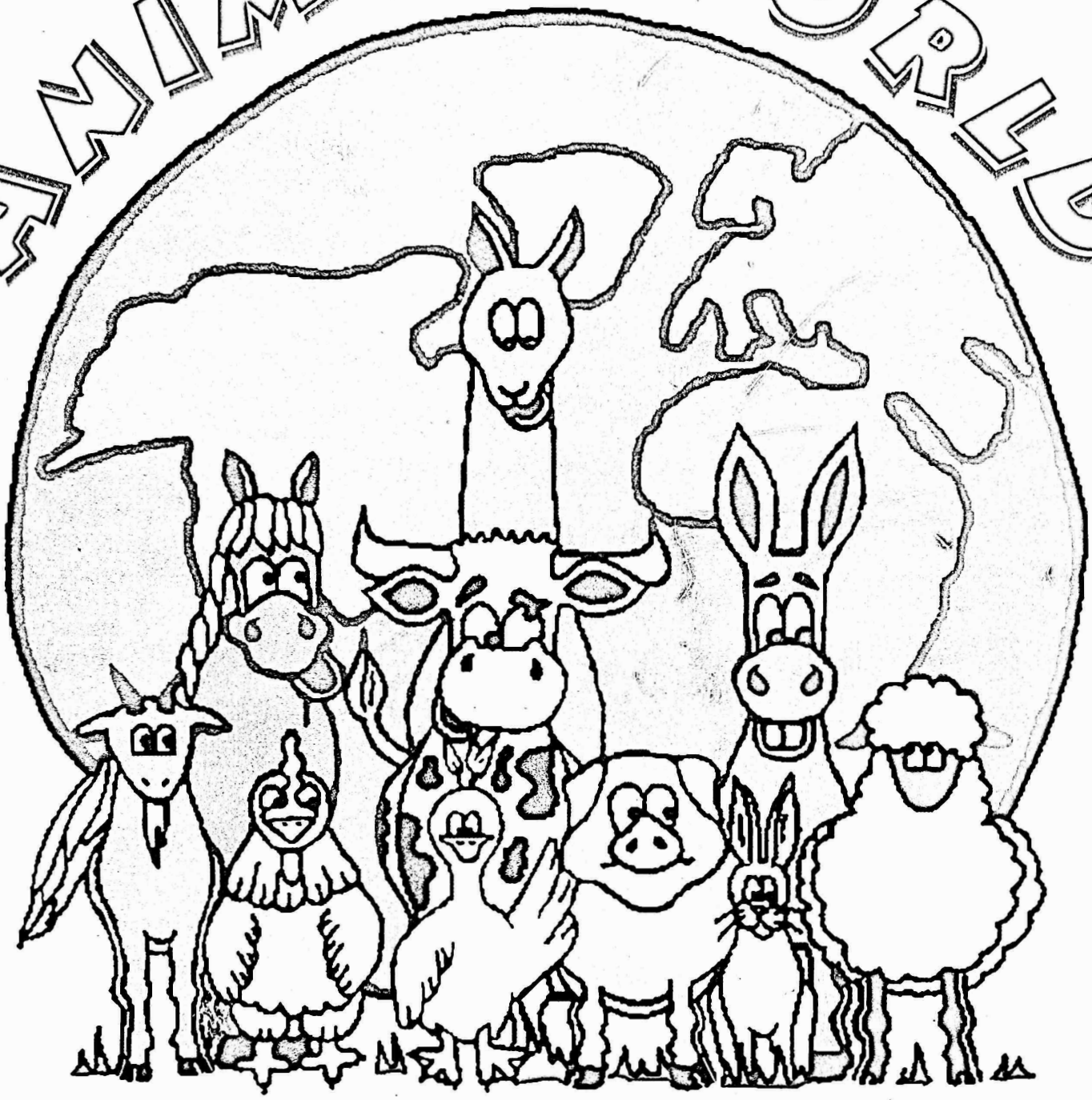

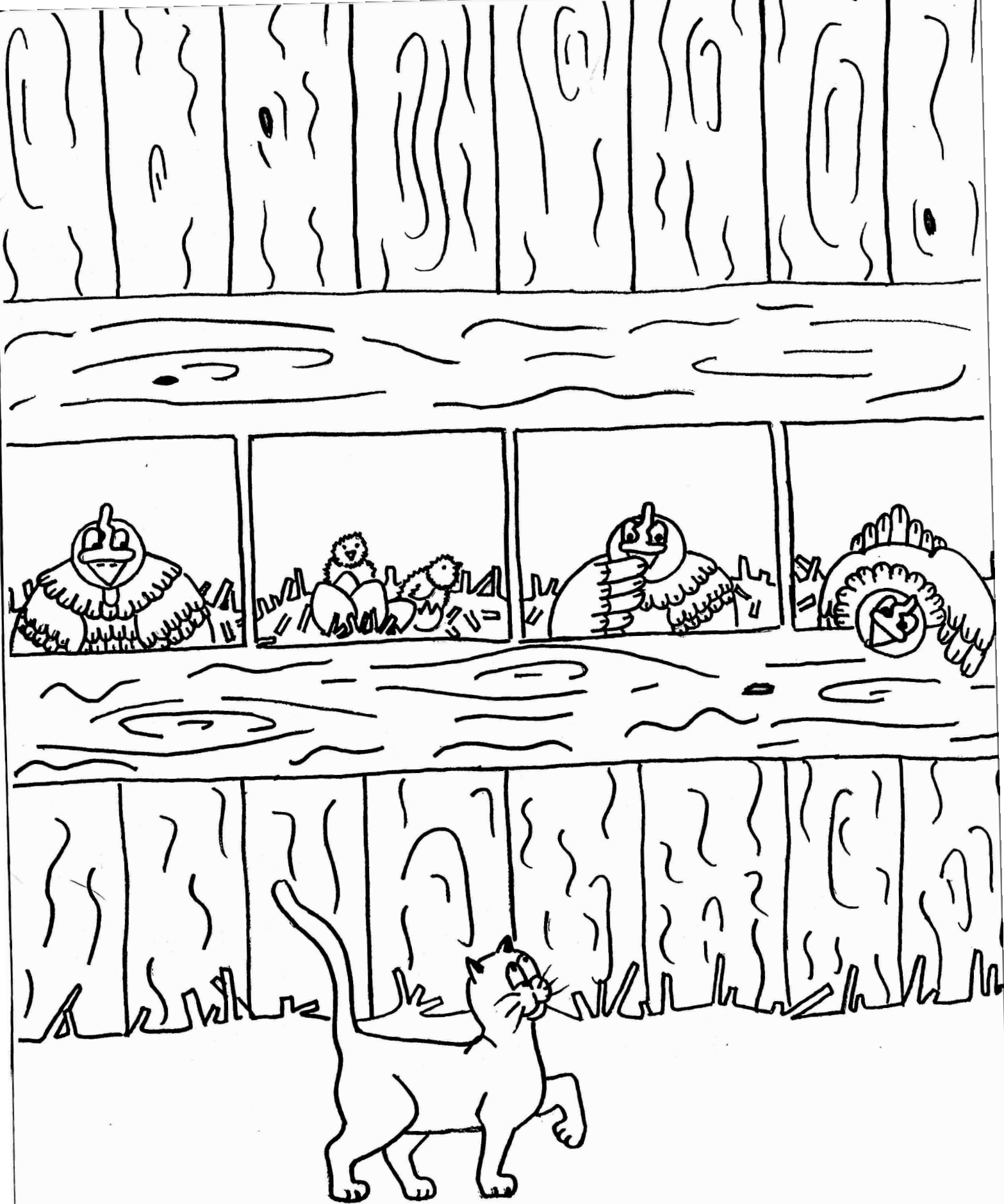


Petting Zoo Coloring Book

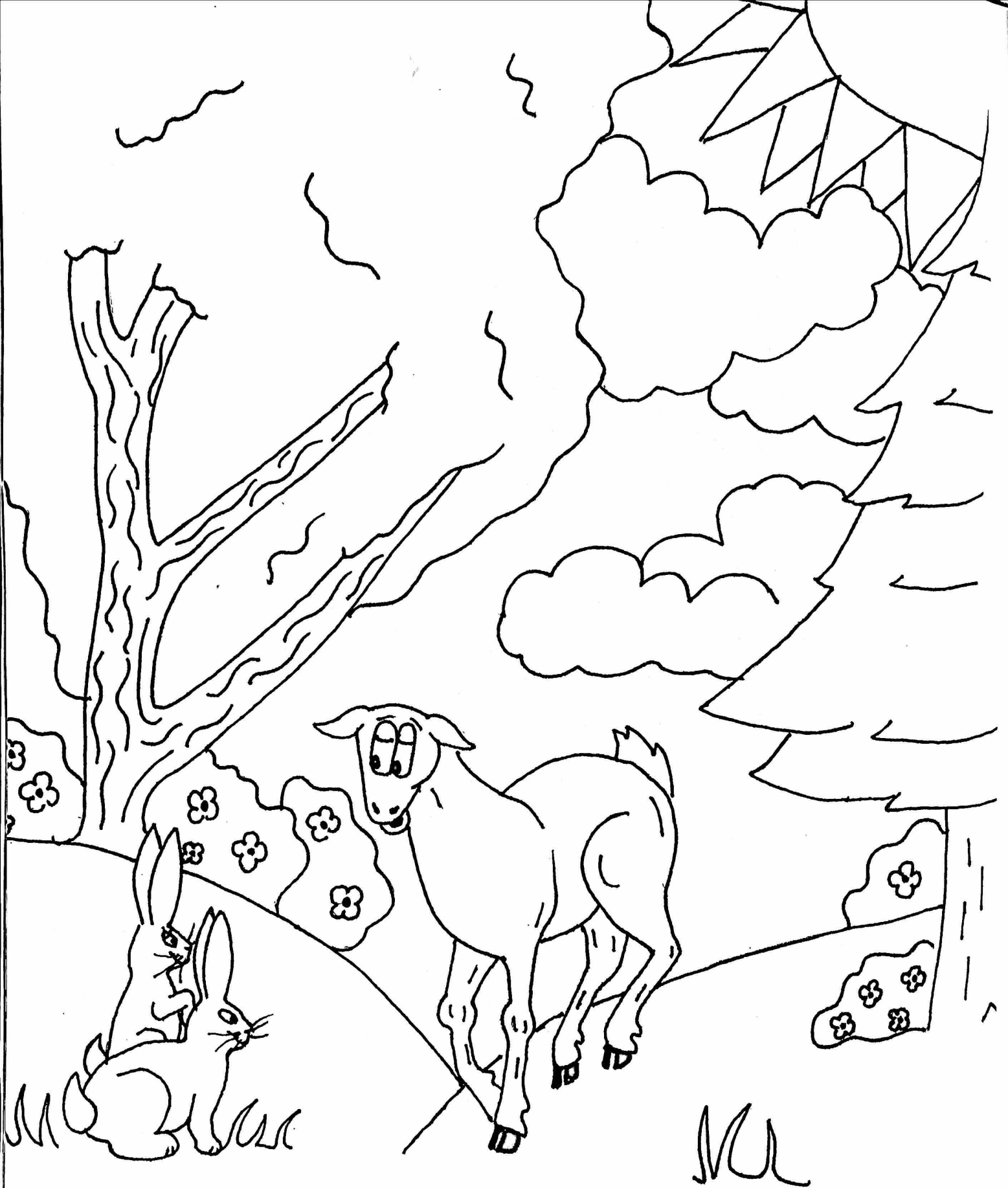

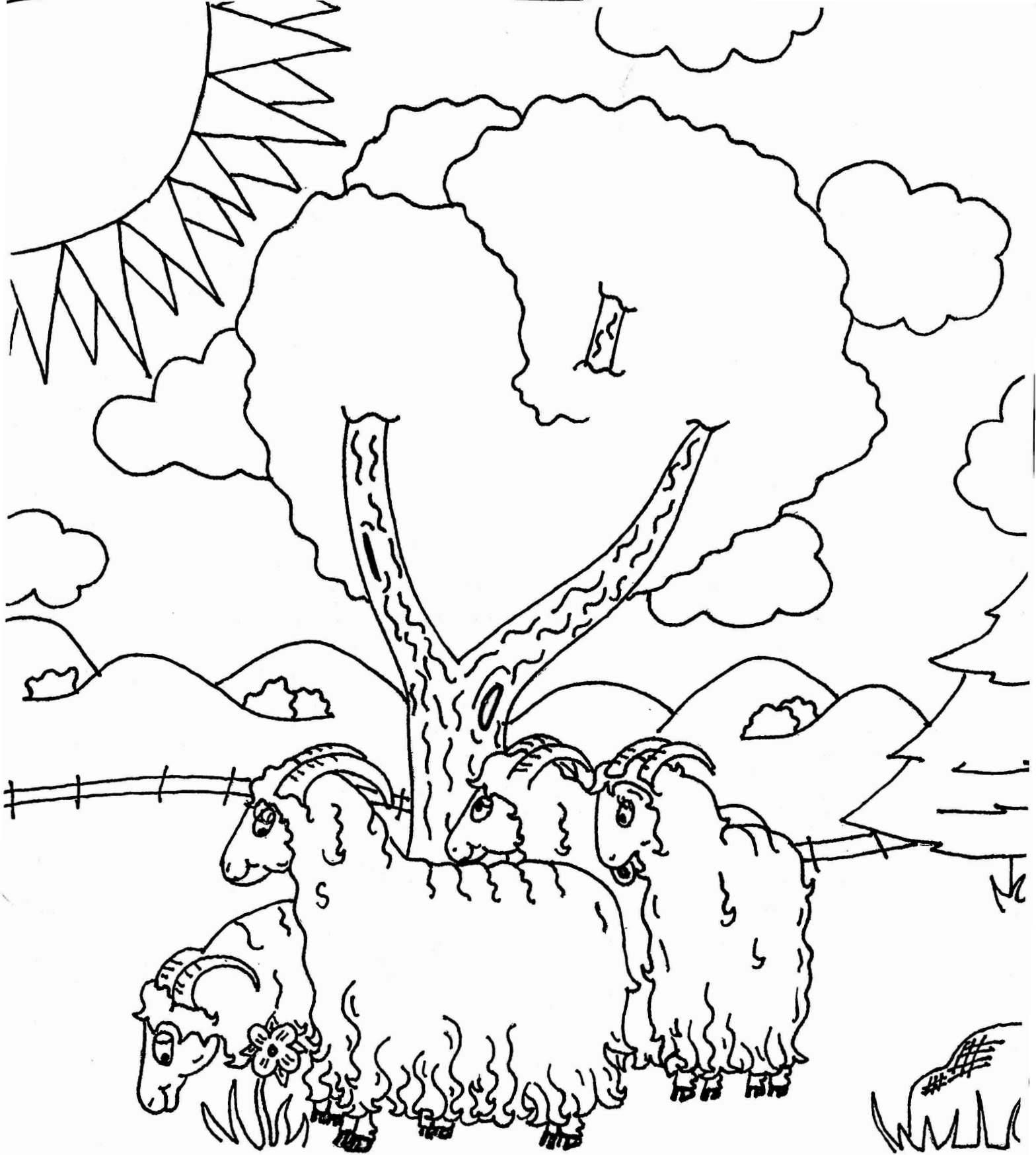
Children watch at the Animal World Farm while a mother pig nurses her piglets. Pot bellied pigs have 2-14 piglets.



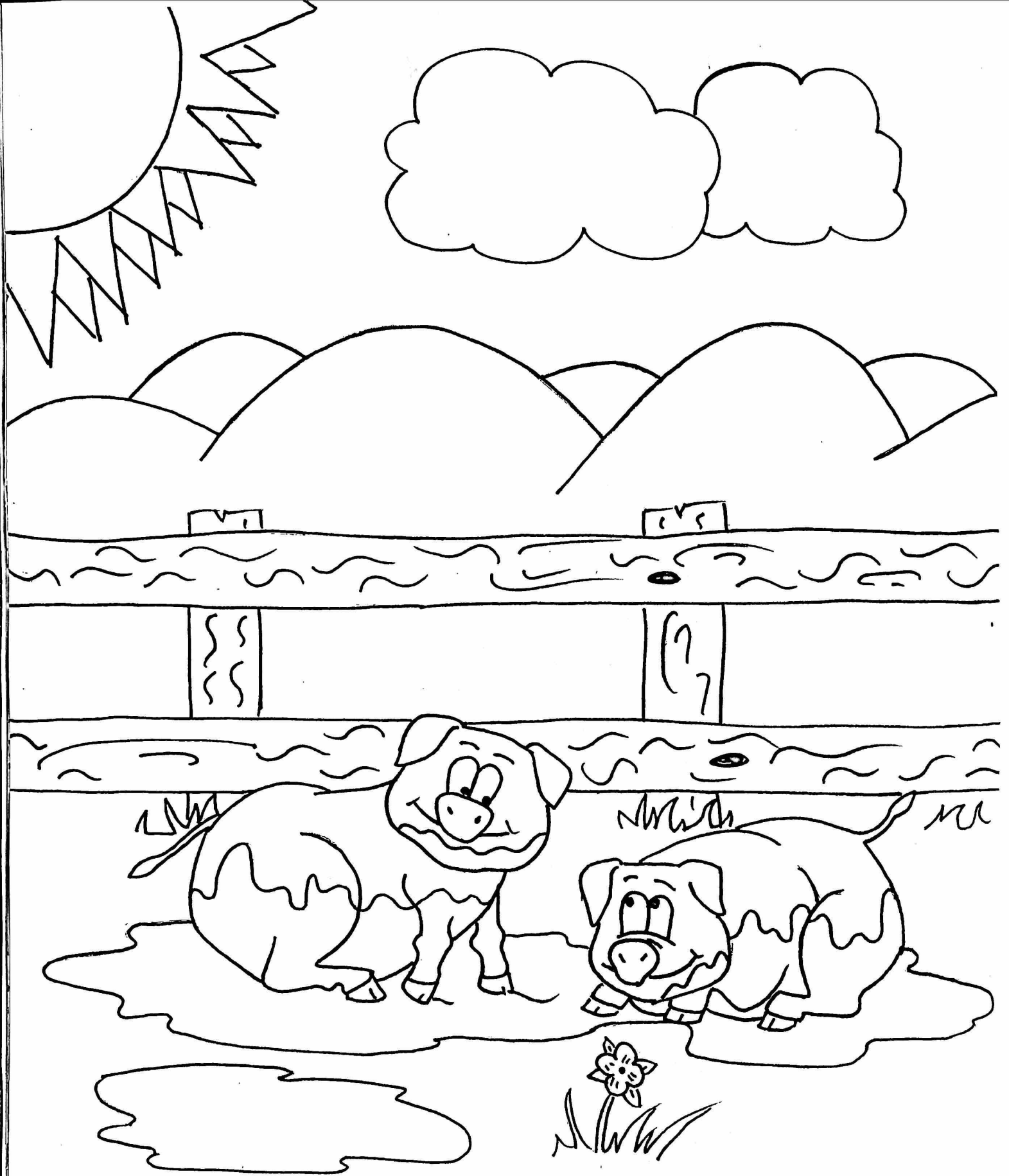
Hens watch while the Animal World farm cat walks slowly through the chicken coop.



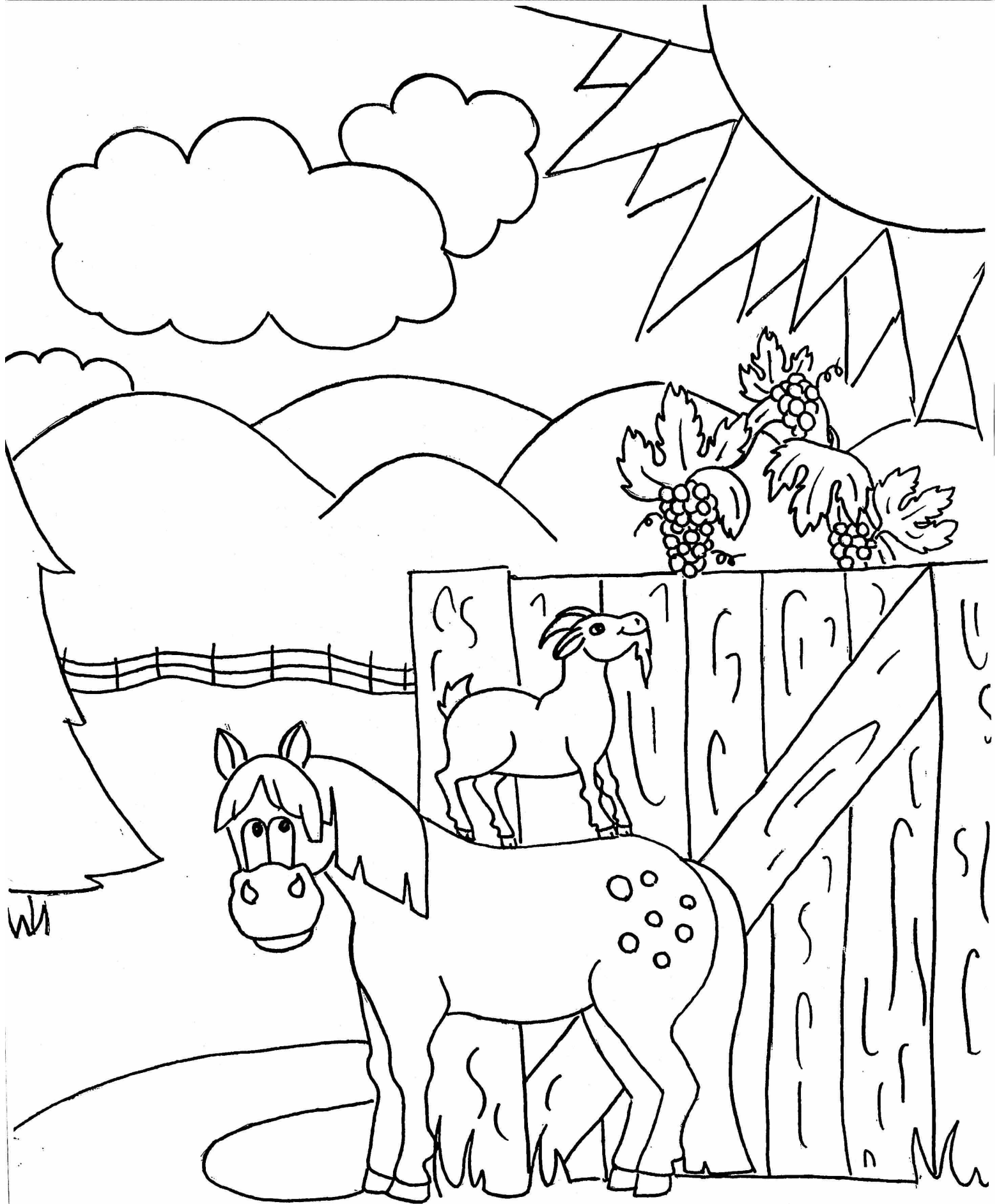
A goat plays in the pasture and passes two bunny rabbits.
Goats are very playful animals.



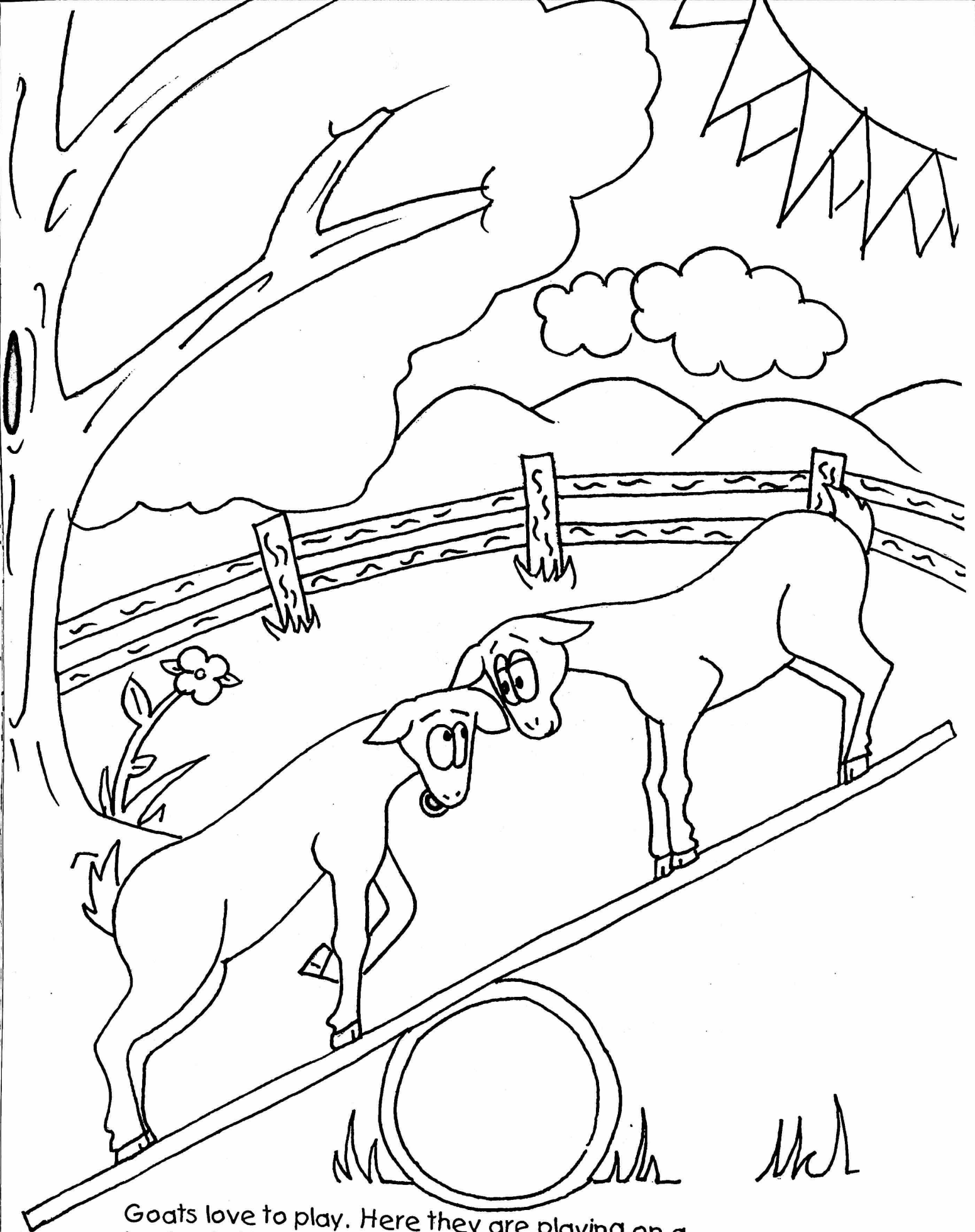
Four Angora Goats enjoy the pasture. Angora goat's hair is sometimes used to make clothing like angora sweaters.



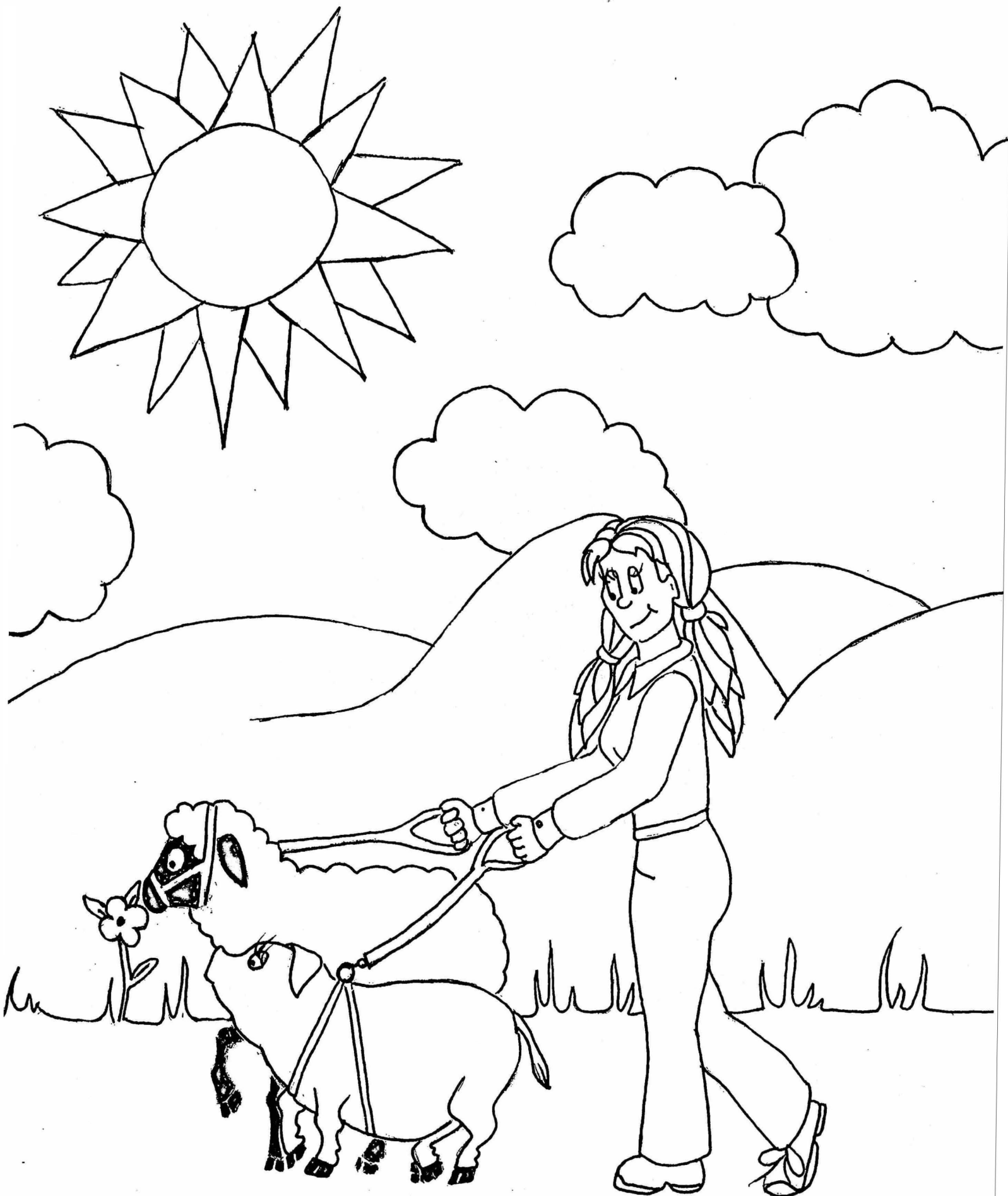
Pot-bellied pigs love to play in the mud. It keeps them cool and protects their skin from the sun.



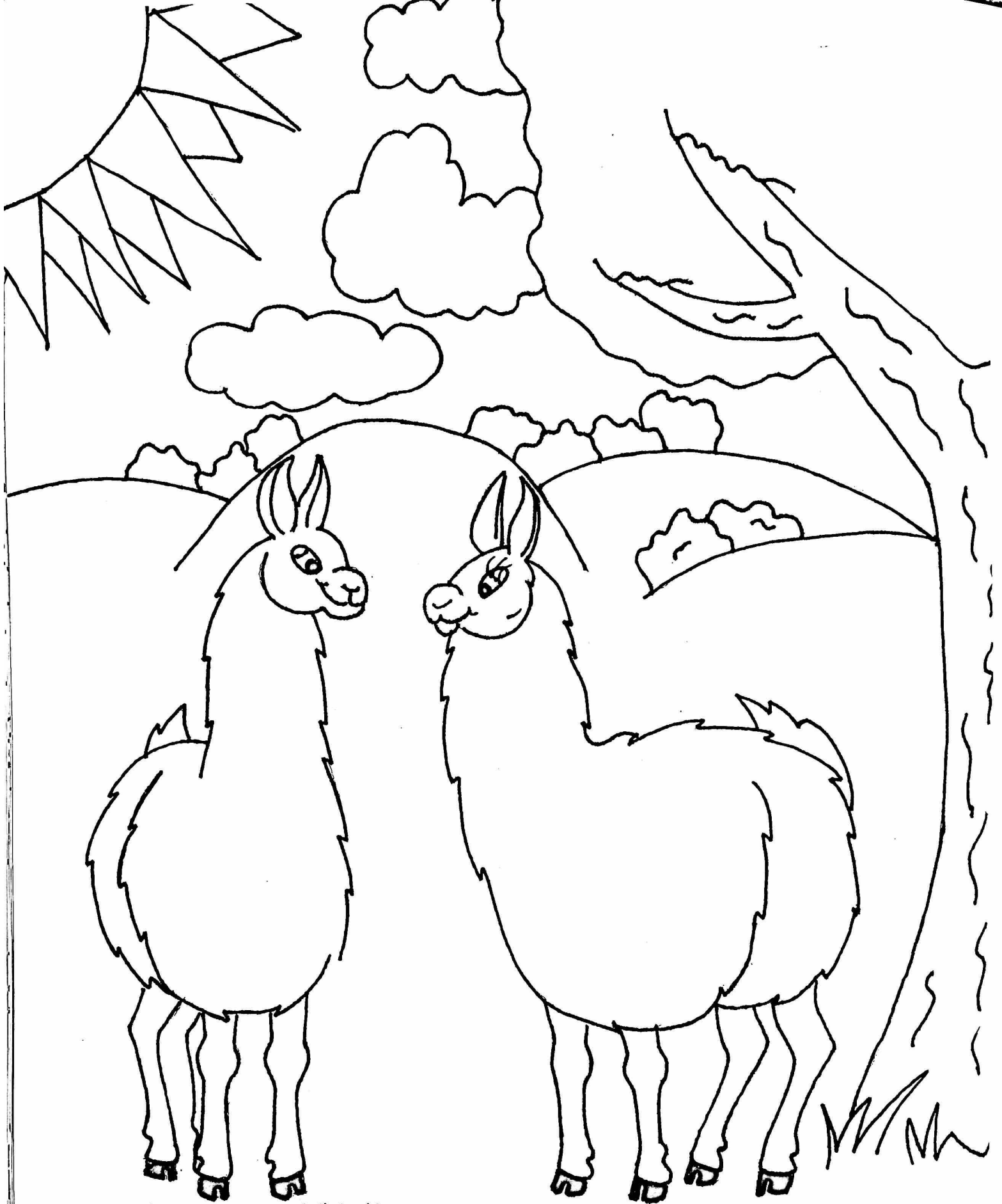
A goat uses a miniature horse to get a boost. Goats think grape leaves are a great treat.



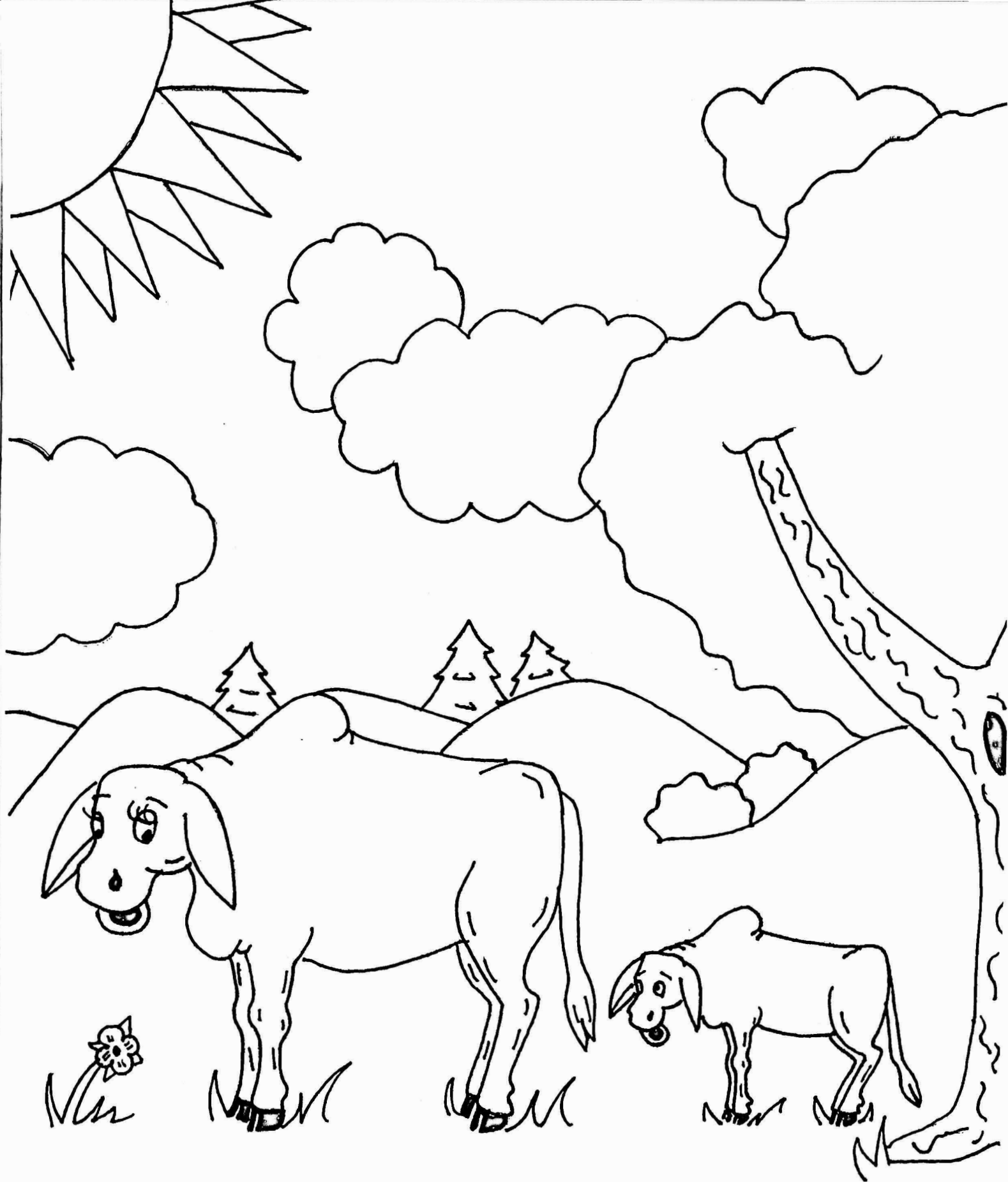
Goats love to play. Here they are playing on a teeter-totter.

Two llamas visit in the pasture. Llamas make good guard animals for herds of goats and sheep. They let out a cry when they sense danger.



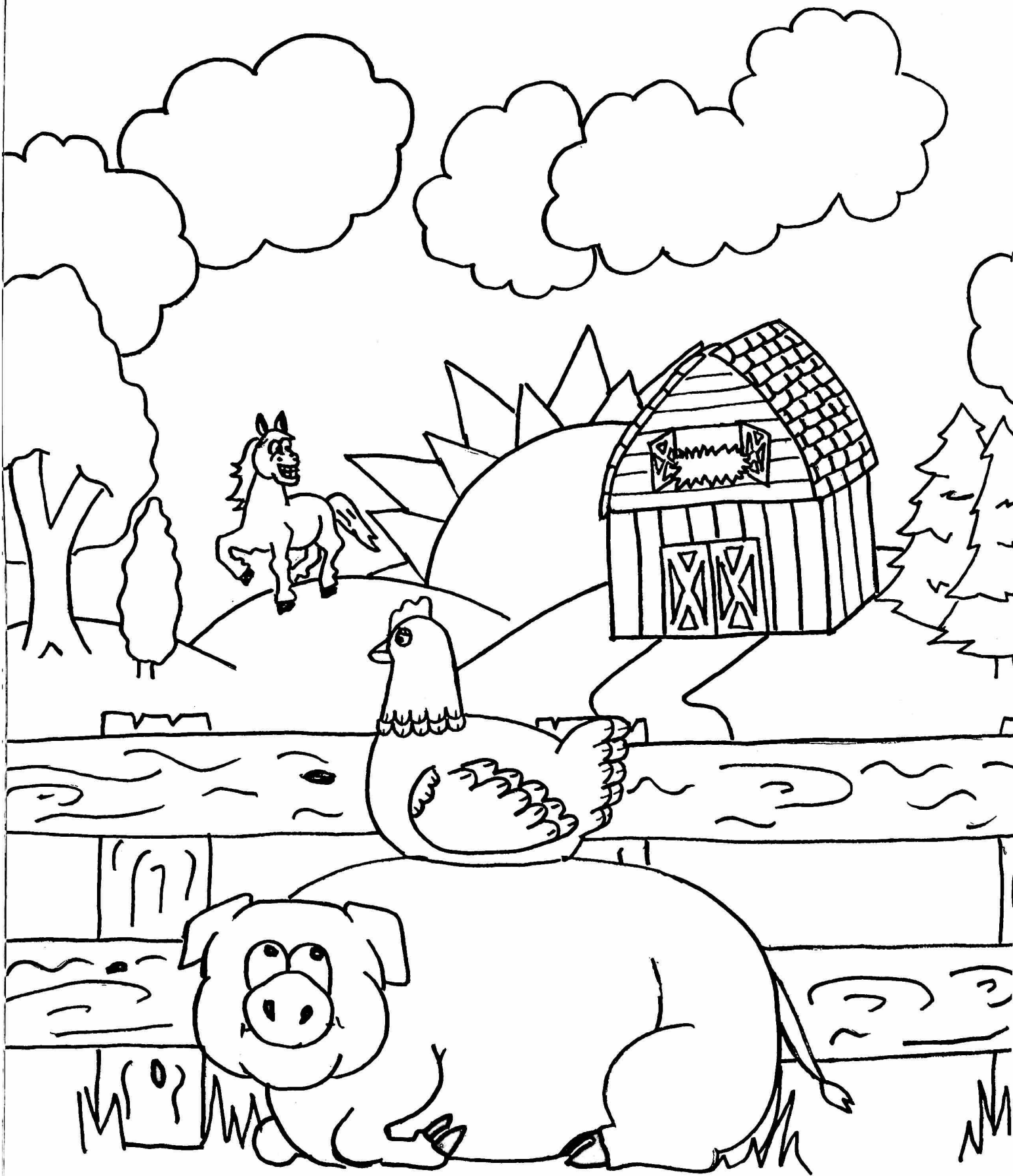
A miniature zebu and her calf walk through the pasture.
Zebu is another word for brahman.



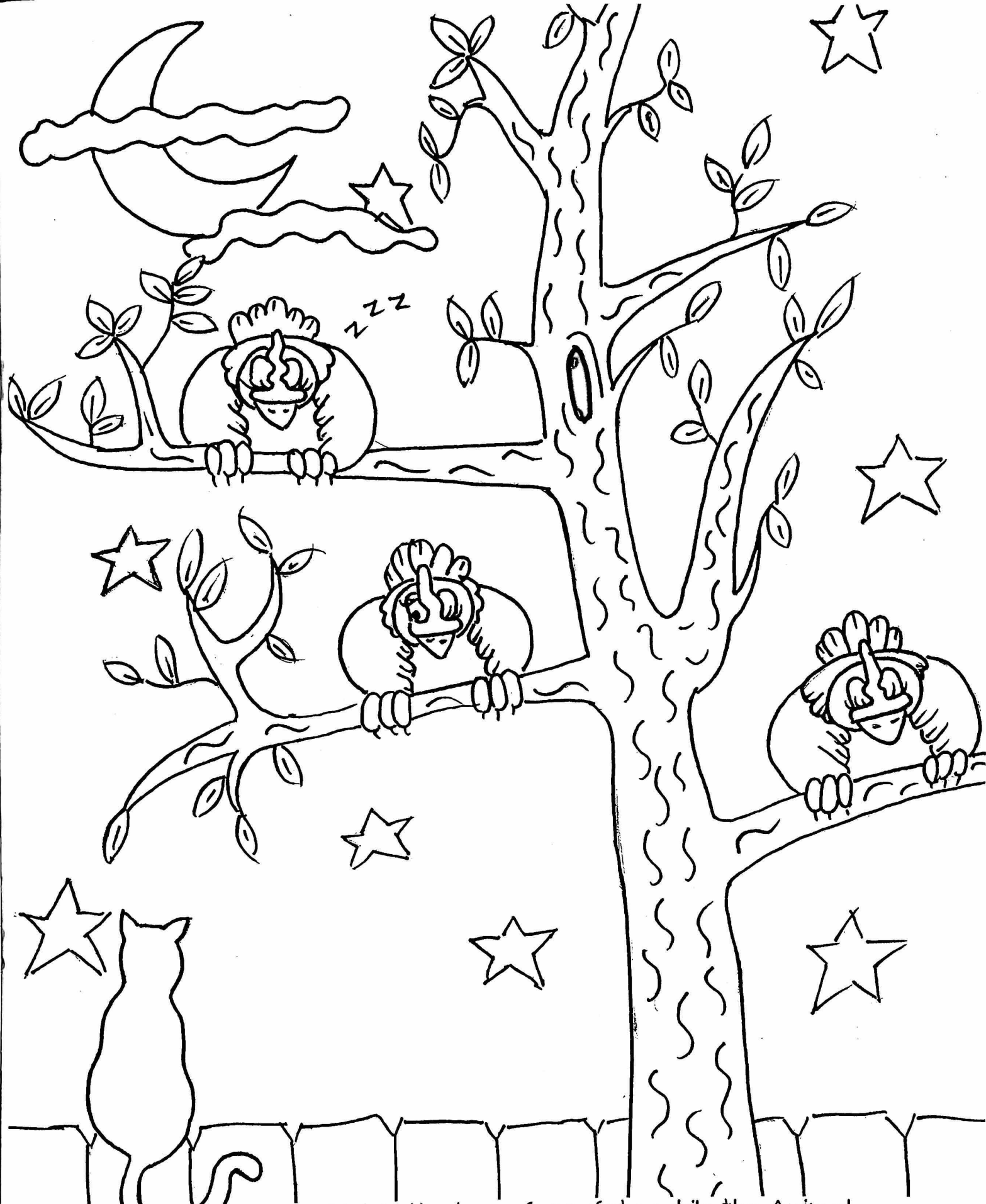
A miniature horse and her filly enjoy playing in the pasture at the Animal World farm. Miniature horses are smaller than ponies.

A chicken decides the coziest place on the farm to sleep is on top of a plump pot-bellied pig.



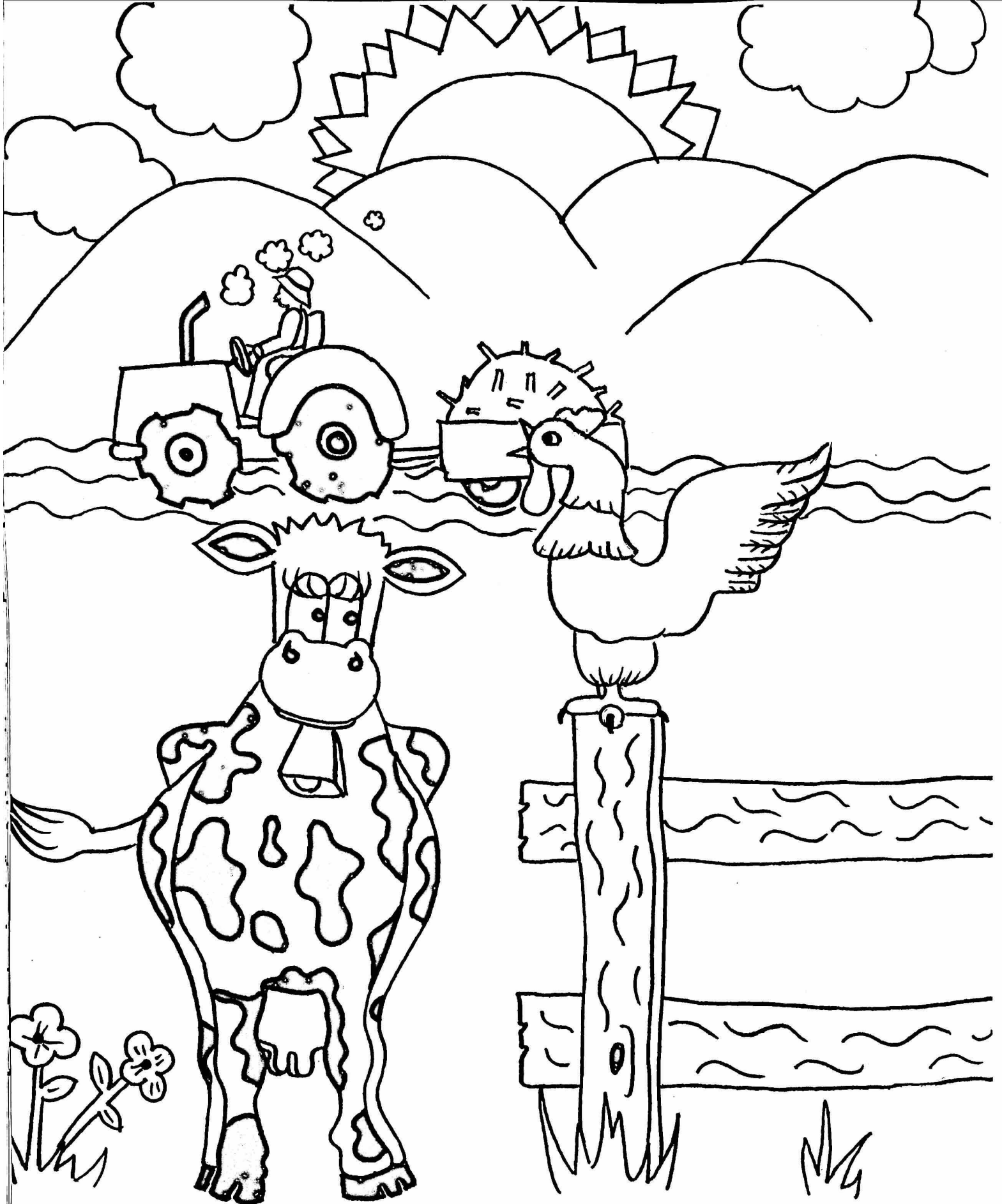
Chickens sleep high in the trees for safety, while the Animal World farm cat watches.



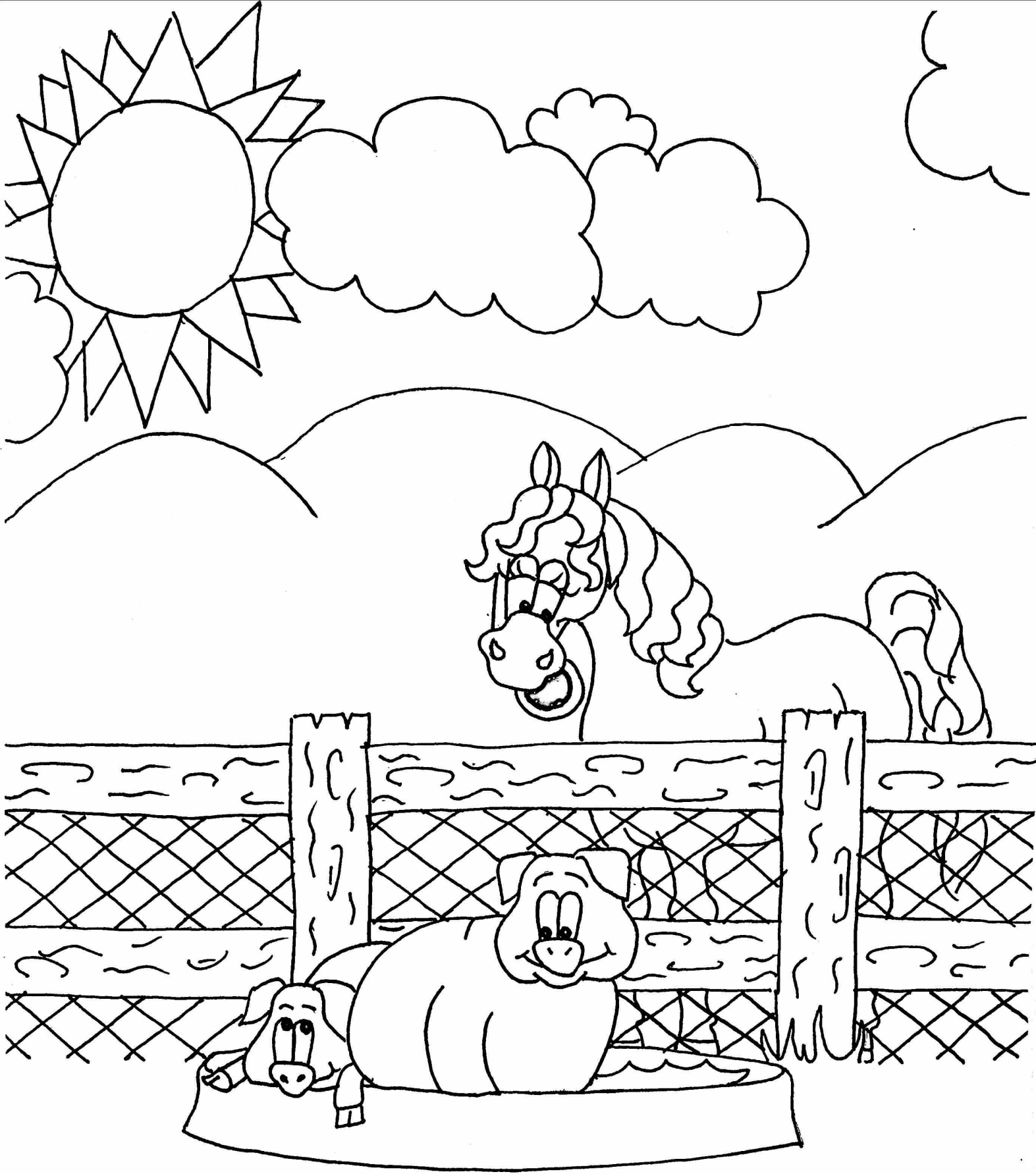
A pig, miniature horse, a chicken, and a sheep find the softest place at the Animal World farm to lie down.

A cow watches as a rooster gives his morning crow.



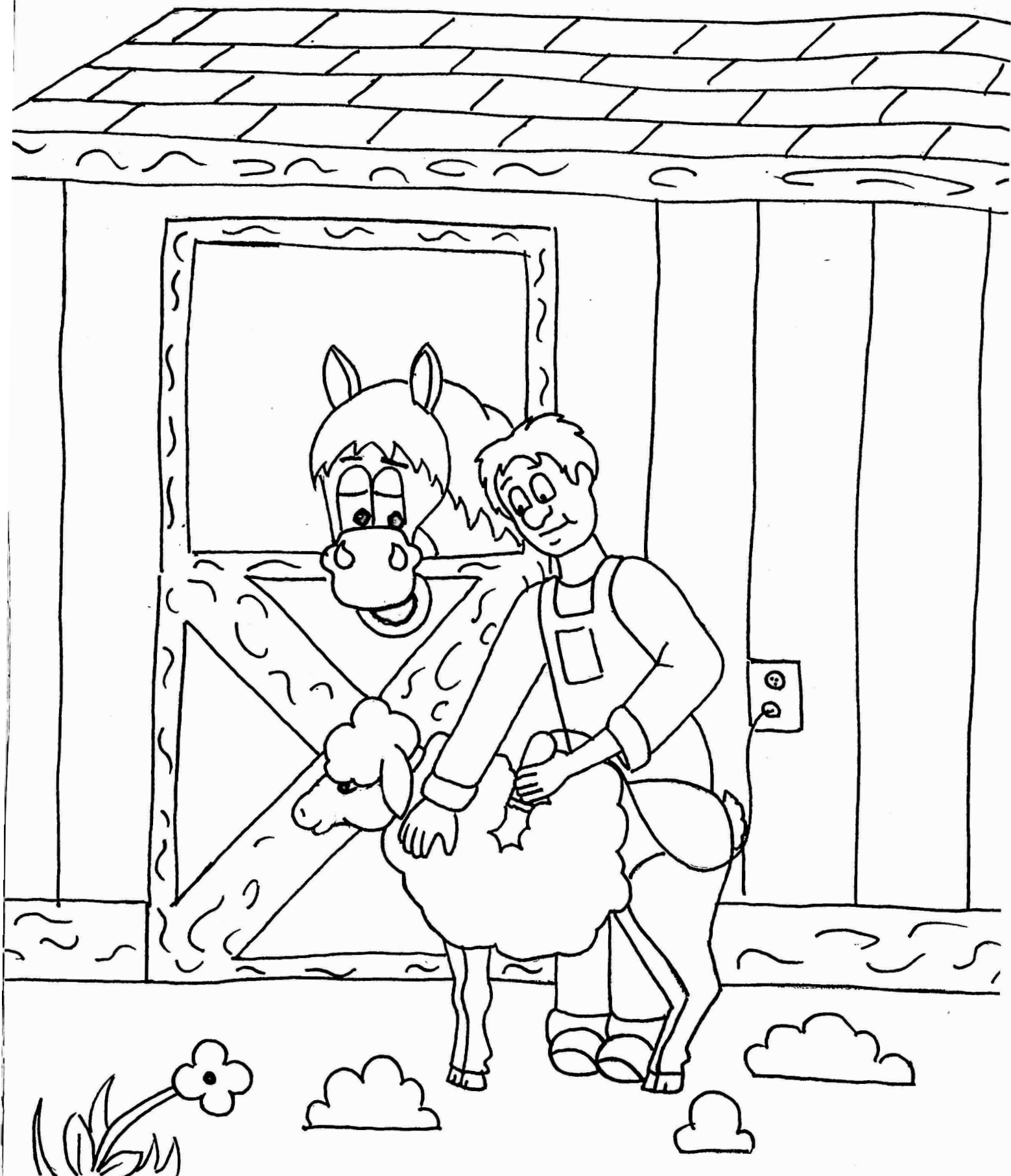
Pot-bellied pigs play in a kiddie pool to cool off while a miniature horse watches.



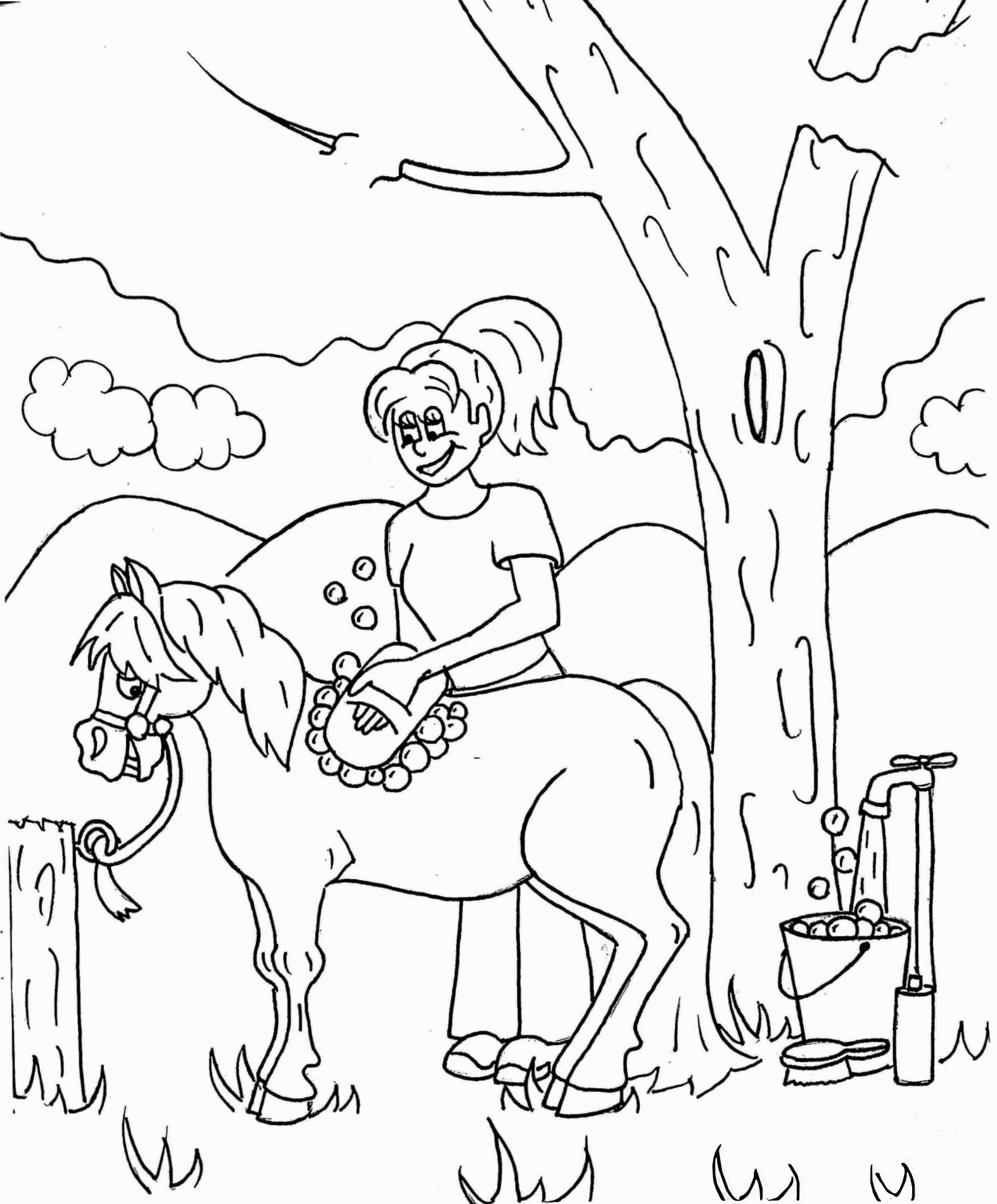
A little girl hugs a mini donkey and gives him apples at the Animal World farm.



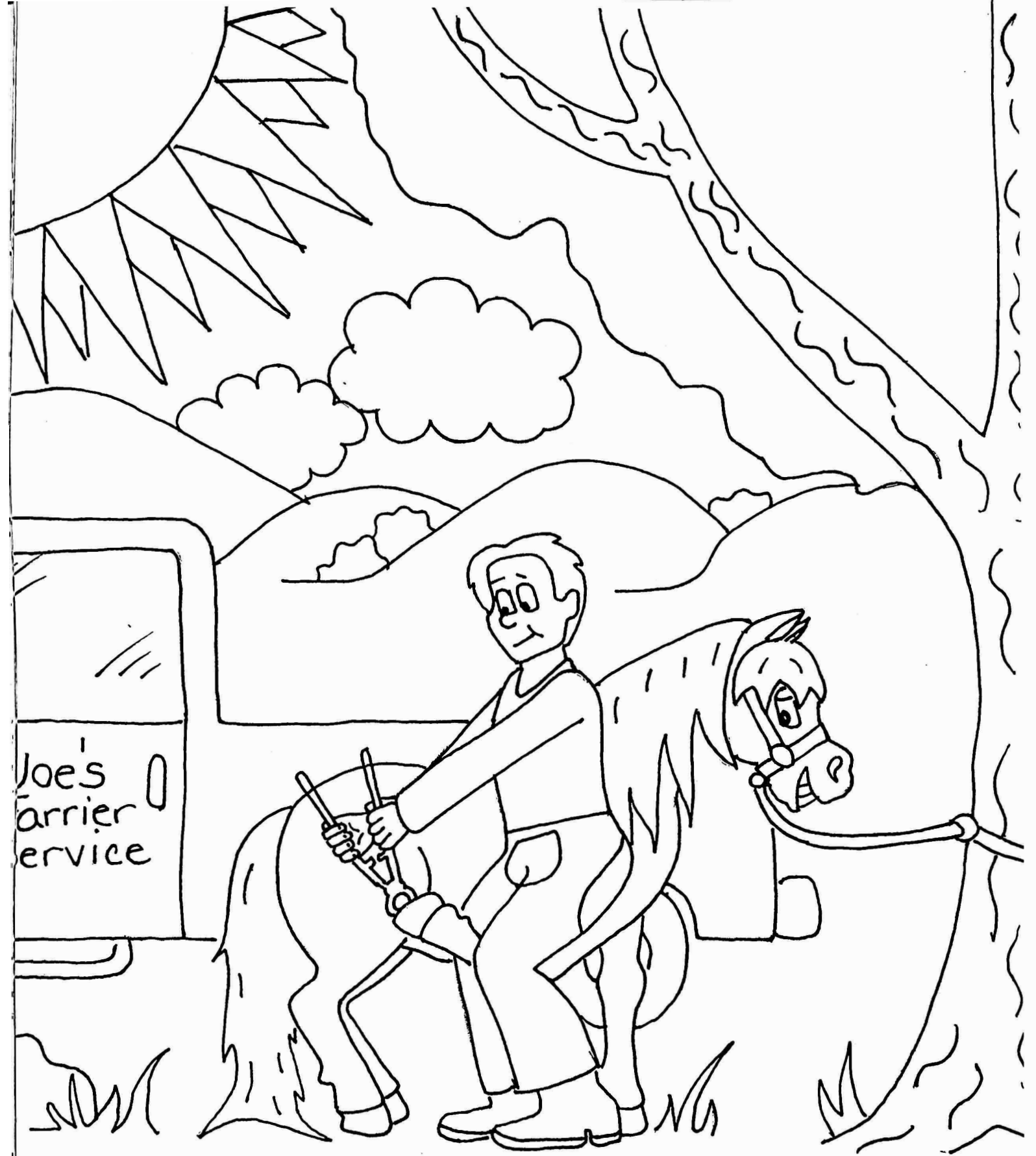
Animal World Petting Zoo goat gets a check-up from the local veterinarian.



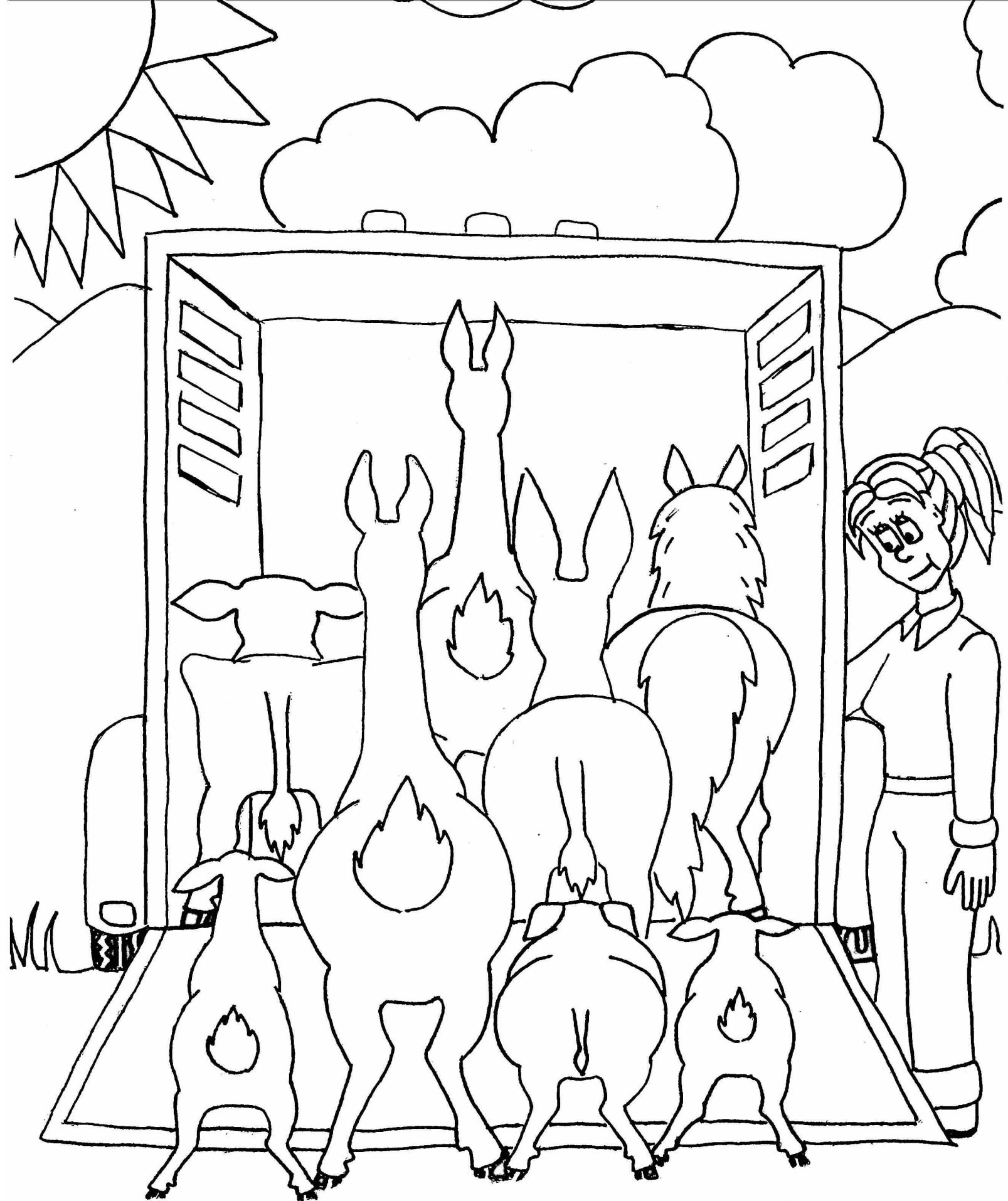
Sheep need to be sheered every summer in hot places to keep cool. Their wool can then be used to make clothing.



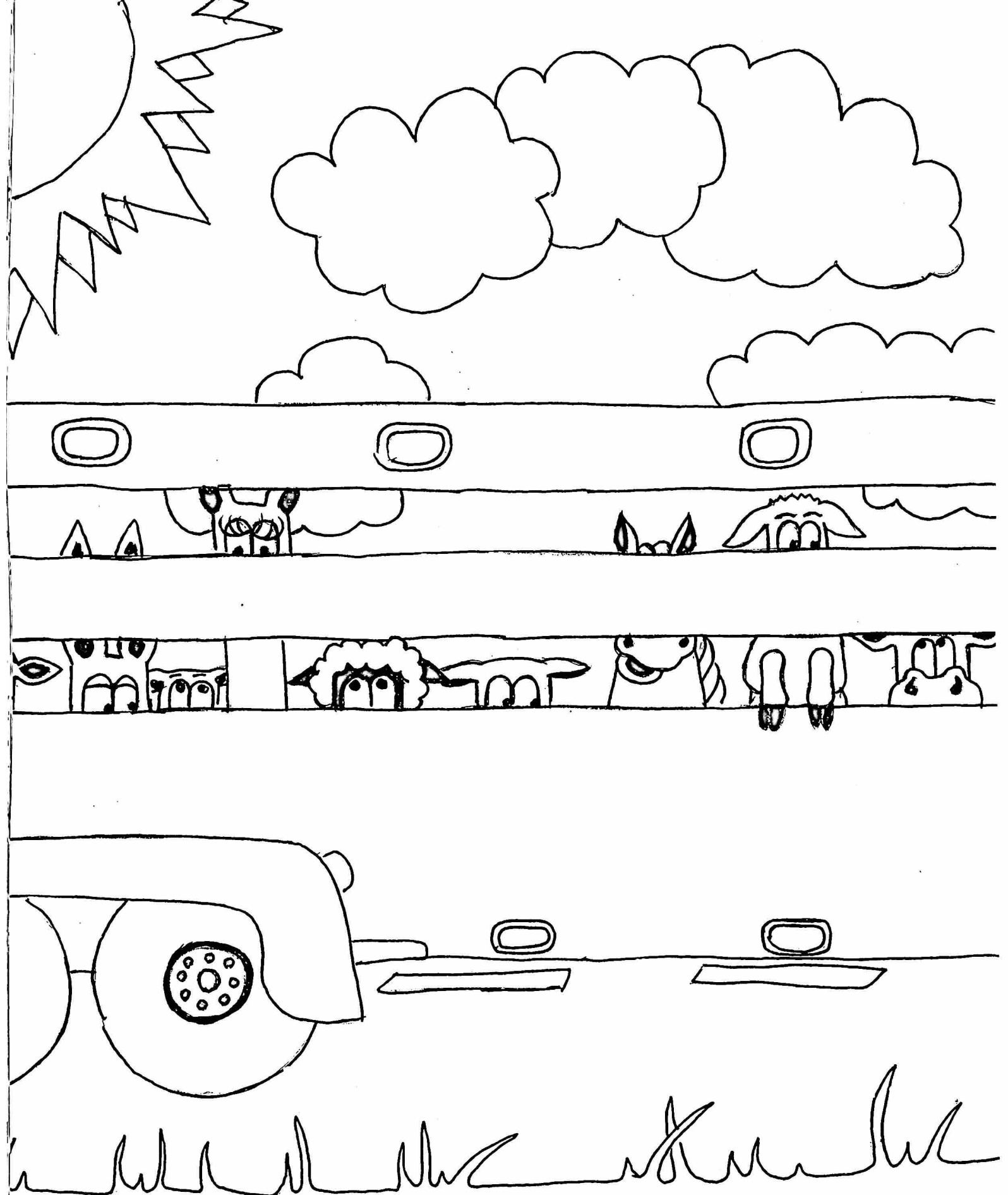
Madilyn washes a miniature horse so he'll be clean and pretty for the petting zoo.



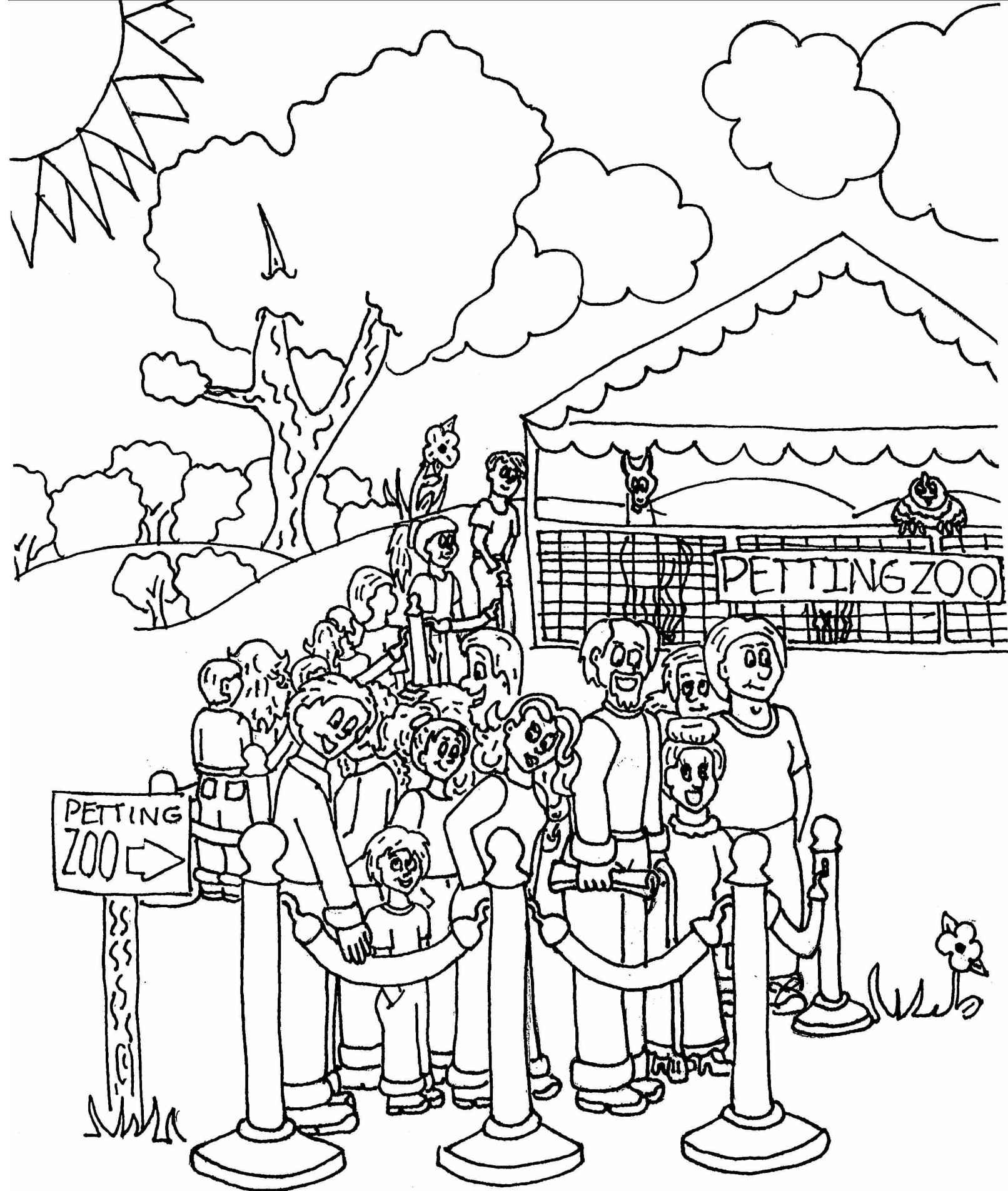
Miniature horses need to have their hooves trimmed and so do big horses.



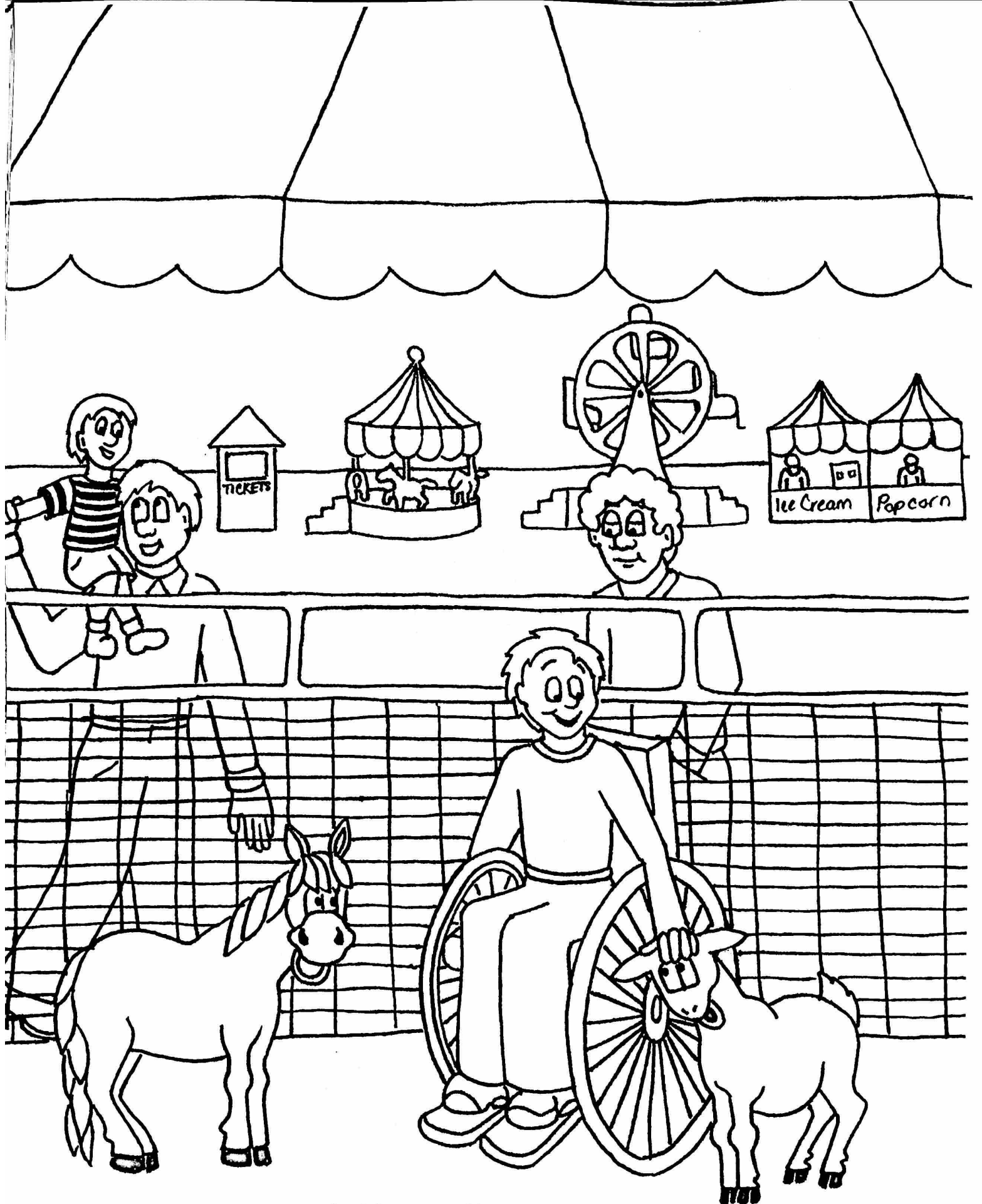
All the Animal World Petting Zoo animals get into the horse trailer to go to the fair.



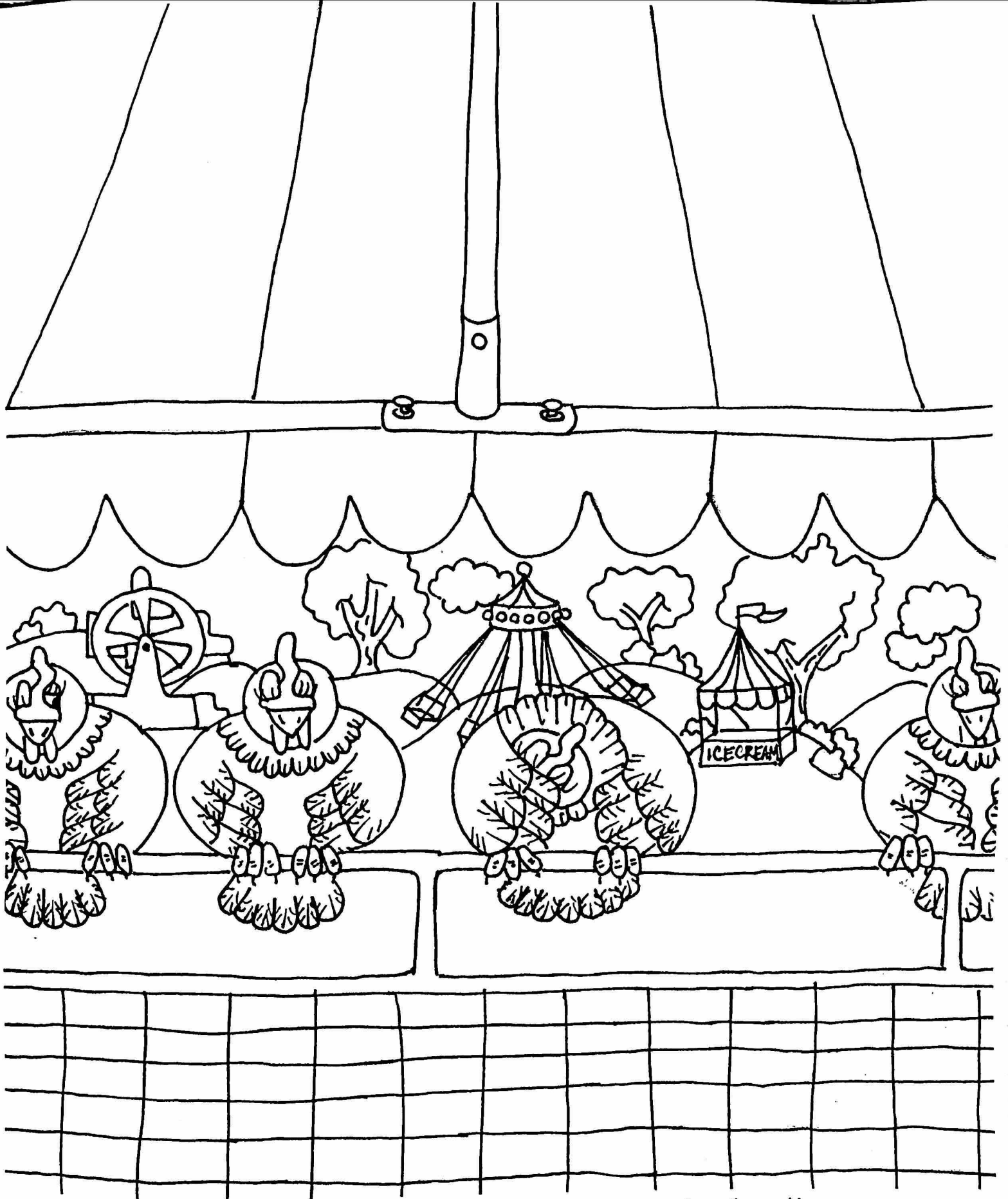
The petting zoo animals look outside the trailer as they travel down the road to the fair.



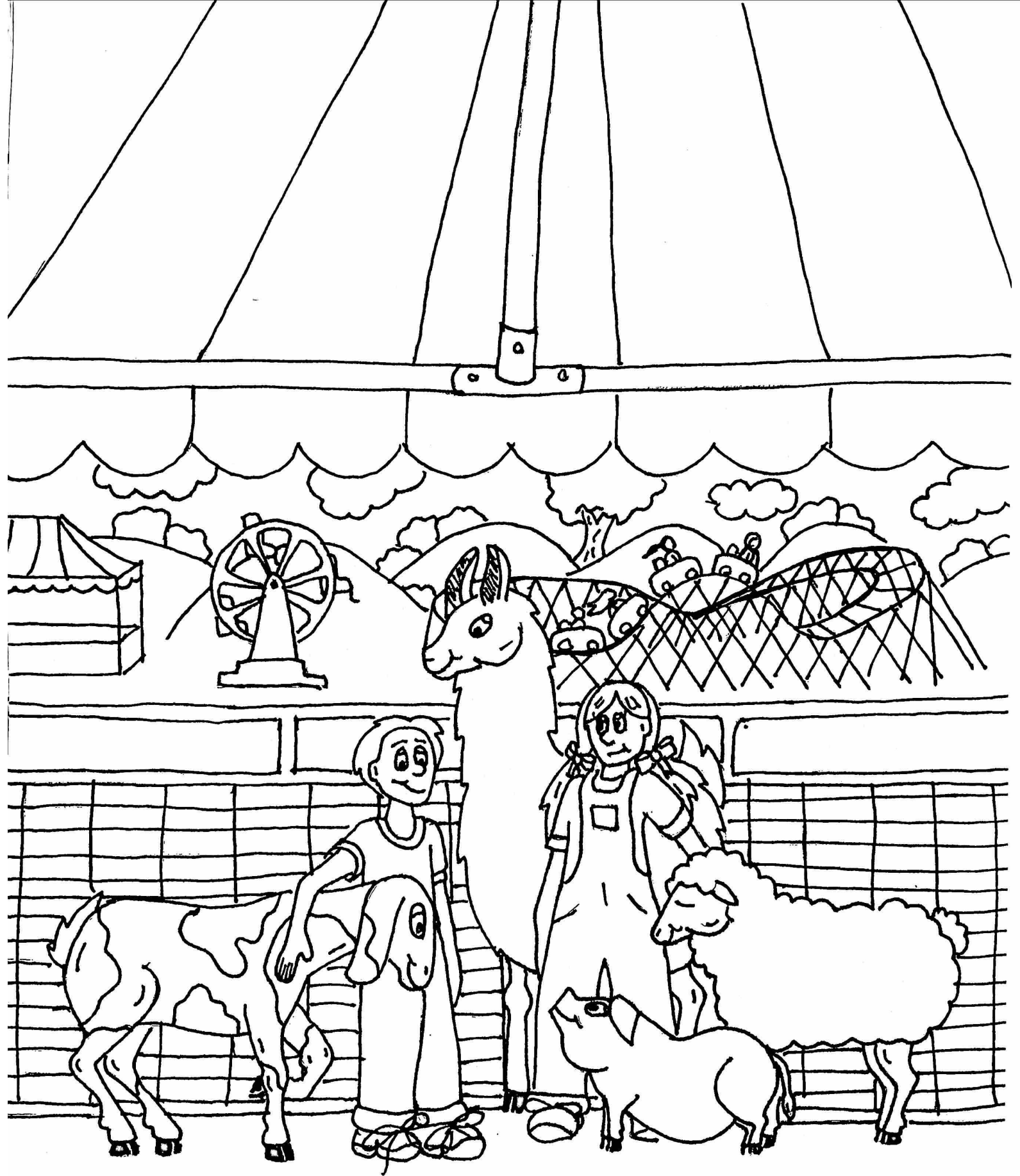
People wait in line for a chance to get in the Animal World
Petting Zoo at the fair.



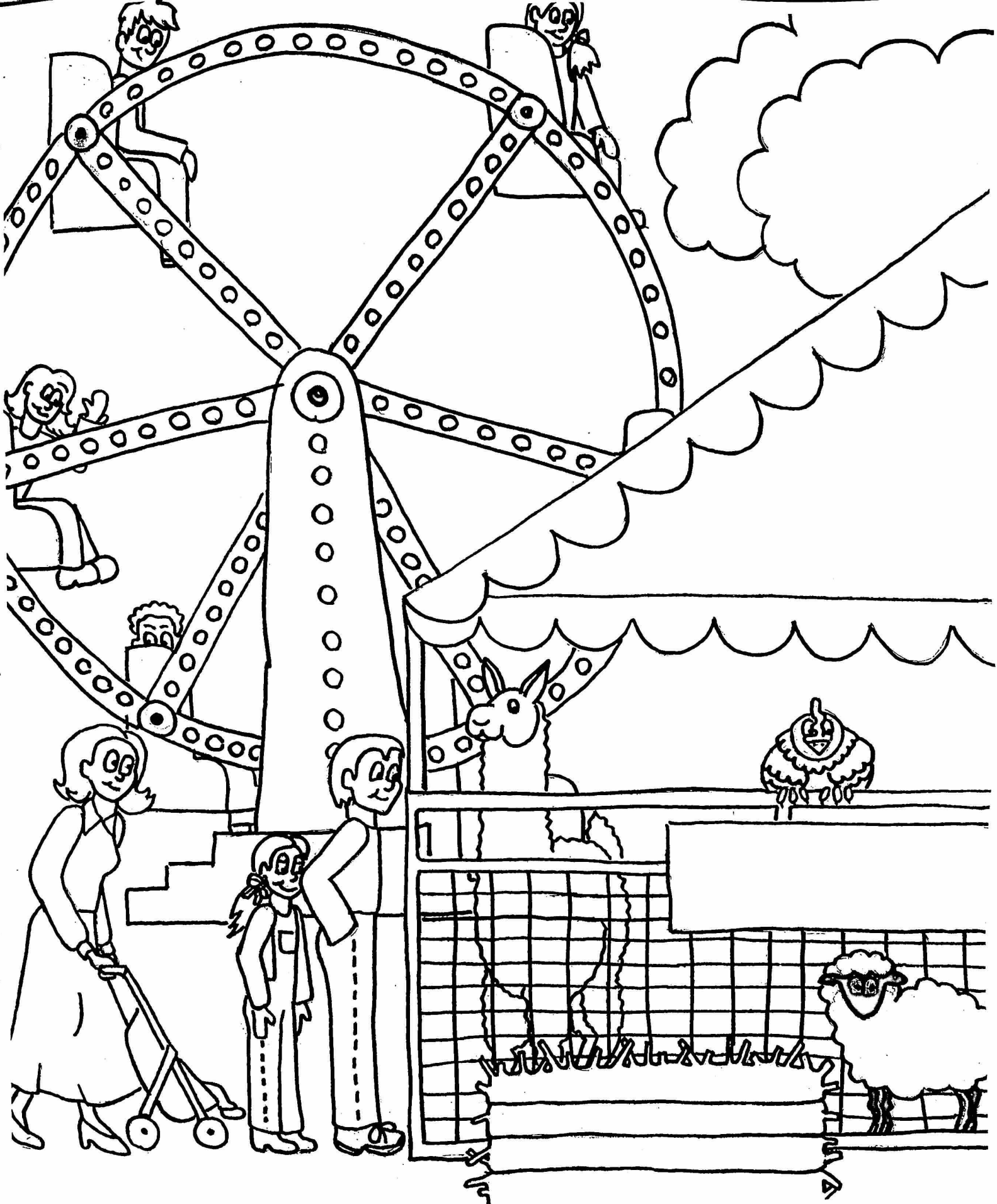
People young and old enjoy the Animal World Petting Zoo.
