The proposed 2024 summer arts academy is a six week session, Monday-Friday from 8:00am until 3:00 pm June 10, 2024 to July 19, 2024. We will be located at 2800 E. River Road Dayton, OH 45439.

This year we will offer two art magnets: **dance and artist**. The dance magnet will include: ballet, modern/creative movement, hip-hop, and liturgical. The artist magnet will consist of: art classes, choir, piano, summer reading, and Spanish. All of our academy instructors are professionally trained and hold various degrees in their field of expertise.

Pertinent information

<u>Dance 5-18yrs</u>: \$75 registration fee and \$140 per week (ballet, modern, contemporary, hip-hop and liturgical and creative movement for younger students) Dancers will be placed according to ability not age.

<u>Artist Magnet:</u> \$75 registration fee and \$140 per week (art, choir, piano, and summer reading/writing, Spanish)

<u>Payments</u> can be made by visiting our website <u>www.ngaainc.com</u>, We accept ACE, Title XX public funding, private pay, and 10% applied to families with 4+ years with Notably Gifted. Payments are collected two weeks prior so that we can cover all costs by the end of camp. Additionally, payment is based on spots reserved not attendance. If you pay in advance and the student does not attend there will be no refunds unless there is extreme medical reasons. To add, if a student attends one day but not the remainder of the week payment will not be pro-rated

There is a payment plan located on the website to help pay for camp over time vs. weekly.

<u>Placements:</u> June 8, 2024 10:00-11:30am for all dancers over 9 years old and students who wish to be considered for advanced piano.

Attendance: Our program is not a drop-in program. Attendance is required in order to acquire skills. Students are only permitted to miss 4 days for the entire camp. Students who miss more than 4 days of camp will not be able to perform in the finale showcase. If your student will be absent please report it in advance to dance magnet coordinators.

<u>Timeliness:</u> Breakfast begins at 7:30am. We will not accept students prior to that time. Camp begins at 8:00am. We will stop receiving students at 8:15am. If you arrive later than 8:15 am without advanced approval your student will not be permitted to camp for the day.

After camp care: 3-5:00pm. Cost is an additional \$40 per week per child and must be paid in advance. If students attend one day the payment will not be pro-rated.

<u>Late fees:</u> Fees will be assessed at 3:10pm or 5:10pm for after care.

- 1st late pick up fee is \$15 per child
- 2nd late fee is \$20 per child
- 3rd will discuss possible removal from camp

Fundraisers: We will have camp fundraisers.

Coupon books: for every 20 books sold receive \$100 cash prize.

Candy boxes: tbd

Families who do not engage in the fundraisers will be required to either make a donation of \$100 or pay for their students costumes/music books and shirt which you will keep.

Finale Showcase: Friday July 19, 2024 at Beavercreek High School Auditorium

Thursday 7/18/24 extended day dress rehearsal until 5pm

Friday 7/19/24 students report to building at 10:30am we will transport students to Beavercreek.

Youth Works: High School students 14+ are encouraged to apply for Youth Works at the Department of Job and Family Services and select Notably Gifted as a work site. Students will be able to attend camp and gain work experience.

Duties for Youth workers:

- Assist with pick up and drop off
- Prepare space for breakfast and clean up
- Prepare classrooms
- Janitorial work (cleaning bathrooms, eating areas, sweeping hallways, emptying trash etc)
- Assisting teachers as needed
- Assisting with lunch duty
- Assisting with nap time and restroom breaks for younger students

College Scholarship opportunities:

Each summer our high school students completes the camp they will earn \$150 scholarship funding.

Students participating the freshman year through senior year will receive \$600

Students must participate junior year and complete two summers for a total of \$300.

Funding is earned every summer and students must complete the summer of their senior year.

Checks will be made payable to college/university on behalf of the student.
